



# **KNITTING PATTERN**



**Sweater** 

Design: Knit Gang | Hobbii Design



### **MATERIALS**

6 (7) 7 (8) skeins of Highland Wool col. Wild Berry (35) 6 (7) 7 (8) skeins of Friends Kid Silk col. Maroon (49)

Knitting needles 5 mm (US 8) and 6 mm (US 10)
Circular needles 5 mm (US 8)

## **YARN QUALITY**

Tapestry needle for sewing

Highland Wool, Hobbii 100% Peruvian Highland Wool 50 g (1.75 oz) = 175 m (191 yards)

Friends Kid Silk, Hobbii 72% Mohair, 25% Silk, 3% Wool 25 g (0.9 oz) = 200 m (218 yds)

#### **GAUGE**

 $10 \text{ cm} \times 10 \text{ cm} (4'' \times 4'') = 18 \text{ sts} \times 24 \text{ rows}$ 

# **ABBREVIATIONS**

k = knit
p = purl
k2tog = 2 knit sts together
yo = yarn over
CO = cast on
BO = bind off
inc = increase

### SIZE

S(M)L(XL)

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Width: 58 (62) 66 (69) cm / 22.8 (24.4) 25.9 (27.1)" Length: 52 (56) 60 (64) cm / 20.4 (22) 23.6 (25.1)"

#### PATTERN INFORMATION

Beautiful, incredibly soft, warm sweater with a decorative bobbles design. It looks elegant and at the same time is very comfortable.

The sweater is worked straight, consists of separate parts sewn together at the end.

# **Pattern**







**INFO AND TIPS** 

Stitches used in the pattern:

Rib stitch: k2, p2.

**Stockinette stitch:** k on the right side, p on the wrong side.

**Bobble stitch (bs):** make 7 sts from 1 st: k, yo, k, yo, k, yo, k, then, work 5 rows of these sts

in stockinette stitch, in the 6th row knit all of these 7 sts together.

*Tip*- if it is difficult for you while making the bobble to pull the thread through these 7 sts, you can help yourself with a crochet hook or a thin knitting needle.

#### **FRONT PIECE**

With 5 mm knitting needles CO 98 (100) 108 (117) sts. Work 7 (11) 13 (17) rows in a rib stitch. In the next row of the rib inc evenly 7 (11) 9 (8) sts = 105 (111) 117 (125) sts.

Change to 6 mm needles and work 30 rows in a stockinette stitch.

In the 31st row, start to work the bobbles pattern: work 52 (55) 58 (62) sts in a stockinette stitch (knit sts), bs, k 52 (55) 58 (62). Work the next 7 rows in a stockinette stitch, and in the next row make 2 bobbles according to the chart.

Continue working increasing the number of bobbles. The space between the boobles is always 11 sts in a row, and 7 rows. Work this way 62 rows (S, M, L, XL) in a stockinette stitch. Now you will start to form a raglan: in the 63rd and 64th row BO the 4 (S, M, L), 5 (XL) first sts. From the 65th row work together 2 first and 2 last sts in every other row. In the 101st (107th) 107th (107th) row BO the middle 25 (S, M, L), 31 (XL) sts to form the neckline. In the next rows, continue the raglan, working 2 sts together in every other row, at the same time from the side of the middle BO sts, work 2 sts together to shape the neckline. Finish the front piece on the 118th (125th) 129th row.

#### **BACK PIECE**

Work the same way as the front piece.

### **SLEEVES**

With 5 mm needles CO 42 (46) 50 (52) sts. Work 8 (12) 14 (16) rows with a rib stitch. In the last row, inc 1 st (S, M, L, XL). Change to 6 mm needles and start to work in a stockinette



stitch, increasing 1 st on both sides of the sleeve in every 6th row. In the  $47^{th}$  (S, M, L),  $49^{th}$  (XL) row start to work the bobbles pattern: work 28 (30) 32 (34) sts in a stockinette stitch, bs, then, 28 (30) 32 (34) sts in a stockinette stitch. Continue to work the bobbles as on the front and back pieces according to the chart, keeping in mind that the space between the boobles is always 11 sts in a row, and 7 rows.

Continue working the sleeve, inc in each 6th row 1 st from both sides. In the 66th row you should have 65 (69) 73 (75) sts.

In the 67th and 68th row BO 4 (S, M, L), 5 (XL) first sts to form the raglan. From the 69th row work together 2 first and 2 last sts in every other row. The number of rows of raglan should be the same as in the front and back pieces.

## **FINISHING**

Sew all parts of the sweater on the wrong side with a mattress stitch. On the 5 mm circular needles pick up sts around the head opening. Work 6 rows in a rib stitch. Secure all ends.
