

CROCHET PATTERN

MATERIALS

6 (6, 7, 7) 9, 11 skeins of Metallico Fine Color 7

Crochet hook 4.0 mm (US G/6) Stitch markers Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

Metallico Fine, Hobbii 70 % Polyamide, 10% Acrylic, 10% Wool 50 g / 1.75 oz = 265 m / 289 yds

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm $(4'' \times 4'')$ = 16 sts x 10 rows Dc rows

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain
blo = back loop only
sl st = slip stitch
sc = single crochet
hdc = half double crochet
dc = double crochet
dc2tog = 2 double crochet together
puff st = YO, insert hook into st, *YO, pull
up a loop, repeat from * 3 more times, YO
pull through all 9 loops
Inc = 2 double crochet in the same st
bor = beginning of round

SIZE

XS (S, M, L) XL, 2XL

MEASUREMENTS

Waist Circumference: 58 (63, 71, 81) 91, 101

cm / 23" (26", 28", 32") 36", 40" **Length:** Approx 43 cm/17"

PATTERN INFORMATION

This pattern is made starting with the waistband and working back and forth. Then, it is worked in the round.

The skirt is mainly made in dc stitches and has a beautiful lace piece at the bottom.

For round 2 of the lace accent, I recommend using stitch markers and placing them in every 17th stitch to keep the lace lined up.

INFO AND TIPS

If your waistband is slipping, I highly recommend adding elastic to it. Sew it in the inner band using a whip stitch. If using Metallico yarn it is not needed as the tie holds nicely.

WAISTBAND

The waistband will be worked flat.

CH 17, sl st in 2nd ch from hook sl st in each st to the end, turn, ch 1 (16sts)

Row 1: sl st in the blo of each st to the end, turn, ch 1

Repeat row 1 for 119 (131, 149, 173) 197, 224 more rows or until the waistband measures approx. 58 (63, 71, 81) 91, 101 cm / 23" (26", 28", 32") 36", 40" long. This band will be very stretchy.

At the end of the last row, fold in half and sl st the band together. This seam will be on the side of your skirt. Try waistband on and make sure you like the fit.

Do not cut yarn, continue below.

BODY

The body will be worked in the round.

The beginning ch does not count as a st throughout the pattern.

Round 1: ch 1, 2 sc in the same row and each row around, sl st in bor.

240 (264, 300, 348) 396, 450 sts

Round 2: ch 2, dc in the same st and each st around, sl st in bor.

Round 3: ch 2, dc in the same, *2 dc in the next st, dc in the next st, repeat from * around to the last st, 2 dc in the last st, sl st in bor.

360 (396, 450, 522) 594, 675 sts

Round 4: ch 2, dc in the same st and each st around, sl st in bor.

360 (396, 450, 522) 594, 675 sts

REPEAT Round 4 until the garment measures 23 cm/9"

Last Round of DC INC: ch 2, dc in the same st and in the next 24 (32, 49, 103) 593, 134 sts, 2 dc in the next st, repeat 14 (12, 9, 5) 1, 5 times, then dc to end. 374 (408, 459, 527) 595, 680 sts



LACE ACCENT

Round 1: ch 2, dc2tog in the 1st and following st, (dc2tog) 2 more times in the following sts, *(ch 1, puff in the next st) 5 times total, ch 1,**, (dc2tog) in the following sts, 6 times total, repeat from *across ending last repeat at **, (dc2tog) 3 more times, sl st in bor. 374 (408, 459, 527) 595, 680 sts

Round 2: CH 1, HDC into the blo of the same st and in each st and ch 1 space around, sl st in bor.

374 (408, 459, 527) 595, 680 sts

Repeat rounds 1-2, 6 more times, or to the desired length the final skirt length is approx 43 cm/17"

Cut yarn and sew in end.

TIE STRING

With two strands held together, ch your waist circumference plus enough to tie a knot.

With the sl st seam on the side, move to the center front and at the top of the band, start to weave the drawstring through the waistband. Continue around ending back at the beginning and tie a knot. Your skirt is ready to wear!
