Swirl

Ornament

MATERIALS

Panettone

1 skein of 1, 4, 7, 17

Crochet hook 3.5 mm (US E/4)

Filling 100 g - Hobbii

Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Panettone**, Hobbii

87% Cotton, 7% Polyamide, 6% Metallic fiber

50 g (1.75 oz) = 120 m (131 yds)

GAUGE

20 sts x 9 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

st = stitch

sp = space

ss = slip stitch

sc = single crochet

hdc = half double crochet

dc = double crochet

cc = change color

[] denote that the stitches are worked into the same stitch

{ } denote that the stitches are repeated later in the round

* also denotes that the stitches are repeated later in the round

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 10 cm / 4"

Length: 12.7 cm / 5"

PATTERN INFORMATION

This pattern is inspired by swirled candies. They are each made using two colors of the Panettone yarn. The pattern explains how to change color to create the swirl as well as some pictures to explain the steps. The front and back sides are identical, so they are simple to join. A small amount of filling is placed inside the ornament.

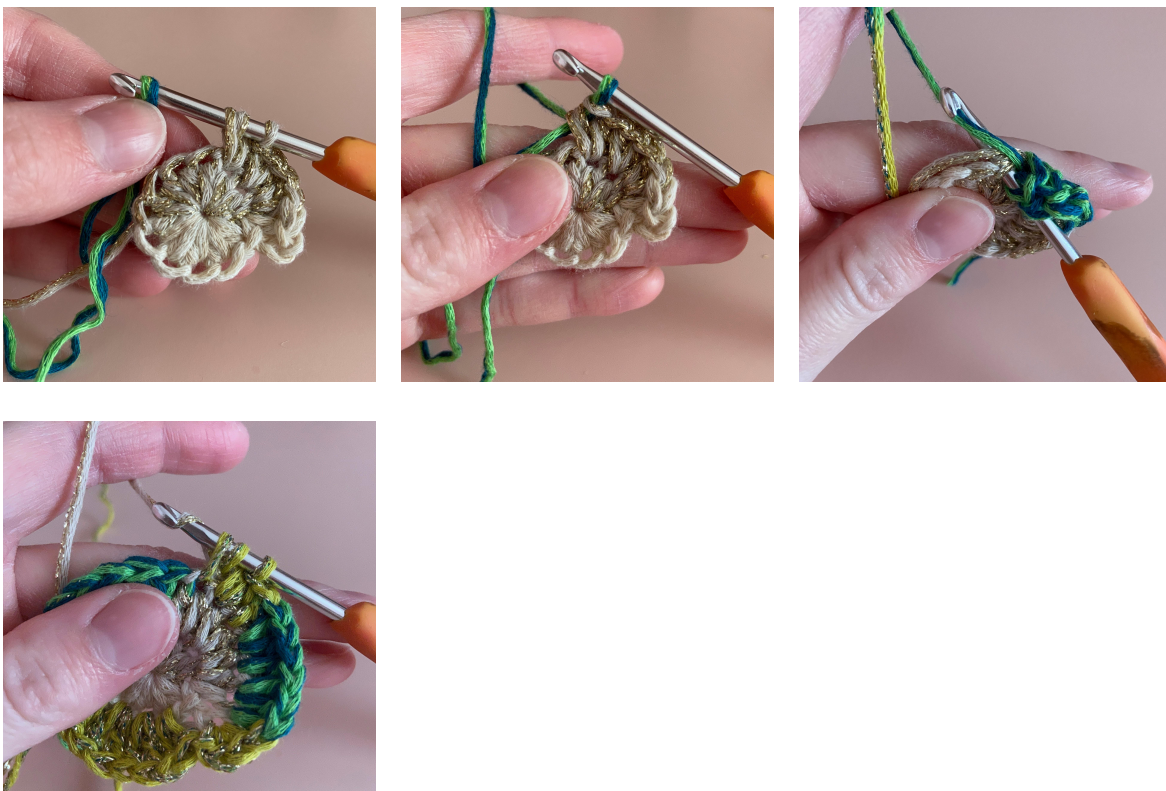

INFO AND TIPS

To create the swirl, tapestry crochet is used to change color within the round. The front and back sides of the ornament are identical, so it is simple to join. It is joined with a single crochet stitch, and a small amount of filling is placed inside.



How to Change Color

When the pattern says, "cc to", use the new color to complete the final "yarn over, pull through" of the st that comes before it (pictures 1 and 2). Then, hold the previous color against the back of the work while crocheting with the new color (picture 3). When it is time to change color again, use the previous color to complete the final "yarn over, pull through" of the st that comes before the color change, and then, hold the other color against the back of the work (picture 4).

FRONT PIECE

A refers to the background color, and B refers to the color of the swirl. I made 3 ornaments, and used color 1 for yarn A. I used colors 4, 7, and 17 for yarn B.

With yarn A, begin with a magic circle.

Round 1: Ch 2 (counts as the first hdc throughout), 11 hdc into the magic circle. Close the magic circle, and ss into the top of the ch 2. (12).

Round 2: [Ch 2, hdc]. In each of the following 3 sts, [2 hdc]. Cc to B. In each of the following 8 sts, [2 dc]. Then, ss into the top of the ch 2. (24).

Round 3: [Ch 1 (does not count as a st), 2 sc], hdc. { [2 hdc], hdc}. Repeat {} 2 more times. Cc to A. * [2 sc], sc.* Repeat from * to * 7 more times. Ss into the first sc. (36).

Round 4: [Ch 1 (does not count as a st), 2 sc], 2 sc. { [2 sc], 2 sc}. Repeat {} 2 more times. Cc to B. [2 sc], 2 hdc. *[2 hdc], 2 hdc.* Repeat from * to * 6 more times. Cc to A, ss into the first sc, and fasten off yarn B. (48).

Round 5: [Ch 1 (does not count as a st), sc], [2 sc]. {5 sc, [2 sc]}. Repeat {} 6 more times. 4 sc. Ss into the top of the first sc, and fasten off. (56).



BACK PIECE

Follow the same instructions as the front piece.

JOINING

To join the ornament, hold the front and back pieces together with the right sides facing out. Insert the hook through a st of the front side and the back side and pull the yarn through. Then, work one sc st into each set of corresponding sts of the front and back sides. However, into one set of corresponding sts, [sc, ch 15, ss into the first ch of the ch 15, sc] to add the hanging loop.

When about half of the ornament is joined, insert a small amount of filling inside, and continue joining. At the end of the round, ss into the first sc st, and fasten off.
