MATERIALS

7 (8, 8) 10, 10, 13, 13, 14, 14 skeins of Flash it! col. 12

8 (9, 9) 11, 11, 13, 14, 15, 15 skeins of Friends Cotton 8/8 col. 01

Crochet hook 4 mm / US G/6

- or the hook that gives you the correct gauge

A needle and matching thread

YARN QUALITY

 **Flash it!**, Hobbii

80% Viscose, 20% Metallic fiber

50 g / 1.75 oz = 90 m / 98 yds

 **Friends Cotton 8/8**, Hobbii

100 % Cotton

50 g / 1.75 oz = 75 m / 82 yds

GAUGE

Square = 11 cm x 11 cm / 4.5" x 4.5"

Half of the square = 11 cm x 5,5 cm / 4.5" x 2.2"

ABBREVIATIONS

sl st = slip stitch

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

dc = double crochet

dc3tog = 3 dc crochet together

SIZE

XS, (S, M), L, XL, 2XL, 3XL, 4XL, 5XL

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 39 (47.5, 47.5) 56, 56, 69.5, 69.5, 79.5, 79.5 cm / 15.4" (18.7", 18.7") 22", 22", 27.3", 27.3", 31.2", 31.2"

Length: 50 (50, 50) 50, 50, 59, 59, 59, 59 cm / 19.7" (19.7", 19.7") 19.7", 19.7", 23.2", 23.2", 23.2", 23.2"

Sleeve length: 40 (40, 40) 40, 40, 40, 40, 40, 40 cm / 19.7" (19.7", 19.7") 19.7", 19.7", 19.7", 19.7", 19.7", 19.7"

Sleeve width: 19 (19, 19) 19, 19, 24, 24, 30, 30 cm / 7.5" (7.5", 7.5") 7.5", 7.5", 9.4", 9.4", 11.8", 11.8"

The captivating design is created by joining granny squares together through the back loop only, using a needle and thread. This pattern is beginner-friendly, making it perfect for crocheters of all skill levels. If you are familiar with crocheting granny squares, you'll find this project enjoyable and rewarding. The pattern includes schemes for all sizes, ensuring a perfect fit for everyone.

INFO AND TIPS

When cutting the Flash it! Weave in the ends immediately and tie a little knot to prevent the yarn from unravelling.

Number of squares /half-squares needed:

XS: 57 squares and 20 half squares

S, M: 77 squares

L, XL: 77 squares and 20 half squares

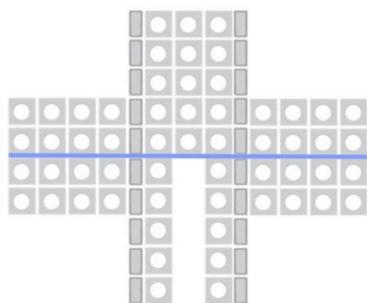
2XL, 3XL: 110 squares and 16 half squares

4XL, 5XL: 132 squares.

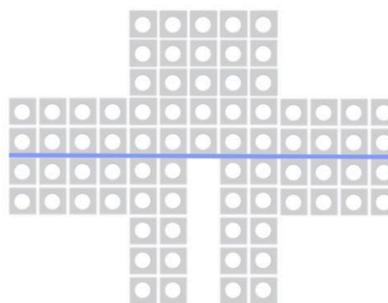
NOTE: if you need to make your sleeves longer add an additional row of squares or half-squares

Please check the schemes below. The blue horizontal lines are the folding lines.

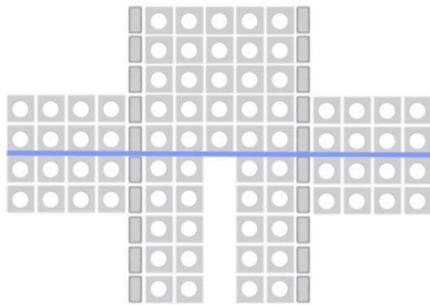
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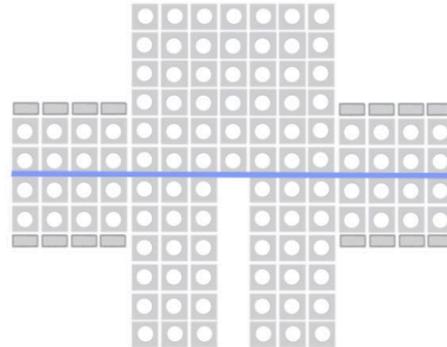
S-M



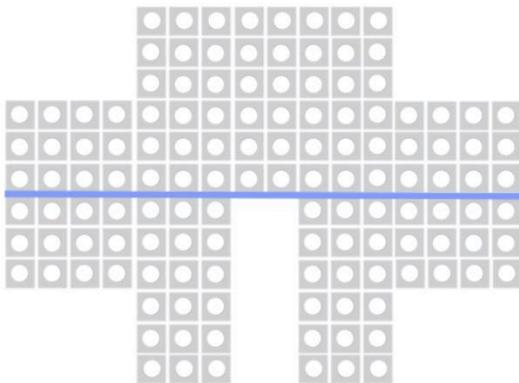
L-XL

SQUARE



Start with Friends Cotton 8/8, ch 4, join with sl st to the first ch

Round 1: Ch 4 (counts as a first dc with ch-1), * dc into the circle, ch 1 **, repeat from * to ** 10 times, join with sl st to top of ch 3. Fasten off. (12 ch-1 spaces)

Change the yarn to Flash it!

Round 2: Connect the yarn with sl st to any ch-1 space, ch 2, dc2tog in same space, ch 2, * dc3tog in next ch-1 space, ch 2 **, rep from * to ** 10 times, join with sl st to top of ch 2. Fasten off. (12 petals)

Change the yarn to Friends Cotton 8/8

Round 3 : Connect the yarn with sl st to any ch-2 space, ch 3 (counts as the first dc), 2 dc in same space, ch 2, 3 dc in same space, 3 dc in next 2 ch-2 spaces, * 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, 3 dc in same space, 3 dc in next 2 ch-2 spaces **, rep from * to ** twice, join with sl st to top of ch 3. Fasten off.

Change the yarn to Flash it!

Round 4: Connect the yarn with sl st to any ch-2 space, ch 1, 3 sc in same space, sc in next 12 dc, * 3 sc in next ch-2 space, sc in next 12 dc ** rep from * to ** twice, join with sl st to the first sc. Fasten off.

HALF-SQUARE



Start with Friends Cotton 8/8, ch 4, join with sl st to the first ch

Row 1: Ch 4 (counts as a first dc with ch-1), dc into the circle, * ch 1, dc into the circle **, repeat from * to ** 5 times. Fasten off. (7 ch-1 spaces)

Change the yarn to Flash it!

Row 2: Connect the yarn with sl st to the first ch-1 space, ch 2, dc2tog in same space, * ch 2, dc3tog in next ch-1 space **, rep from * to ** 5 times. Fasten off. (7 petals)

Change the yarn to Friends Cotton 8/8

Row 3: Connect the yarn with sl st to top of the first petal, ch 3 (counts as the first dc), 2 dc in next ch-2 space, 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, 3 dc in same space, 3 dc in next 2 ch-2 spaces, 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, 3 dc in same space, 2 dc in next ch-2 space, dc in the top of the last petal. Fasten off.

Change the yarn to Flash it!

Round 4: Connect the yarn with sl st to the first dc, ch 1, sc in same st, sc in next 5 dc, 3 sc in next ch-2 space, sc in next 12 dc, 3 sc in next ch-2 space, sc in last 6 dc, turn, and start working on the fourth side, 3 sc in the first (white) space, sc in next (silver) space, 3 sc in next (white) space, 2 sc in next (white) space, 3 sc in next (white) space, sc in next (silver) space, 3 sc in the last space, join with sl st to the first sc. Fasten off. (16 sc on the fourth side)

JOINING

Lay your two squares with right sides facing each other and sew them through back loops only with a needle and thread. Join all the squares in the same way according to the schemes above.



BORDER

Connect Friends Cotton 8/8 to any sc of the front part. The number of sts is a dividable by 2.

Round 1: Ch 3 (counts as a first dc), dc in each sc around, 5 dc in each corner of the bottom part of the front part, join with sl st to top of ch 3. Fasten off.

Change the yarn to Flash it!

Round 2 : Connect the yarn with sl st to any dc, ch 1, sc in the same space, ch 2, skip next dc, * sc in next dc, ch 2, skip next dc **, rep from * to ** around, join with sl st to the first sc

Connect Friends Cotton 8/8 to any sc of a cuff. The number of sts is a multiple of 2.

Round 1: Ch 3 (counts as a first dc), dc in each sc around, join with sl st to top of ch 3. Fasten off.

Change the yarn to Flash it!

Round 2 : Connect the yarn with sl st to any dc, ch 1, sc in the same space, ch 2, skip next dc, * sc in next dc, ch 2, skip next dc **, rep from * to ** around, join with sl st to the first sc
