# Gingerbread

# **MATERIALS**

1 skein of Pearly Haze color 10 – Yarn A 1 skein of Pearly Haze color 110 – Yarn B

Straight needle 4 mm (US 6) Straight needle 5 mm (US 8) Stuffing Stitch holder

# **YARN QUALITY**

Pearly Haze, Hobbii 73% Viscose, 27% Wool 50 g (1.75 oz) = 110 m (120 yds)

#### **GAUGE**

10 cm x 10 cm (4'' x 4'') = 20 sts x 30 rows

#### SIZE

One size

### **MEASUREMENTS**

Height: 23 cm / 9.06" with the loop Width: 15 cm / 5.91" arm to arm

# **PATTERN INFORMATION**

This great Christmas decoration is a very quick and easy projekt to make.

The gingerbread man is knitted in two parts then sewn together, the buttons, the loop and the candy cane are knitted separately.

# **ABBREVIATIONS**

**K** = knit

P = Purl

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**C/on** = Cast on

**C/off** = Cast off

**Kf&b** = knit in the front and then the back of the same stitch with the yarn at the back of the work

**Pf&b** = Purl in the front and then around the back of the same stitch with the yarn at the front of the work

**K2tog** = Knit the next two stitches together

**P2tog** = Purl the next two stitches together

**SKP** = Slip knitwise, Knit then pass the slip stitch over the knitted stitch

**SPP** = Slip purlwise, purl then pass the slip stitch over the purled stitch

**M1** = Make one stitch using the left needle and pick up the yarn before the next stitch from the front and knit it into the back

# MAN (MAKE 2)

#### First leg

\*C/on 3 sts on 5 mm (US 8) with yarn A

Row 1 – Kf&b, K1, Kf&b (5 sts)

Row 2 - P row

Row 3 - Kf&b, K3, Kf&b (7 sts)

Row 4 – P row

Row 5 - K row

Row 6 - P row

Repeat the last 2 rows 6 times \*\*

Leave all 7 sts on your stitch holder, cut the yarn and repeat for the second leg from \* to \*\*

Next row – K row then K7 from the stitch holder



You now have all your sts on the same needle (14 sts)

#### **Torso**

Next row - K row

Next row - P row

Repeat the last 2 rows 5 times

#### **Arms**

Next row - C/on 10 and K the row (24 sts)

Next row - C/on 10 and P the row (34 sts)

Next row - K2tog, K to the last 2 sts, SKP (32 sts)

Next row - P row

Repeat the last 2 rows once more (30 sts)

Next row – K2tog, C/off 9 (including the first K2tog) and K the row (20 sts)

Next row – P2tog, C/off 9 (including the first P2tog) and P the row (10 sts)

#### Head

Next row – K2tog, K to the last 2 sts, SKP (8 sts)

Next row - P2tog, P to the last 2 sts, SPP (6 sts)

Next row – Kf&b, K to the last st, Kf&b (8 sts)

Next row – Pf&b, P to the last st, Pf&b (10 sts)

Next row - K row

Next row - P row

Repeat the last 2 rows twice

Next row – K2tog, K to the last 2 sts, SKP (8 sts)

Next row - P row

Repeat the last 2 rows once more (6 sts)

Next row – K2tog, K to the last 2 sts, SKP (4 sts)

C/off all the 4 sts purlwise, cut the yarn and make secure

# **BUTTON (MAKE 3)**

C/on 3 sts on 4 mm (US 6) with yarn B

Row 1 – Kf&b, K1, Kf&b (5 sts)

Row 2 - Prow

Row 3 - K2tog, K1, K2tog (3 sts)

Thread through all 3 sts, cut the yarn and make secure



# **LOOP**

C/on 3 sts on 4 mm (US 6) with yarn B

Row 1 - K row

Row 2 - Move all the sts back on the left needle and K the row

Repeat those 2 rows until your lcord measure 14 cm / 5.51"

C/off all 3 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

# **CANDY CANE**

C/on 3 sts on 4 mm (US 6) with yarn B

Row 1 - K1, SKP, K2, M1, K1 with yarn B

Row 2 - K row with yarn B

Row 3 – K row with yarn A

Row 4 - K1, SKP, K2, M1, K1 with yarn A

Row 5 – K row with yarn B

Row 6 - K1, SKP, K2, M1, K1 with yarn B

Repeat row 3 to 6, six more times

C/off all remaining sts with B, cut the yarn and make secure

# **FINISHING UP**

Add the buttons by sewing each of them at equal distance on one side of the torso.

Sew the two torso sides all around the man together and stuff flat very lightly.

Curl the loop and fix at the top of the head.

Finally join the edging of the candy cane lengthwise, the candy should bend naturally. Then fix it to the body under the arm and at the side of the leg.

Weave in all ends
