Reindeer

Ornament

MATERIALS

Friends Extra Fine Merino

1 skein of color 07 – Yarn A

1 skein of color 04 – Yarn B

1 skein of color 12 - Yarn C

1 skein of color 40 – Yarn D

Straight needle 3.25 mm (US 3) Stuffing

YARN QUALITY

Friends Extra Fine Merino, Hobbii 100% Wool 50 g (1.75 oz) = 165 m (180 yds)

GAUGE

 $10 \text{ cm } \times 10 \text{ cm } (4'' \times 4'') = 30 \text{ sts } \times 40 \text{ rows}$

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Height: 17 cm / 6.69" with the loop Width: 12 cm / 4.72" arm to arm

PATTERN INFORMATION

This little reindeer ornament will look super cute on your tree for Christmas.

The reindeer is knitted flat in individual parts then sewn together.

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit

P = Purl

St(s) = Stitch(es)

C/on = Cast on

C/off = Cast off

Kf&b = knit in the front and then the back of the same stitch with the yarn at the back of the work

K2tog = Knit the next two stitches together

K3tog = Knit the next three stitches together

P2tog = Purl the next two stitches together

M1 = Make one stitch using the left needle and pick up the yarn before the next stitch from the front and knit it into the back

HEAD

C/on 10 sts with yarn A

Row 1 – (K1, Kf&b) repeat to the end of the row (15 sts)

Row 2 - Prow

Row 3 – (K1, Kf&b) repeat to the last st, K1 (22 sts)

Row 4 - P row

Row 5 - K row

Row 6 - Prow

Repeat the last 2 rows once more

Row 9 – (K2, Kf&b) repeat to the last st, K1 (29 sts)

Row 10 – P row

Row 11 – (K2, Kf&b) repeat to the last 2 sts, K2 (38 sts)

Row 12 - Prow

Row 13 - K row

Row 14 - P row

Row 15 – (K2tog) repeat to the end of the row (19 sts)

Row 16 - P row

Row 17 – (K2tog) repeat to the last 3 sts, K1, K2tog (10 sts)

Row 18 – (P2tog) x 5 (5 sts)



Thread through the remaining 5 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

BODY

Start from the neck down C/on 10 sts with yarn A

Row 1 - Prow

Row 2 – (K2, M1) repeat to the last 2 sts, K2 (14 sts)

Row 3 - Prow

Repeat the last 2 rows two more times (29 sts)

Now you will add yarn B as indicated to create the tummy It is easier to make a mini ball of yarn A when working the second section with yarn A

Row 8 - K12A, K5B, K12A

Row 9 - P11A, P7B, P11A

Row 10 - K10A, K9B, K10A

Row 11 - P10A, P9B, P10A

Repeat the last 2 rows two more times

Row 16 - K11A, K7B, K11A

Row 17 - P12A, P5B, P12A

Row 18 - K13A, K3B, K13A

Work this section with yarn A only

Row 19 - Prow

Row 20 – (K2, K2tog) repeat to the last st, K1 (22 sts)

Row 21 - Prow

Row 22 – (K2tog) repeat to the end of the row (11 sts)

C/off the remaining 11 sts purlwise cut the yarn and make secure

LEG (MAKE 4)

C/on 4 sts with yarn A

Row 1 - K row

Row 2 – Slip all your sts back to the left needle and K the row

Repeat the first 2 rows 6 more times

Change to yarn C

Next row - Kf&b, K2, Kf&b (6 sts)

Next row - Slip all your sts back to the left needle and Kf&b, K4, Kf&b (8 sts)

Next row - Slip all your sts back to the left needle and K the row

Next row – Slip all your sts back to the left needle and K the row

C/off the remaining 8 sts cut the yarn and make secure



EARS (MAKE 2)

The front of the ears is made with both colours which will be shown by the letter C/on 7 sts with yarn A

Row 1 - K2A, K3B, K2A

Row 2 - P2A, P3B, P2A

Repeat the last 2 rows one more time

Row 5 – K2tog A, K3tog B, K2tog A (3 sts)

Row 6 - P2tog A, slip the st back on the left needle, then P2tog A

C/off the remaining st, cut the yarn and make secure

The back of the ears are made with yarn A only C/on 7 sts with yarn A

Row 1 - K row

Row 2 - Prow

Repeat the last 2 rows one more time

Row 5 - K2tog, K3tog, K2tog (3 sts)

Row 6 – P2tog, slip the st back on the left needle, then P2tog

C/off the remaining st, cut the yarn and make secure

ANTLERS (MAKE 2)

C/on 3 sts with yarn C

Row 1 - K row, then slip all 3 sts back on the left needle

Repeat the first row 3 times

Row 5 – C/on 5 sts then c/off 4 sts, K2tog, K1, then slip all 3 sts back on the left needle Rows 6 to 8 – Repeat row 1 but don't slip the sts back on the left needle for the last row (row 8) Row 9 – TURN your work, c/on 5 sts then c/off 4 sts, K2tog, K1, then slip all 3 sts back on the left needle

Rows 10 to 12 - Repeat row 1

C/off the remaining 3 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

NOSE

C/on 3 sts with yarn D

Row 1 – Kf&b, K to the last st, Kf&b (5 sts)

Row 2 - P row

Repeat the last 2 rows one more time (7 sts)



Row 5 – K row

Row 6 – P row

Row 7 - K2tog, K3, K2tog (5 sts)

Row 8 – P row

Row 9 - K2tog, K1, K2tog (3 sts)

Thread through the remaining 3 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

SCARF

C/on 4 sts with yarn D

Row 1 - K row

Row 2 - Prow

Repeat the first 2 rows until your piece measure 12 cm / 4,72"

C/off the remaining 4 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

LOOP

C/on 3 sts with yarn A

Row 1 - K row

Row 2 – Slip all the sts back on the left needle and K the row

Repeat those 2 rows until your lcord measure 12 cm / 4.72"

C/off all 3 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

FINISHING UP

Head – Thread through the c/on edge and pull tight to create the nose then join the edging and stuff, finally close the opening. Embroider the eyes with yarn C using French knots.

Nose – Thread through around the edge and pull tight in a ball to create the nose, then attach to the head.

Ears – Join the front and back of each ear and stuff very lightly before attaching to the head.

Antlers – Attach to the head on the inside of the ears and stabilise them by sewing a few stitches to the side of the ears.

Body – Join the seams of the back, start stuffing as you go. Continue to the top of the body in the same way, then sew the head to it.

Legs - Attach all four to the body as per the picture.



Scarf – Attach it around the reindeer's neck and fix the overlap with a stitch or two.

Loop – Fold in half and sew it in between the two antlers ready for the tree.

Weave in all ends
