MATERIALS

Friends Cotton 8/4:

1 skein color Black (124)
 1 skein color Lilac (63)
 1 skein color Orange (30)
 1 skein color Caramel (14)
 1 skein color Shamrock (104)

Crochet hook 2.5 mm / US C/2 DIY Headbands 2 pairs of Safety eyes - 6 mm - Black Stuffing Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

Friends Cotton 8/4, Hobbii
 100 % cotton
 50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (175 yds)

INFO AND TIPS

Ch 1 in the beginning of round doesn't count as a st. You work in closed rounds, finishing each round with one slip stitch in the first stitch.

How to change colour:

Crochet the last stitch of the last round of the current color like this: insert hook in the stitch, yarn over with the current color, pull through the st. Yarn over with the new color, and pull through the two loops on hook.

COVER (make 2)

With col Lilac and Black and hook 2.5 mm (C/2)

The amount of stitches and rows that you need can vary depending on your tension. Try it often on the headband and adjust the amount of increase and rows if necessary. Remember to take notes to work the two pieces in the same way. Work these pieces not too tight, to allow it to have a little elasticity, to make it easier to put the headband inside.

Color sequence: like the amount of rounds can vary the idea is to choose your colors randomly. Here is the sequence I used:

- <u>Cover 1:</u> *5 rounds Purple, 3 rounds Black, 3 rounds Purple, 1 round Black, 2 rounds Purple, 5 rounds Black* Repeat * to * twice. 5 rounds Purple, 3 rounds Black, 3 rounds Purple, 1 round Black, 2 rounds Purple, 3 rounds Black
- <u>Cover 2:</u> *5 rounds Black, 2 rounds Purple, 1 round Black, 3 rounds Purple, 3 rounds Black, 5 rounds Purple * Repeat * to * twice. 5 rounds Black, 2 rounds Purple, 1 round Black, 3 rounds Purple, 3 rounds Black, 3 rounds Purple

Make a magic circle **Round 1:** ch1 (doesn't count as a st), 4 sc in mc. Sl st in first st. (4 sts)

Round 2: ch1, inc in each st. Sl st in first st. (8 sts)

Rounds 3 to 12: ch1, 1 sc in each st . Sl st in first st. (8 sts, 10 rounds)



Round 13: ch1, inc, 1 sc in each st . Sl st in first st. (9 sts)

Rounds 14 to 23: ch1, 1 sc in each st . Sl st in first st. (9 sts, 10 rounds)

Round 24: ch1, inc, 1 sc in each st. Sl st in first st. (10 sts)

Rounds 25 to 27: ch1, 1 sc in each st . Sl st in first st. (10 sts, 3 rounds)

Round 28: ch1, inc, 1 sc in each st . Sl st in first st. (11 sts)

Rounds 29 to 34: ch1, 1 sc in each st . Sl st in first st. (11 sts, 6 rounds)

Round 35: ch1, inc, 1 sc in each st . Sl st in first st. (12 sts)

Rounds 36 to 56: ch1, 1 sc in each st . Sl st in first st. (12 sts, 21 rounds)

Try on the cover, it must be a little shorter than the half of the headband. Adjust the amount of rows if necessary. Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Make another piece in the same way but cut and weave in ends for this one.

HAT

With col Black and hook 2.5 mm (C/2)

Make a magic circle **Round 1:** ch1, 6 sc in mc. Sl st in first st. (6 sts)

Rounds 2 and 3: ch1, 1 sc in each st . Sl st in first st. (6 sts, 2 rounds)

Round 4: ch1, 3 sc, inc3 in next st, 2 sc. Sl st in first st. (8 sts)

Round 5: ch1, 4 sc, inc3 in next st, 3 sc. Sl st in first st. (10 sts)

Round 6: ch1, 1 sc in each st . Sl st in first st. (10 sts)

Round 7: ch1, 1 sc, inc3 in next st, 8 sc. Sl st in first st. (12 sts)

Round 8: ch1, 2 sc, inc3 in next st, 9 sc. Sl st in first st. (14 sts)

Round 9: ch1, 3 sc, inc3 in next st, 6 sc, inc3, 3 sc. Sl st in first st. (18 sts)

Round 10: ch1, 13 sc, inc3 in next st, 4 sc. Sl st in first st. (20 sts)

Round 11: ch1, 1 sc in each st . Sl st in first st. (20 sts)

Round 12: ch1, inc3, 7 sc, inc x2, 10 sc. Sl st in first st. (24 sts)

Round 13: ch1, inc, 1 sc, inc, 7 sc, inc, 2 sc, inc, 10 sc. Sl st in first st. (28 sts)



Round 14: ch1, *6 sc, inc* x 4 times. Sl st in first st. (32 sts)

Rounds 15 and 17: ch1, 1 sc in each st . Sl st in first st. (32 sts, 3 rounds)

Round 18: ch1, 3 sc, inc, * 7 sc, inc* x 3 times, 4 sc. Sl st in first st. (36 sts)

Rounds 19 and 20: ch1, 1 sc in each st . Sl st in first st. (36 sts, 2 rounds)

Round 20: ch1, *8 sc, inc* x twice, change to orange in the last st (see info and tips). Sl st in first st. (40 sts)

Rounds 21 to 23: ch1, 1 sc in each st (40 sts, 3 rounds). Sl st in first st. Change to Black in the last st Round 23.

Round 24: ch1, *8 sc blo, dec blo* x 4 times. Sl st in first st. (36 sts)

Rounds 25: ch1, *4 sc, dec* x 6 times. Sl st in first st. (30 sts)

Start stuffing.

Round 26: ch1, *3 sc, dec* x 6 times. Sl st in first st. (24 sts)

Round 27: ch1, *2 sc, dec* x 6 times. Sl st in first st. (18 sts)

Round 28: ch1, *1 sc, dec* x 6 times. Sl st in first st. (12 sts)

Round 29: ch1, dec all around. Sl st in first st. (6 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail. With the yarn needle, pass the yarn through the front loops of each st and tight to close the hole and secure.

Now you will work the edge hat. With black yarn, work in the front loops of round 24.

Join the yarn in the front loop of the first st in Round 24. **Round 1:** ch 1, inc flo in each st. (80 sts)

Round 2: ch 1, *1 sc, inc* repeat around. (120 sts)

Rounds 3 and 4: ch 1, 1 sc in each st . (120 sts, 2 rounds)

Fasten off and weave in ends.

SPIDER

With col Caramel and hook 2.5 mm (C/2)

Make a magic circle **Round 1:** ch1, 6 sc in mc. Sl st in first st. (6 sts)

Round 2: ch1, inc in each st. Sl st in first st. (12 sts)



Round 3: ch1, *1 sc in next st, inc* repeat around. Sl st in first st. (18 sts)

Round 4: ch1, *1 sc in next 2 sts, inc* repeat around. Sl st in first st. (24 sts)

Round 5: ch1, *1 sc in next 3 sts, inc* repeat around. Sl st in first st. (30 sts)

Rounds 6 to 9: ch1, 1 1 sc in each st. Sl st in first st. (30 sts)

Place the safety eyes between Rounds 7 and 8, after the 13th st and after the 16th st (3 sts between them)

Round 10: ch1, *1 sc blo in the next 3 sts, dec blo* repeat around. Sl st in first st. Start to stuff as you go.

Round 11: ch1, *1 sc in the next 2 sts, dec* repeat around. Sl st in first st.

Round 12: ch1, *1 sc in the next st, dec* repeat around. Sl st in first st.

Round 13: ch1, dec in each st. Sl st in first st.

Fasten off leaving a long tail. Stuff before to close the hole. With the yarn needle, pass the yarn through the front loops of each st and tight to close the hole and secure.

Legs

With col Caramel and hook 2.5 mm (C/2)

Take your spider, the first round down and the eyes in front of you.

Count 2 rounds up the right eye, then 9 sts to the right. Join yarn in the flo of the 9th st from Round 10.

[Work in flo from Round 11 *Ch 9, 1 sc in the 2sd st from hook, 1 sc in the next 7 ch*. Work 1 sl st in the next 2 sts from the body. Repeat from * to *. Work 1 sl st in the next st from the body. Repeat from * to *. Work 1 sl st in the next 2 sts from the body. Repeat from * to *. Work 1 sl st in the next st from the body. Fasten off and weave in ends.]

Take your spider, the first round down and the eyes in front of you.

Count 2 rounds up the left eye, then 3 sts to the left. Join yarn in the flo of the 3th st from Round 11 and repeat from [to].

PUMKIN

With col Orange and hook 2.5 mm (C/2)

Make a magic circle **Round 1:** ch1, 6 sc in mc. Sl st in first st. (6 sts)



Round 2: ch1, inc in each st. Sl st in first st. (12 sts)

Round 3: ch1, *1 sc in next st, inc* repeat around. Sl st in first st. (18 sts)

Round 4: ch1, *1 sc in next 2 sts, inc* repeat around. Sl st in first st. (24 sts)

Round 5: ch1, *1 sc in next 3 sts, inc* repeat around. Sl st in first st. (30 sts)

Rounds 6 to 12: ch1, 1 sc in each st . Sl st in first st. (30 sts, 7 rounds)

Place the safety eyes between Rounds 8 and 9 after the 12th st and after the 18th st (8 sts between them).

Round 13: ch1, *1 sc in next 3 sts, dec* repeat around. Sl st in first st. (24 sts) Start to stuff as you go.

Round 14: ch1, *1 sc in next 2 sts, dec* repeat around. Sl st in first st. (18 sts)

Round 15: ch1, *1 sc in next st, dec* repeat around. Sl st in first st. (12 sts)

Round 16: ch1, dec in each st. Sl st in first st. (6 sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail. Stuff before to close the hole. With the yarn needle, pass the yarn through the front loops of each st and tight to close the hole and secure.

STEM

With col Shamrock and hook 2.5 mm (C/2)

Make a magic circle **Round 1:** ch1, 5 sc in mc. Sl st in first st. (5 sts)

Round 2: ch1, 1 sc in each st . Sl st in first st. (5 sts)

Round 3: ch6, sl st in the 2sd ch from hook, sc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts, ch 1, sl st in the last ch. Ch5, sl st in the 2sd ch from hook, sc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts, ch 1. Sl st in the first ch of the round. Sl st in the next st from the previous round.

Fasten off leaving a long tail.



ASSEMBLY

- Grab the pumpkin and thread the yarn that you left on the darning needle. Pass the needle through the pumpkin, from the magic circle (in the opposite end) to bring the yarn out at the starting point, the yarn passes between the eyes. Pull gently, this will create a hollow on the pumpkin. Continue to pull gradually until you are happy with the result. Repeat this 6 times in total with regular spacing. Finally sew the stem on the top of the pumpkin (round 1).

- Place the 2 pieces of the cover on the headband and sew them together.
- Place the hat on the headband on the right (when wearing). The end of the edge must be on the center of the headband. Sew it in place.
- Place the pumpkin 2 cm from the hat on the left (when wearing). Remember to place the pumpkin's face on the right side. Sew it in place.
- Place the spider next to the pumpkin, on the left, with the legs on the pumpkin and sew it in place.

Of course it's totally up to you! You can choose your favourite placement.
