



CROCHET PATTERN

Citrus

Ornament

MATERIALS

Friends Cotton 8/4:

1 skein of color 4, 22, 104

Crochet hook 3.0 mm (US D/3)

Filling 100 g - Hobbii

Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Cotton 8/4**, Hobbii

100 % cotton

50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (175 yds)

GAUGE

22 sts x 10 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

st = stitch

sp = space

ss = slip stitch

sc = single crochet

hdc = half double crochet

dc = double crochet

tr = treble

cc = change color

[] denote that the stitches are worked into the same stitch

{ } denote that the stitches are repeated later in the round

SIZE

One size

For the measurements below, the citrus ornament is in parenthesis, and the slice of a citrus ornament is not.

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 7.6 (10) cm / 3" (4")

Length: 10 (9) cm / 4" (3.5")

PATTERN INFORMATION

This pattern is inspired by citrus hard candies. One ornament resembles a citrus fruit, and the other ornament is a slice of the citrus fruit. The pattern includes pictures to explain how to change color and join the ornaments. The front and back sides of the ornaments are identical, so they are simple to join. I used yellow and green yarn to create lemon and lime ornaments, but additional colors could be used to create oranges, grapefruit, etc.

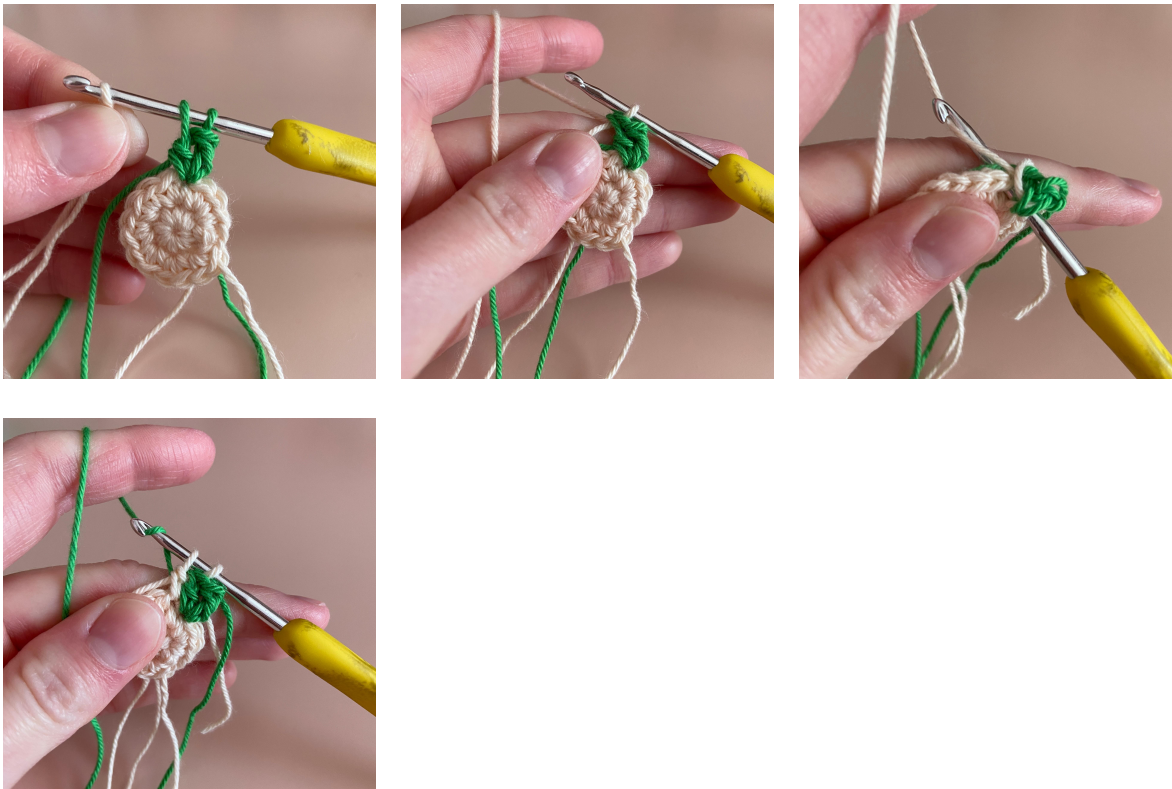

INFO AND TIPS

This pattern includes instructions to make two candy inspired ornaments: a citrus fruit and a slice of a citrus fruit. I used yellow and green yarn to create lemon and lime ornaments; however, orange could also be used to create an orange ornament. For both ornaments, the front and back sides are identical, so they are simple to join. A little bit of colorwork is required.



How to Change Color

When the pattern says, "cc to", use the new color to complete the final "yarn over, pull through" of the st that comes before it (pictures 1 and 2). Then, hold the previous color against the back of the work while crocheting with the new color (picture 3). When it is time to change color

again, use the previous color to complete the final “yarn over, pull through” of the st that comes before the color change, and then, hold the other color against the back of the work (picture 4).

SLICE OF A CITRUS ORNAMENT

A refers to the cream yarn (color 4), and B refers to the color of the citrus. To make a lemon ornament, I used color 22 for B, and for the lime, I used color 104 for B.

Front side

With yarn A, begin with a magic circle.

Round 1: 8 sc into the magic circle. Close the magic circle. Ss into the first sc. (8).

Round 2: [Ch 1 (does not count as a st), 2 sc]. [2 sc] into each of the following sts of the previous round. Ss into the first sc and fasten off. (16).

Round 3: Join yarn B into any st of the previous round. [Ch 3 (counts as first dc throughout), dc], cc to A, dc, cc to B, { [2 dc], cc to A, dc, cc to B}. Repeat {} 6 more times. Ss into the top of the ch 3. (24).

Round 4: [Ch 3, dc], dc, cc to A, dc, {cc to B, [2 dc], dc, cc to A, dc}. Repeat {} 6 more times. Ss into the top of the ch 3 (with yarn A and fasten off yarn B). (32).

Round 5: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc throughout), [2 hdc]. {3 hdc, [2 hdc]}. Repeat {} 6 more times. 2 hdc. Ss into the top of the ch 2 and fasten off. (40).

Back side

Follow the same instructions as the front side.

Joining



To join the ornament, hold the front and back pieces together with the right sides facing out (try to align the stripes of the two sides). Insert the hook through a st of the front side and the back side and pull yarn B through. Then, work one sc st into each set of corresponding sts of the front and back sides. However, into one set of corresponding sts, [sc, ch 20, ss into the first ch of the ch 20, sc] to add the hanging loop.

When about half of the ornament is joined, insert a small amount of filling inside, and continue joining. At the end of the round, ss into the first sc st, and fasten off.

CITRUS ORNAMENT

A refers to the color of the citrus and B refers to the cream yarn (color 4). To make a lemon ornament, I used color 22 for A, and for the lime, I used color 104 for A.

Front side

With yarn A, ch 4, ss into the first ch to create a ring.

Round 1: Ch 3 (counts as first dc throughout), 3 dc. Cc to B. 6 dc. Cc to A. 2 dc. Ss into the top of the ch 3. (12).

Round 2: [Ch 3, dc]. In the next 3 sts, [2 dc] into each of them. Cc to B. In the next 6 sts, [2 dc] into each of them. Cc to A. [2 dc], [2 dc]. Ss into the top of the ch 3. (24).

Round 3: [Ch 1 (does not count as a st), sc], 3 sc, [2 sc], sc, [2 hdc], [dc, tr]. Cc to B. [Tr, dc], [2 hdc], sc, [2 sc], 4 sc, [2 sc], sc, [2 hdc], [dc, tr]. Cc to A. [Tr, dc], [2 hdc], sc, [2 sc]. Ss into the first sc. (36).

Round 4: [Ch 1 (does not count as a st), sc], 5 sc, [2 sc], 2 sc, [2 hdc], [dc, tr]. Cc to B. [Tr, dc], [2 hdc], 2 sc, [2 sc], 8 sc, [2 sc], 2 sc, [2 hdc], [dc, tr]. Cc to A. [Tr, dc], [2 hdc], 2 sc, [2 sc], 2 sc. Ss into the first sc, and fasten off. (48).

Back side

Follow the same instructions as the front side.

Joining



To join the ornament, hold the front and back pieces together with the right sides facing out (make sure to align the cream sections and the cream sections will become the top of the ornament). Insert the hook through the second cream st from the far-right side of the last round of the front side and the back side and pull yarn A through. Then, we will work into the corresponding sts of the front and back sides as we did with the slice of a citrus ornament. [Ch 1 (does not count as a st), sc], 9 sc. [Sc, ch 20, ss into the first ch of the ch 20, sc], 12 sc. Ch 3, sc into the first ch of the ch 3. Place a small amount of filling inside. 24 sc. Ch 3, sc into the first ch of the ch 3. Sc. Ss into the first sc and fasten off.
