Owl

Ornament

MATERIALS

Friends Wool

1 skein of color 10 – Yarn A
1 skein of color 09 – Yarn B
1 skein of color 40 – Yarn C
1 skein of color 02 – Yarn D
1 skein of color 24 – Yarn E

Straight needle 4 mm (US 6)
Stuffing
Safety eyes 8mm

YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Wool**, Hobbii
100% Wool
50 g (1.75 oz) = 100 m (109 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 23 sts x 30 rows

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Height: 17 cm / 6.69" with the loop
Width: 7 cm / 2.76"

PATTERN INFORMATION

The little owl ornament will look super cute on your tree during Christmas
The owl is knitted in individual parts then stuffed and sewn together.

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit

P = Purl

St(s) = Stitch(es)

C/on = Cast on

C/off = Cast off

Kf&b = knit in the front and then the back of the same stitch with the yarn at the back of the work

K2tog = Knit the next two stitches together

P2tog = Purl the next two stitches together

HEAD

C/on 8 sts with yarn A

Row 1 – P row

Row 2 – (Kf&b) repeat to the end of the row (16 sts)

Row 3 – P row

Row 4 – (Kf&b) repeat to the end of the row (32 sts)

Row 5 – P row

You are now going to mix the colours, which are notified by the letter

Row 6 – K12A, K3B, K2A, K3B, K12A

Row 7 – P11A, P4B, P2A, P4B, P11A

You might find it easier to start a second ball of yarn A for the second part here

Row 8 – K10A, K12B, K10A

Row 9 – P10A, P12B, P10A

Repeat the last 2 rows once

Row 12 – K11A, K10B, K11A

Row 13 – P12A, P8B, P12A

Row 14 – K13A, K2B, K2A, K2B, K13A

Row 15 – P row with yarn A only

Row 16 – (K2tog) repeat to the end of the row (16 sts)

Row 17 – P row

Row 18 – (K2tog) repeat to the end of the row (8 sts)

Thread through the remaining 8 sts, cut the yarn and make secure.

EYE (MAKE 2)

C/on 3 sts with yarn D

Row 1 – (Kf&b) repeat to the end of the row (6 sts)

Row 2 – Kf&b, K4, Kf&b (8 sts)

Row 3 – K row

Repeat the last row once

Row 5 – K2tog, K4, K2tog (6 sts)

Row 6 – (K2tog) repeat to the end of the row (3 sts)

Thread through the remaining 3 sts, cut the yarn and make secure.

BODY

Start from the neck down

C/on 10 sts with yarn A

Row 1 – P row

Row 2 – (Kf&b) repeat to the end of the row (20 sts)

Row 3 – P row

Row 4 – (Kf&b) repeat to the end of the row (40 sts)

Row 5 – P row

Row 6 – K row

Row 7 – P row

You are now going to mix the colours, which are notified by the letter

You might find it easier to start a second ball of yarn A for the second part here

Row 8 – K16A, K8B, K16A

Row 9 – P15A, P10B, P15A

Row 10 – K14A, K12B, K14A

Row 11 – P13A, P14B, P13A

Row 12 – K13A, K14B, K13A

Row 13 – P13A, P14B, P13A

Repeat the last 2 rows 4 more times

Row 22 – K15A, K10B, K15A

Row 23 – P16A, P8B, P16A

Work this section with yarn A only

Row 24 – K row

Row 25 – P row

Row 26 – (K2tog) repeat to the end of the row (20 sts)

Row 27 – (P2tog) repeat to the end of the row (10 sts)

Thread through the remaining 10 sts, cut the yarn and make secure.

SCARF

C/on 3 sts with yarn C

Row 1 – K row
Row 2 – K row

Change to yarn D
Row 3 – K row
Row 4 – K row

Repeat those 4 rows until the piece measure 23 cm / 9.06", finishing with yarn C.
C/off the remaining 3 sts with yarn C, cut the yarn and make secure.

HAT

C/on 34 sts with yarn D

Row 1 – K row
Row 2 – K row

Change to yarn C
Row 3 – K row
Row 4 – P row

Repeat the last 2 rows one more time

Row 7 – (K4, K2tog) x 5, K4 (29 sts)
Row 8 – P row
Row 9 – K row
Row 10 – P row
Row 11 – (K3, K2tog) x 5, K4 (24 sts)
Row 12 – P row
Row 13 – K row
Row 14 – P row
Row 15 – (K2, K2tog) x 6 (18 sts)
Row 16 – P row
Row 17 – K row
Row 18 – P row
Row 19 – (K1, K2tog) x 6 (12 sts)
Row 20 – P row
Row 21 – K row
Row 22 – P row
Row 23 – (K2tog) x 6 (6 sts)
Row 24 – P row
Row 25 – K row
Row 26 – P row
Row 27 – (K2tog) x 3 (3 sts)
Row 28 – P row

Thread through the remaining 3 sts, cut the yarn and make secure.

POMPOM FOR THE HAT

C/on 3 sts with yarn D

Row 1 – Kf&b, K to the last st, Kf&b (5 sts)

Row 2 – P row

Repeat the last 2 rows one more time (7 sts)

Row 5 – K2tog, K3, K2tog (5 sts)

Row 6 – P row

Row 7 – K2tog, K1, K2tog (3 sts)

Thread through the remaining 3 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

FOOT (MAKE 2)

C/on 6 sts with yarn E

Row 1 – K row

Repeat row 1 twice

Row 4 – K2, TURN

Repeat the last row 3 times

C/off the remaining 2 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Rejoin the other 4 sts

Next row – K2, TURN

Repeat the last row 3 times

C/off the remaining 2 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Rejoin the last 2 sts

Next row – K2, TURN

Repeat the last row 3 times

C/off the remaining 2 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

LOOP

C/on 3 sts with yarn D

Row 1 – K row

Row 2 – Slip all the sts back on the left needle and K the row

Repeat those 2 rows until your lcord measure 15 cm / 5.91"

C/off all 3 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

FINISHING UP

Eyes – Push the safety eyes through the middle of the knitted eye pieces and fix them directly to the head. Make sure the head is the right way up as per the picture.

Head – Thread through the c/on edge and pull tight then join the edging and stuff, finally close the opening. Sew the eyes to the face and add two little lines between the eyes with yarn E for the beak.

Body – Join the seams at the back, start stuffing as you go. Continue to the top of the body in the same way, then sew the head to it.

Feet – Attach both feet to the body as per the picture.

Scarf – For the fringe, cut 10 strands of yarn D measuring 11 cm / 4.33" each. Thread through five fringes at each end of the scarf as a loop and pull through to tighten them. Finish by giving them a cut and put it on your owl.

Hat – Join the seams at the back and add the pompom at the end. Attach the hat to the head.

Loop – Fold in half and sew it at the top of the head ready for the tree.

Weave in all ends
