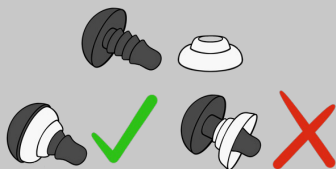
For eyebrows 40 cm black

It is perfect for many projects - baskets, pillows, rugs, yes, all kinds of home interior items.

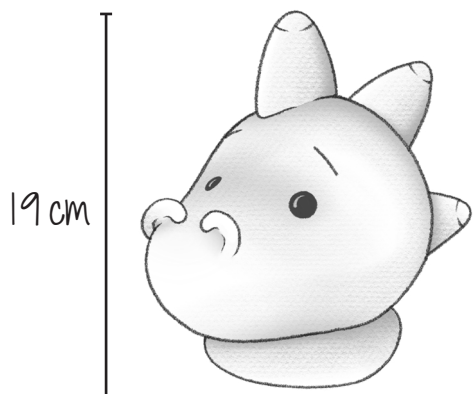
And of course, the Chenille structure in particular is ideal for baby sensory toys. Kids will love it for its softness.

Recommended machine wash at 40° C.

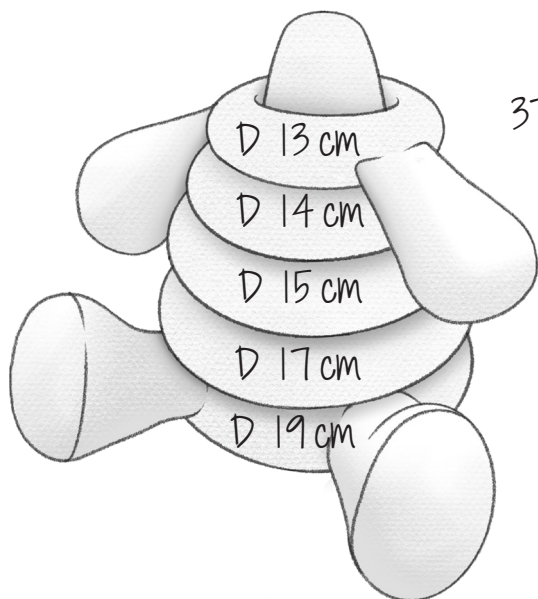

It is important that the crochet tension is maintained so that the rings fit harmoniously and securely on the cone. Especially the large bottom ring must fit well and not come off. If, for example, it is crocheted too loosely or tightly, it can be adjusted by adding or reducing the number of rounds on the last rings at the top.

## GUIDE:

The top ring is mounted on the head, to ensure stability.

The cone consists of two crocheted parts that are sewn together around the foam cone.

## NOSTRIL 2 X

Colour A.

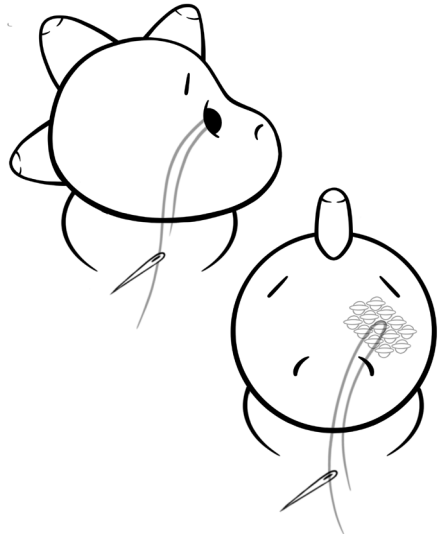

Sew onto the nose.

### Shape the head and eye sockets:

Using the yarn, thread about 25 cm of it through the needle. Insert the needle under the chin and up at the inner edge of the eye. Stitch over one stitch, and bring the needle out near the chin. Tighten the thread to create a depression over the eye. To maintain the pressure on the depression, sew through a couple of stitches near the chin. The depression on one eye is now completed.

Repeat the process on the opposite eye.



### Introduction to spikes:

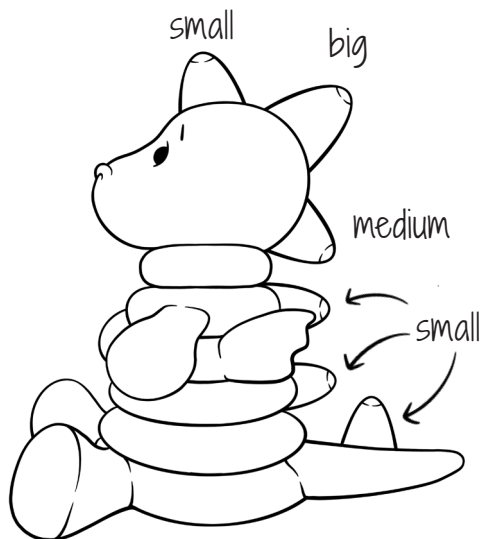
The spikes are sewn on from the nose to the tail tip.

On the head: small, large, medium

On the rings and tail: small

The spikes are sewn on with 3 rows in between.

The first spike is sewn on in the same row as the eyebrows, between rows 15 & 16.



### SPIKE SMALL X 4

Start with colour C.

1.) mr with 6 dc (6)

Change to color B.

2.) \*1 dc, 2 dc inc\* (9)

3.) \*2 dc, 2 dc inc\* (12)

4.) 12 dc (12)

5.) \*3 dc, 2 dc inc\* (15)

6.) 15 dc (15)

### SPIKE MEDIUM X 1

Start with colour C.

1.) mr with 6 dc (6)

Change to color B.

2.) \*1 dc, 2 dc inc\* (9)

3.) \*2 dc, 2 dc inc\* (12)

4.) \*3 dc, 2 dc inc\* (15)

5. - 7.) 15 dc (15)

### SPIKE BIG X 1

Start with colour C.

1.) mr with 6 dc (6)

Change to color B.

2.) \*1 dc, 2 dc inc\* (9)

3.) \*2 dc, 2 dc inc\* (12)

4.) \*3 dc, 2 dc inc\* (15)

5.) \*4 dc, 2 dc inc\* (18)

6. - 8.) 18 dc (18)

## RING 12 CM

Use the thread to sew the ring together.

Add the filling along the way.

Mount the ring on the head as shown in the picture.

Use the thread to sew the ring together.

## LEG X 2

Colour C.

- 1.) 8 ch, 2 dc in 2. ch from the hook,  
5 dc, 5 dc in the last ch,  
5 dc in ch on the opposite side,  
2 dc in the last ch (19)
- 2.) 2 dc inc, 7 dc, 2 dc inc x 3,  
7 dc, 2 dc inc (24)
- 3.) 2 dc inc x 2, 8 dc, 2 dc inc x 5,  
8 dc, 2 dc inc (32)
- 4.) 2 dc inc x 3, 11 dc, 2 dc inc x 5,  
12 dc, 2 dc inc (41)
5. - 6.) 41 dc (41)

Change to colour A.

- 7.) 1 dc in the bl in every dc (41)
- 8.) 18 dc, dc 2 tog x 4, 15 dc (37)
- 9.) dc 2 tog x 2, 13 dc,  
dc 2 tog x 3, 14 dc (32)
- 10.) 14 dc, dc 2 tog,  
1 dc, dc 2 tog, 13 dc (30)
- 11.) dc 2 tog, 10 dc, dc 2 tog x 3,  
10 dc, dc 2 tog (25)
- 12.) 9 dc, dc 2 tog, 3 dc, dc 2 tog, 9 dc (23)

The legs are sewn onto the 19 cm ring.

4. - 9.) 100 dc (50)
- 10.) \*dc 2 tog\* (50)
- 11.) 50 dc (50)

Use the thread to sew the ring together.



## RING 15 CM

Colour A.

- 1.) 45 ch, gather to a ring (45)
- 2.) 45 dc (90)
- 3.) \*2 dc inc\* (90)
4. - 9.) 90 dc (45)
- 10.) \*dc 2 tog\* (45)
- 11.) 45 dc (45)

Use the thread to sew the ring together.

A small spike is sewn on the outside of the ring.



## RING 14 CM

Colour A.

- 1.) 40 ch, gather to a ring (40)
- 2.) 40 dc (80)
- 3.) \*2 dc inc\* (80)
4. - 9.) 80 dc (40)
- 10.) \*dc 2 tog\* (40)
- 11.) 40 dc (40)

Use the thread to sew the ring together.

## WING X 2

Colour B.

- 1.) 10 ch, 3 htr, 3 dc, 3 sl st
- 2.) Crochet in bl: 3sl st, 3 dc, 3 htr
- 3.) 3 ch, 1 dc in the 2. st from the hook.  
Crochet in bl: 3 htr, 3 dc, 3 sl st
- 4.) as row 2
- 5.) as row 3

Use the threads to sew the wings onto the 14 cm ring.



## RING 13 CM

Colour A.

# Good to know

## Hook Size + Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us.

The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.



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
