Sweater

MATERIALS

7 (7) 8 (9) skeins of Friends Kid Silk col. Nougat (09)

Knitting needles 4 mm (US 6), 3 mm (US 5) Circular needles 3 mm (US 5) Tapestry needle for sewing Cable needle

YARN QUALITY

Friends Kid Silk, Hobbii 72% Mohair, 25% Silk, 3% Wool 25 g (0.9 oz) = 120 m (218 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 22 sts x 32 rows Cable – 5 cm = 15 sts

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit

p = purl

CO = cast on

BO = bind off

inc = increase

SIZE

S (M) L (XL)

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 60 (64) 67 (72) cm / 23.6 (25.1) 26.3

(28.3)'

Length: 52 (55) 59 (64) cm / 20.4 (21.6) 23.2

(25.1)''

PATTERN INFORMATION

Outstanding, lightweight, soft sweater with cute cable pattern. Perfect for the mountain walk as well as for a romantic dinner at the restaurant.

The sweater is easy to make, as its simple form does not require advanced skills.

INFO AND TIPS

Stitches used in the pattern:

Rib stitch: k2, p2.

Stockinette stitch: k on the right side, p on the wrong side.

Cable: put 5 sts to the back on a cable needle, work 5 sts, then 5 sts from a cable needle, and work 5 sts. Work 5 rows in stockinette stitch and in the next row: work 5 sts, put 5 sts to the front on a cable needle, work 5 sts, then 5 sts from a cable needle. Work 5 rows in stockinette stitch. Repeat the entire sequence.

Work the sts in the row where the cable crosses, as a knit sts.

FRONT PIECE

With 3 mm knitting needles CO 134 (142) 150 (165) sts. Work 17 rows in a rib stitch.

In the next row inc 1 st every 6(7)7(7) sts = 159 (167) 175 (185) sts.

Change to 4 mm needles and start to work the cables.

The further rows will be counted from the end of the ribbing.

Work this way:

Row 1: 1 edge st, k 6 (10) 14 (19), p 1, k 15 (**cable**), p 1, k 15 (for stockinette stitch), p 1, k 15 (**cable**), p 1, k 15 (for stockinette stitch), p 1, k 15 (**cable**), p 1, k 15 (for stockinette stitch), p 1, k 15 (**cable**), p 1, k 15 (**cable**), p 1, k 6 (10) 14 (19), 1 edge st.

Row 2: purl the knit sts, and knit the purl sts.

Cross the braid for the first time in the 5th row. Then, work as it is written in the description of the cable, that is, in every 6th row.

Continue working up to the 140th (150th) 164th (174th) row.

In the next row start forming the neckline, BO the middle 30 sts (S, M, L, XL). Then, BO on both sides in every other row: 3 sts, 2 sts, 1 st (S, M, L, XL).

BO the remaining sts on the shoulders in the 156th (166th) 179th (187th) row.



BACK PIECE

With 3 mm knitting needles CO 134 (142) 150 (160) sts. Work 17 rows in a rib stitch.

In the next row of the ribbing, inc 1 st every 10 sts (S, M, L, XL).

Change to 4 mm needles and start to work in a stockinette stitch.

Continue working, BO all sts in the 156th (166th) 179th (187th) row.

SLEEVES

With 3 mm needles CO 62 (64) 64 (65) sts. Work 17 rows in a rib stitch. In the next row of the ribbing, inc 1 st every 6 sts (S, M, L, XL).

Change to 4 mm needles and start to work in a stockinette stitch and the cables.

Row 1: 1 edge st, k 26 (28) 28 (28)(for stockinette stitch), p 1, k 15 (cable), p 1, k 26 (28) 28 (28) (for stockinette stitch), 1 edge st.

Continue to work the sleeve increasing 1 st on both sides every 6 rows.

When the sleeve will be 48 (52) 54 (56) cm (with the ribbing), BO all the sts.

FINISHING

Sew the front and back piece on the shoulders with mattress stitch. Sew the sleeves, then sew the sides of the sweater and of the sleeves.

With circular needles 3 mm, pick up sts around the head opening and work 18 rows in a rib stitch. Fold the ribbing in half outward and sew it loosely all around. Secure all ends.
