



KNITTING PATTERN

Elf

Ornament

MATERIALS

Friends Cotton 8/4

1 skein col. 05 – Yarn A
1 skein col. 40 – Yarn B
1 skein col. 105 – Yarn C
1 skein color 10 – Yarn D

Straight needle 2.75 mm (US 2)
Stuffing

YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Cotton 8/4**, Hobbii
100% Cotton
50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (175 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 28 sts x 46 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit
P = Purl
St(s) = Stitch(es)
C/on = Cast on
C/off = Cast off
Kf&b = knit in the front and then the back
of the same stitch with the yarn at the back
of the work
K2tog = Knit the next two stitches together

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Height: 20 cm / 7.87" with the loop
Width: 10 cm / 3.94" arm to arm

PATTERN INFORMATION

A super cute little elf Christmas ornament to decorate your tree.

The elf ornament is knitted flat in individual parts then sewn together.

Pattern



HEAD

C/on 10 sts with yarn A

Row 1 – (Kf&b) repeat to the end of the row (20 sts)

Row 2 – K row

Row 3 – P row

Repeat the last two rows 4 times

Row 12 – (K2tog) repeat to the end of the row (10 sts)

C/off the remaining 10 sts, cut the yarn and make secure.

DRESS

C/on 13 sts with yarn C

Row 1 – Kf&b, K to the last st, Kf&b (15 sts)

Row 2 – P row

Repeat the first two rows 13 times (41 sts)

Next row – K3, c/off 1, (K6, c/off 1) x 4, K4 (when you K6 you already have 1 st from the c/off on the right needle) (36 sts)

You are now going to work in section of 6 sts:

Next row – C/off 3, P6, TURN

Next row – K2tog, K2, K2tog, TURN (4 sts)

Next row – P row, TURN

Next row – (K2tog) x 2, TURN (2 sts)

Next row – P row, TURN

Next row – K2tog

C/off the st, cut the yarn and make secure

Repeat the last six rows 4 more times

C/off the remaining 3 st, cut the yarn and make secure

ARM (MAKE 2)

C/on 3 sts with yarn C

Row 1 – K row

Row 2 – Slip all your sts back to the left needle and K the row

Repeat the first two rows 4 more times

Change to yarn A

Row 11 – K row

Row 12 – Slip all your sts back to the left needle and K the row

Row 13 – Slip all your sts back to the left needle and K the row

C/off the remaining 3 sts, cut the yarn and make secure.

LEG (MAKE 2)

C/on 5 sts with yarn A (then switch between yarn A and B every 2 rows)

Row 1 – K row

Row 2 – Slip all your sts back to the left needle and K the row

Change to yarn B

Row 3 – K row

Row 4 – Slip all your sts back to the left needle and K the row

Repeat the first four rows 6 more times

Change to yarn A

Next row – K row

Next row – Slip all your sts back to the left needle and K the row

Change to yarn C to make the shoe

Next row – Slip all your sts back to the left needle and K the row

Next row – Slip all your sts back to the left needle and K1 with yarn C, K3 with yarn A, K1 with yarn C

Next row – Slip all your sts back to the left needle and K the row with yarn C only

Repeat the last row 3 more times

C/off the remaining 5 st, cut the yarn and make secure

HAT

C/on 22 sts with yarn B

Row 1 – P row

Row 2 – P row

Change to yarn C

Row 3 – K row

Row 4 – P row

Repeat the last two rows 2 more times

Row 9 – K2tog, K to the last 2 sts, K2tog

Row 10 – P row

Repeat the last 2 rows until you have 4 sts left

Thread through the remaining 4 sts, cut the yarn and leave a long tail to sew the hat and make secure

POMPOM FOR THE HAT

C/on 3 sts with yarn B

Row 1 – Kf&b, K to the last st, Kf&b (5 sts)

Row 2 – P row

Row 3 – K2tog, K1, K2tog (3 sts)

Row 4 – P row

Thread through the remaining 3 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

COLLAR

C/on 3 sts with yarn B

Row 1 – K2, Kf&b (4 sts)

Row 2 – Kf&b, K3 (5 sts)

Row 3 – K4, Kf&b (6 sts)

Row 4 – K2tog, K4 (5 sts)

Row 5 – K3, K2tog (4 sts)

Row 6 – K2tog, K2 (3 sts)

Repeat these six rows 4 times

C/off the remaining 3 st, cut the yarn and make secure

LOOP

C/on 3 sts with yarn D

Row 1 – K row

Row 2 – Slip all the sts back on the left needle and K the row

Repeat those 2 rows until your lcord measure 13 cm / 5.12"

C/off all 3 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

FINISHING UP

Head – Thread through the c/on edge and pull, sew the back of the head and stuff, finally close the opening.

Hair – Cut 6 strands of yarn D measuring 15 cm / 5.9" each.
With a tapestry needle insert 3 strands on each side of the head, make 2 plats (in group of 2) then add ties with yarn B.

Hat – Join the seams at the back and sew the pompom at the end. Fix the hat to the head, then fold the pointing bit of the hat down on the side and sew it in place.

Dress – Join the seams at the back and at the same time attach the top of the legs at the collar level.

Arms – Sew the arms to the side of the body.

Collar – Add the collar at the neck and fix it to the dress.

Loop – Fold the loop and attach it at the top of the hat.

Weave in all ends
