Candy Cane

MATERIALS

Friends Cotton 8/4:

- 1 skein color White (01)
- 1 skein color Tomato (40)
- 1 skein color Malachite (106)

Crochet hook 2.5 mm / US C/2
Scissors
Stuffing
Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

-  Friends Cotton 8/4, Hobbii
- 100 % cotton
- 50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (175 yds)

GAUGE

30 sc x 30 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

ABBREVIATIONS

- st(s) = stitch(es)
- ch = chain
- sc = single crochet
- sl st = slip stitch
- dc = double crochet
- A** = yarn color White
- B** = yarn color Tomato or Malachite

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Height (without loop): 3.8" (9.5 cm)

PATTERN INFORMATION

Decorating a Christmas tree is a nice and joyful moment. But it will be even more if the crocheter hangs his art, right?

Candy Cane will decorate your tree wonderfully. You can also make several candy canes in different colorways without the hanging loop and simply place them on your table to create pretty decorations, or crochet other patterns ornaments from Hobbii to create the prettiest garland.

Due to the numerous changement of color, and to the smallness of the piece I don't recommend this pattern for absolute beginners.

INFO AND TIPS

Ch1 doesn't count as a st.

Carry the yarn that is not in use under the stitches.

Stuff the Candy Cane as you go.

CANDY CANE

With **A** and **B** yarns and hook 2.5 mm (C/2)

Start with a magic circle with A yarn

Round 1: ch1, **3 sc A**, **3 sc B**. Sl st in first st. (6 sts)

Round 2: ch1, **1 sc B**, **3 sc A**, **2 sc B**. Sl st in first st. (6 sts)

Round 3: ch1, **2 sc B**, **3 sc A**, **1 sc B**. Sl st in first st. (6 sts)

Round 4: ch1, **3 sc B**, **3 sc A**. Sl st in first st. (6 sts)

Round 5: ch1, **1 sc A**, **3 dc B**, **2 sc A**. Sl st in first st. (6 sts)

Round 6: ch1, **1 sc A**, **1 dc A**, **2 dc B**, **1 sc B**, **1 sc A**. Sl st in first st. (6 sts). Start to stuff.

Round 7: Repeat Round 1

Round 8: Repeat Round 2

Round 9: Repeat Round 3. Stuff to form the angle.

Round 10: ch1, **1 sc B**, **2 dc B**, **1 dc A**, **2 sc A**. Sl st in first st. (6 sts)

Round 11: ch1, **1 sc A**, **3 dc B**, **2 sc A**. Sl st in first st. (6 sts). Stuff as you go.

Round 12: ch1, **2 sc A**, **3 sc B**, **1 sc A**. Sl st in first st. (6 sts)

Round 13: ch1, **3 sc A**, **3 sc B**. Sl st in first st. (6 sts)

Round 14: ch1, **1 sc B**, **3 sc A**, **2 sc B**. Sl st in first st. (6 sts)

Round 15: ch1, **2 sc B**, **3 sc A**, **1 sc B**. Sl st in first st. (6 sts)

Round 16: ch1, **3 sc B**, **3 sc A**. Sl st in first st. (6 sts)

Round 17: ch1, **1 sc A**, **3 sc B**, **2 sc A**. Sl st in first st. (6 sts)

Rounds 18 to 31: repeat rounds 10 to 17 or until your Candy Canes measure approx 3,8" (9,5cm). Don't forget to stuff as you go.

If you add too much stuff, the stuffing can go out where the dc are. Just sew some little stitches if necessary, With sewing thread to be as invisible as possible.

HANGING LOOP

With A yarn and hook 2.5 mm (C/2)

Ch 20, sl st in the first ch. Fasten off. Sew The hanging loop between rounds 10 and 11 in the back of the candy cane.

Dare and unleash your stitches!
