Santa Claus

Ornament

MATERIALS

Friends Cotton 8/4:

1 x Tomato [40] as **yarn A**

1 x Baby Blue [75] as **yarn B**

1 x Rose [44] as **yarn C**

Glitter Deluxe, Go Handmade:

1 x Winter Red [18125] as **yarn D**

1 x Ice Blue [18131] as **yarn E**

Crochet hook 4 mm (US G-6)

Scissors

Yarn needle

Hobbii Colored bells:

2 x 10mm

1 x 14mm

Optional - for stiffening:

White PVA glue and soft brush

Pins and blocking board or foam tiles

YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Cotton 8/4**, Hobbii

100% cotton

50 g / 1.7 oz = 160 m / 175 yds

Glitter Deluxe, Go Handmade

100 % polyester

30 g / 1.1 oz = 1800-2100 m /1950-2300 yds

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 11 cm /4.3"

Length: 18.5 cm / 7.1"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Simple but eye catching!

This triangular decoration is very simple to execute. The only complicated part turns out to be the Santa Claus' body, which is composed of three small trapezoidal elements joined together using the join-as-you-go method (or JAYG). This technique, when used, is indicated by slip stitches written in bold (**sl st**) in the pattern.

ABBREVIATIONS

- ch = chain
- st (s) = stitch (es)
- sl st (s) = slip stitch (es)
- sc = single crochet
- dc = double crochet
- dc2tog = double crochet two together (decrease stitch)
- sl st** = joining slip stitch
- RS = right side
- WS = wrong side

INFO AND TIPS

It's important to remember that the work involves the use of two threads (Friends Cotton 8/4 and Glitter Deluxe) together to crochet the body, beard and hat. The only exception is the face, where the cotton yarn is used alone.

PATTERN STARTS:

BODY

As already mentioned, the body is made of three separated elements, joined together as you go. The first trapezoid is on the left (in red), the second one is central (in pale blue) and the third trapezoid (in red) is on the right (see schematic).

First trapezoid

Using a 4mm hook and both **yarn A** and **yarn D**, ch10, wrap yarn around hook and insert it in 3rd chain from hook.

Row 1 (RS): 8dc, turn. [8sts]

Row 2 (WS): 2ch (doesn't count as a st here and throughout), 6dc, dc2tog, turn. [7sts]

Row 3: 2ch, 5dc, dc2tog, turn. [6 sts]

Row 4: 2ch, 4dc, dc2tog, turn. [5 sts]

Row 5: 2ch, 3dc, dc2tog, turn. [4 sts]

Row 6: 2ch, 2dc, dc2tog, fasten off and turn to RS. [3 sts]



The picture on the left shows the first trapezoid.

The picture on the right shows the joining between the second and the first trapezoids.

Second trapezoid and joining to first one

This piece will be joined to the previous one using the JAYG method, through basic slip stitches (in bold in the written pattern). All the joinings happen on the RS of both trapezoids.

Using a 4mm hook and both **yarn B** and **yarn E**, **sl st** in bottom of first dc of row 1 of first trapezoid, ch5, wrap yarn around hook and insert it in 3rd chain from hook.

Row 1 (RS): 3dc, **sl st** in top of first dc of row 1 of first trapezoid, 2ch, **sl st** in top of first dc of row 2 of first trapezoid, turn. [3 sts]

Row 2 (WS): 2dc, 2dc in last st, turn. [4 sts]

Row 3: 2ch (doesn't count as a st here and throughout), 3dc, 2dc in last st, **sl st** in top of first dc of row 3 of first trapezoid, 2ch, **sl st** in top of first dc of row 4 of first trapezoid, turn. [5 sts]

Row 4: 4dc, 2dc in last st, turn. [6 sts]

Row 5: 2ch, 5dc, 2dc in last st, **sl st** in top of first dc of row 5 of first trapezoid, 2ch, **sl st** on top of first dc of row 6 of first trapezoid, turn. [7 sts]

Row 6: 6dc, 2dc in last st, fasten off and turn to RS. [8 sts]

Third trapezoid and joining to second one

Even for this piece we are going to use the JAYG method.

Using a 4mm hook and both **yarn A** and **yarn D**, **sl st** in bottom of first dc of row 1 of second trapezoid, ch10, wrap yarn around hook and insert it in 3rd chain from hook.

Row 1 (RS): 8dc, **sl st** in top of first dc of row 1 of second trapezoid, 2ch, **sl st** in top of first dc of row 2 of second trapezoid, turn. [8 sts]

Row 2 (WS): 6dc, dc2tog, turn. [7 sts]

Row 3: 2ch (doesn't count as a st here and throughout), 5dc, dc2tog, **sl st** in top of first dc of row 3 of second trapezoid, 2ch, **sl st** in top of first dc of row 4 of second trapezoid, turn. [6 sts]

Row 4: 4dc, dc2tog, turn. [5 sts]

Row 5: 2ch, 3dc, dc2tog, **sl st** in top of first dc of row 5 of second trapezoid, 2ch, **sl st** in top of first dc of row 6 of second trapezoid, turn. [4 sts]

Row 6: 2dc, dc2tog, fasten off and turn to RS.

FACE



Using a 4mm hook, join **yarn C** with a sl st in top of first dc of the body (RS facing you).

Row 1 (RS): 1ch and 1dc in same st space, 13dc, turn. [14 sts]

Row 2 (WS): 2ch (doesn't count as a st here and throughout), 12dc, dc2tog, turn. [13 sts]

Row 3: 2ch, 11dc, dc2tog, fasten off. [12 sts]

HAT

Using a 4mm hook, join **yarn B** and **yarn E** with a sl st in top of the first dc of the face (RS facing you).

Row 1 (RS): 1ch and 1dc in same st space, 9dc, dc2tog, turn. [11 sts]

Row 2 (WS): 2ch (doesn't count as a st here and throughout), 9dc, dc2tog, fasten off and turn to RS. [10 sts]

Now join **yarn A** and **yarn D** with a sl st in top of the first dc of the brim (RS facing you).

Row 1 (RS): 1ch and 1dc in same st space, 7dc, dc2tog, turn. [9 sts]

Row 2 (WS): 2ch, 7dc, dc2tog, turn. [8 sts]

Row 3: 2ch, 6dc, dc2tog, turn. [7 sts]

Row 4: 2ch, 5dc, dc2tog, turn. [6 sts]

Row 5: 2ch, 4dc, dc2tog, turn. [5 sts]

Row 6: 2ch, 3dc, dc2tog, turn. [4 sts]

Row 7: 2ch, 2dc, dc2tog, turn. [3 sts]

Row 8: 2ch, 1dc, dc2tog, turn. [2 sts]

Row 9: 2ch, dc2tog, 25ch, sl st in top of previous dc2tog, fasten off.

Weave in all ends.



STIFFENING (OPTIONAL)

Prepare a solution made 50% of water and 50% of white PVA glue.

Pin the ornament (WS facing you) on a blocking board or foam blocks.

With the help of a soft brush spread the solution on the ornament and let it dry completely before starting the next step.

EMBELLISHMENTS

Use the below picture for reference.



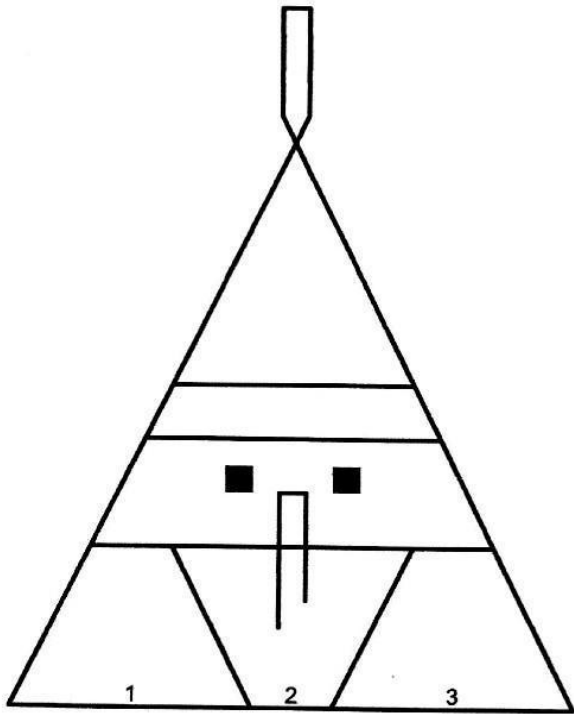
Pompom: Collect a 14mm bell and knot it to the top of the hat using a matching yarn. Trim the excess of yarn.

Eyes: Collect two 10mm bells and knot them in the middle of the face using a matching yarn. Trim the excess of yarn.

Moustache: thread 5 lengths of **yarn B** and 5 lengths of **yarn E** through a yarn needle and pass it under a stitch post, just under the eyes. Knot these threads together once and trim to the desired length.
