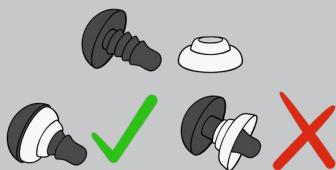
MATERIALS

Cube 8 x 8 cm
Eyes 6 mm
Squeaker 25 mm
Filling
Crochet hook for animal 2,5 mm
Crochet hook for cube 4,5 mm

*Gauge cube: 22 st/10 cm
Gauge animal: 34 dc/10 cm*

The specified yarn quantities are indicative and for one cube and one animal, if crocheted in one color of yarn.

Soft Bamboo "fine" & "double"



- a Bamboo yarn out of the ordinary

The yarn contains as much as 70% of bamboo, which adds an amazing softness and a special lightness to the yarn. Comfortable against the skin, so indeed a very child friendly product. The texture is silky with a beautiful drape.

Bambus and environment - Bamboo is the fastest growing plant in the world and thus a great source of sustainable production. Bamboo releases more oxygen than any other plant and is grown without the use of pesticides. 23% cotton and 7% acrylic add a good shape retention to the yarn.
Machine washable.

70% Bamboo/23% Cotton/7% Acrylic



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GUIDE:

The sides are crocheted in double crochet stitches, in combination with chain stitches, so the sides become square

The rear part and legs are the same for all animals. All animals have a squeaker in the rear part.

NOTE! The sides of the dice are crocheted in **two strands** of Soft Bamboo "double".

The animals are crocheted in **one strand** of Soft Bamboo "fine".

SAME FOR ALL ANIMALS

SIDES X 6

- 1.) mr, 3 ch, 2 tr, 1 ch,
3 tr, 1 ch x 3.
1 sl tr i 3. ch (beginning of each round)
2. - 4.) sl tr to the corner,
3 ch, 1 tr in the corner, 1 ch,
2 tr in the corner.
*tr to the next corner, 2 tr in the corner,
1 ch, 2 tr in the corner* x 4
1 sl st in 3. ch (beginning of each round)

The 6 squares are sewn together around the cube.

- 2.) 1 dc, 2 sl st, *2 dc inc* x 3, 2 sl st,
2 dc inc x 2 (15)
- 3.) 2 htr in the next st, 3 sl st,
2 htr in the next st, 3 dc,
2 htr in the next st, 3 sl st,
2 htr in the next st, 1 dc, 1 sl st (19)

Sew the spots onto the rear part.

TAIL

Cut 3 threads of 20 cm each. Thread them halfway through the middle stitch on the cow's rear part.

Make a braid of 3 cm and tie a knot.

Trim the tail to a length of 1 cm.

Thread them through one stitch so that they are folded in half.

Tie knots and trim the hair to the desired length.

TAIL

Cut 3 threads of 20 cm each. Thread them with their halfway point through one stitch on the giraffe's rear part.

Make a braid of 4 cm and tie a knot.
Trim the tail tuft to a length of 1 cm.

SPOTS X 4

- 1.) mr with 6 dc (6)
- 2.) *2 dc inc* (12)

Sew the spots on the rear part.

Crocheted in rows with brown

- 3.) 2 ch, 1 htr, 2 htr inc,
1 dc, 2 dc inc 3x, 1 sl st (12)

Snout and head

Start with brown

- 3.) *2 dc inc* 3 x, 3 dc,
2 dc inc 3 x, 3 dc (18)
- 4.) 2 dc, *2 dc inc* 2 x, 4 dc, 2 dc inc,
2 dc, *2 dc inc* 2 x, 4 dc, 2 dc inc (24)
- 5.) *3 dc, 2 dc inc* (30)
6. - 9.) 30 dc (30)

Switch to light brown.

- 10.) 6 dc, 2 dc inc, 3 dc, *2 dc inc,
2 dc* x 3, 2 dc inc, 3 dc,
2 dc inc, 6 dc (36)
- 11.) 7 dc, *2 dc inc, 3 dc* x 2,
2 dc inc, 4 dc, *2 dc inc, 3 dc* x 2,
2 dc inc, 7 dc (42)
- 12.) 9 dc, *2 dc inc, 4 dc* x 2,
2 dc inc, 2 dc, *2 dc inc,
4 dc* x 2, 2 dc inc, 9 dc (48)

Cut the thread, thread it through the stitches, and pull them together.

Sew the head onto the front side.

For the hair, cut several threads of 10 cm each.

Thread them through one stitch so that they are folded in half.

Tie knots and trim the hair to the desired length.

Sew the ears onto the head.

Cut a thread at 60 cm. Thread the needle with both ends of the thread. Sew through one stitch at the beginning of the tail. Pull the ends through the loop.

Sew through 12 stitches on the top side of the tail.

Finally, sew under the same stitch again to secure the thread.

Sew the tail onto the rear part.

Good to know

Hook Size + Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us.

The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.



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
