MATERIALS

Friends Cotton 8/4: 1 skein of color 41 1 skein of color 53 1 skein of color 66 1 skein of color 90

Crochet hook 3.0 mm (US D/3) Filling 100 g - Hobbii Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

Friends Cotton 8/4, Hobbii
 100 % cotton
 50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (175 yds)

GAUGE

22 sts x 10 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain
st = stitch
sp = space
ss = slip stitch
sc = single crochet
hdc = half double crochet
dc = double crochet
tr = treble
blo = back loop only
cc = change color
[] denote that the stitches are worked into
the same stitch
{} denote that the stitches are repeated
later in the round

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 7.6 cm / 3" Length: 10 cm / 4"

PATTERN INFORMATION

This pattern is inspired by candies that have flowers on them. There are two flower ornaments. The first one is more beginner friendly whereas the second one includes a little bit of colorwork. There are pictures to explain how to change color and join the ornaments. The front and back sides of the ornaments are identical, so they are simple to join. A small amount of filling is placed inside the ornaments.

INFO AND TIPS

This pattern includes instructions to make two flower ornaments. The first flower ornament is more beginner friendly whereas the second flower requires a little bit of colorwork. For both ornaments, the front and back sides are identical, so they are simple to join.





How to Change Color

The second ornament requires a little bit of colorwork. When the pattern says, "cc to", use the new color to complete the final "yarn over, pull through" of the st that comes before it (pictures 1 and 2). Then, hold the previous color against the back of the work while crocheting with the new color (picture 3). When it is time to change color again, use the previous color to complete the final "yarn over, pull through" of the st that comes before the color change, and then, hold the other color against the back of the work (picture 4).



FIRST FLOWER ORNAMENT

I made three ornaments: a red flower, pink flower, and blue flower. For all of them, I used the faint purple as the background color.

Front side

With the color of the flower, begin with a magic circle.

Round 1: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc throughout), 11 hdc into the magic circle, close the magic circle, ss into the top of the ch 2. (12).

Round 2: [Ch 1 (counts as first ss), dc], [dc, ss]. { [Ss, dc], [dc, ss] }. Repeat {} 4 more times. Ss into the ch 1. (24).

Round 3: Ch 1 (counts as first ss), [dc, tr], [tr, dc], ss. {Ss, [dc, tr], [tr, dc], ss}. Repeat {} 4 more times. Ss into the ch 1 and fasten off. (36).

Round 4: For this round, we will work into the blo of the sts of the previous round. Join the color of the background into the blo of a dc that comes directly before a tr of the previous round. Ch 2, [2 sc], sc, hdc, dc. {Dc, hdc, [2 sc], sc, hdc, dc}. Repeat {} 4 more times. Dc. Ss into the top of the ch 2. (42).

Round 5: [Ch 2, hdc], 6 hdc. { [2 hdc], 6 hdc}. Repeat {} 4 more times. Ss into the top of the ch 2 and fasten off. (48).

Back side

Follow the same instructions as the front side.

Joining

See below for the joining instructions.

SECOND FLOWER ORNAMENT

A refers to the color of the background, and B refers to the color of the flower. I made three ornaments, and I used the faint purple for yarn B for all of them. For yarn A, I used red, pink, and blue.

Front side

With yarn A, begin with a magic circle.

Round 1: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc throughout), 11 hdc into the magic circle. Close the magic circle. Ss into the top of the ch 2. (12).

Round 2: [Ch 3 (counts as first dc throughout), dc]. { Cc to B. [2 dc]. Cc to A. [2 dc] }. Repeat {} 4 more times. Cc to B. [2 dc]. Cc to A, ss into the top of the ch 3. (24).

Round 3: [Ch 1 (does not count as a st), sc], sc. { Cc to B. [Sc, dc], [dc, sc]. Cc to A. 2 sc }. Repeat {} 4 more times. Cc to B. [Sc, dc], [dc, sc]. Cc to A, ss into the first sc, and fasten off yarn B. (36).

Round 4: [Ch 2, hdc], hdc, hdc into blo, [2 sc] into blo, sc into blo, hdc into blo. { [2 hdc], hdc. Working into the blo of the next 4 sts, hdc, [2 sc], sc, hdc}. Repeat {} 4 more times. Ss into the top of the ch 2 and fasten off. (48).

Back side

Follow the same instructions as the front side.

Joining

See below for the joining instructions.





JOINING

Both ornaments are joined with the color of the flower. To join the ornaments, hold the front and back pieces together with the right sides facing out (try to align the petals of the flowers on the two sides). Insert the hook through a st of the front side and the back side and pull the yarn through. Then, work one sc st into each set of corresponding sts of the front and back sides. However, into one set of corresponding sts, [sc, ch 20, ss into the first ch of the ch 20, sc] to add the hanging loop.

When about half of the ornament is joined, insert a small amount of filling inside, and continue joining. At the end of the round, ss into the first sc st, and fasten off.
