



CROCHET PATTERN

Hard Candy

Ornament

MATERIALS

Flash it! from Hobbii

1 skein of color 3

1 skein of color 6

1 skein of color 8

1 skein of color 11

Crochet hook 5 mm (US H/8) Filling 100 g - Hobbii Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

Flash it!, Hobbii 80 % Viscose, 20 % Metallic fiber 50 g / 1.75 oz. = 90 m / 98 yds

GAUGE

17 sts x 8 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4'' x 4''

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

st = stitch

sp = space

ss = slip stitch

sc = single crochet

hdc = half double crochet

dc = double crochet

5 dc pc = popcorn stitch composed of 5

double crochet stitches

6 dc pc = popcorn stitch composed of 6

double crochet stitches

blo = back loop only

flo = front loop only

[] denote that the stitches are worked into

the same stitch

 $\{\,\}$ denote that the stitches are repeated later

in the round

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 9 cm / 3.5" Length: 11.5 cm / 4.5"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Since Hobbii's theme for Christmas 2023 is Candyland Christmas, we have created multiple patterns that are inspired by old fashioned Christmas candies. This one is inspired by the round hard candies. Popcorn stitches are used to add some texture. The front and back sides are identical, so it is simple to join. A small amount of filling is placed inside the ornament.

INFO AND TIPS

To make this ornament 3 dimensional, we will sometimes only work into the front loops or the back loops of previous rounds. The front and back sides of the ornament are identical, so it is simple to join. It is joined with a single crochet stitch, and a small amount of filling is placed inside.







How to crochet a popcorn stitch

Begin by crocheting 6 dc sts into the same st. Then, remove the hook from the work. Insert the hook into the front loop only of the first dc of the 6 dc sts (picture 1). Pull the working loop through to complete the st (pictures 2 and 3).

The first popcorn stitch of a round is a little bit different. The ch 2 at the beginning of the round + a popcorn st composed of 5 dc sts counts as the first 6 dc pc.

FRONT PIECE

Begin with a magic circle.

Round 1: Ch 3 (does not count as a st), 12 dc into the magic circle. Close the magic circle. Ss into the blo of the first dc st. (12).

Round 2: For this round, we will work into the blo of the sts of round 1. [Ch 1 (does not count as a st), 2 sc into the blo]. In each of the following sts, [2 sc into the blo]. Ss into the first sc st. (24).



Round 3: For this round, we will work into the flo of the sts of round 1. Ss into the flo of the first dc st of round 1. [Ch 2 + 5 dc pc (counts as first 6 dc pc), ch 1]. { [6 dc pc into the flo, ch 1] }. Repeat {} 10 more times. Ss into the top of the first pc. (12 pc sts + 12 ch-sps). Round 4: For this round, we will work into the tops of the pc sts and the ch-sps of round 3. [Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), hdc], hdc into the ch-sp. { [2 hdc] into the top of the next pc st. Hdc into the next ch-sp}. Repeat {} 10 more times. Ss into the top of the ch 2 and fasten off. (36).

BACK PIECE

Follow the same instructions as the front piece.

JOINING

To join the ornament, hold the front and back pieces together with the right sides facing out.







Insert the hook through a hdc st of the front side and the back side and pull the yarn through. Then, work one sc st into each set of corresponding hdc sts of the front and back sides. However, into one set of corresponding hdc sts, [sc, ch 12, ss into the first ch of the ch 12, sc] to add the hanging loop.

When about half of the ornament is joined, insert a small amount of filling inside, and continue joining. At the end of the round, ss into the first sc st, and fasten off.
