



CROCHET PATTERN

Ribbon Candy

Ornament

MATERIALS

Panettone

1 skein of color 4, 7, 17

Crochet hook 3.5 mm (US E/4)

Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Panettone**, Hobbii

87% Cotton, 7% Polyamide, 6% Metallic fiber

50 g (1.75 oz) = 120 m (131 yds)

GAUGE

20 sts x 9 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

st = stitch

sp = space

ss = slip stitch

sc = single crochet

hdc = half double crochet

tr = treble

flo = front loop only

blo = back loop only

[] denote that the stitches are worked into the same stitch

{ } denote that the stitches are repeated later in the round

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 2.5 cm / 1"

Length: 9 cm / 3.5"

PATTERN INFORMATION

This pattern is inspired by ribbon candy. One color of the Panettone yarn is used to make each ornament. The pattern includes some pictures to explain how to create the shape of the ribbon candy.

INFO AND TIPS

These ribbon candy ornaments are each made using one color of the Panettone yarn. During some rows, we will work into the sts of the previous row as well as the sts of another previous row. This creates the loops of the ribbon candy.



During row 5, we will work into the sts of row 4 as well as the ch-sps at the bases of the sts of row 1. To do so, simply insert the hook into a st of row 4 and the ch-sp at the base of the tr st of row 1 that corresponds to it (picture 1), and work a sc st. At the end of row 5, we will have completed the first loop of the ribbon candy (picture 2).



During row 11, insert the hook into a st from the previous row as well as the back loop of the corresponding hdc st from row 6 (picture 3), and work a sc st. At the end of row 11, we will have completed the second loop of the ribbon candy (picture 4).

ORNAMENT PATTERN

Ch 9.

Row 1: Skip the first 4 ch-sps (count as first tr), tr into each of the following 5 ch-sps. Flip. (6).

Row 2: Ch 4 (counts as first tr throughout), tr into each of the following sts. Flip. (6).

Row 3: Same as row 2.

Row 4: [Ch 1 (does not count as a st), sc], sc into each of the following sts. Flip. (6).

Row 5: Ch 1 (does not count as a st). {Insert your hook into the st of the previous row as well as the ch-sp at the base of the corresponding tr st of row 1. Sc}. Repeat {} with the following 5 sts. Flip. (6).

Row 6: [Ch 2 (does not count as a st), hdc]. Hdc into each of the following sts. Flip. (6).

Row 7: Ch 4, tr into the flo of the following sts. Flip. (6).

Row 8: Ch 4, tr into the following sts. Flip. (6).

Row 9: Same as row 8.

Row 10: [Ch 1 (does not count as a st), sc], sc into the following sts. Flip. (6).

Row 11: Ch 1 (does not count as a st), {Insert your hook into the st from the previous row as well as the back loop of the corresponding hdc st from row 6. Sc}. Repeat {} with the following 5 sts. Flip. (6).

Repeat rows 6-11 two more times to create the other two loops of the ribbon candy (however, when repeating row 11, insert the hook into the back loops of the row of hdc sts that is closest to it- not the original row 6).

Continue to repeat rows 6-11 if you would like to add more loops to the ribbon candy.

To add the hanging loop, during the last row, after the first 3 sc sts, ch 15, ss into the first ch of the ch 15, then work the remaining 3 sc sts as normal.
