Shine Bright

Hat and scarf

MATERIALS

Scarf:

4 skeins Friends Wool, color Off White (02)

2 skeins Friends Wool, color Off White (02) As second strand to both hat and scarf, use a thread of Glitter Deluxe, color White (18124)

Circular needles 4.5 mm 40 cm 1 stitch marker

YARN QUALITY

Friends Wool, Hobbii 100% Wool 50 g = 100 m

Glitter Deluxe, Go Handmade 100% polyester 30g = 1,800 m

GAUGE

 $10 \times 10 \text{ cm} = 18 \text{ sts} \times 24 \text{ r}$

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Scarf: 134 cm long and 21 cm wide Hat: 22 cm long and approx. 52 cm around. The hat is stretchy. In the picture it fits a head circumference of 57 cm.

PATTERN INFORMATION

The "Shine Bright" design, consisting of a hat and scarf, is meant as a toasty unisex project for the cold winter days. The set is knit in Friends Wool in the color Off White, and has a second strand of thin glitter thread, to give it a hint of "sun glittering in the snow". The set is reversible.

If you want the scarf to be longer, you can always add an extra skein of yarn. The scarf is worked back and forth on circular needles, and the pattern consists of just two rows. The hat is worked around on circular needles 40 cm.

I recommend that you read through the pattern before you begin knitting the set, to get an overall impression of the pattern.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit
p = purl
st(s) = stitch(es)
rnd = round
edge st = edge stitch
sm = stitch marker
k2tog = knit 2 together
p2tog = purl 2 together
rs = right side
ws = wrong side
dec = decrease

INFO AND TIPS

Edge stitches (edge sts) are in this pattern defined as the two first and two last stitches of each row. They are worked as such:

On both right and wrong side the two first stitches are knit.

For the two last stitches of both right and wrong side, slip the stitches with the yarn in front of your work. That way you will get a nice and even edge on the scarf.

SCARF

Cast on 48 sts on circular needles 40 cm, 4.5 mm.

The first two and last two sts through the entire work are edge stitches (edge sts) as described above.

The pattern is divisible by 4 sts.

Work the first row p, before the pattern begins.

Pattern:

1. row (rs): 2 edge sts, p until the last two sts, 2 edge sts

2. row (ws): 2 edge sts, *k1, p1 and k1 in same st, p2tog*, repeat until last two sts, 2 edge sts Repeat the two pattern rows above until you are almost out of yarn. At this point the scarf measures approx. 134 cm.



Work one row p on the ws and, on the rs, bind off all sts evenly and not too tight.

HAT

Cast on 96 sts on circular needles 40 cm, 4.5 mm

Join the work in a ring, but be careful it doesn't twist.

Place a sm in the first st, so you will know when the round begins.

The pattern is divisible by 4 sts.

Work first round k, before the pattern begins.

Pattern:

- 1. rnd: p through the round
- 2. rnd: p1, p1 and k1 in same st, k2tog

Repeat the two pattern rows above until the work measures 19 cm. From here begin decreases.

1. dec: *p1, k2tog, k1* - repeat through the round. You have now decreased 24 sts.

Work 1 round p

2. dec: *p1, k2tog* - repeat through the round. You have now decreased 24 sts.

Work 1 round p

3. dec: *p2tog* - repeat through the round. You have now decreased 24 sts.

Work 1 round p

4. dec: *p2tog* - repeat through the round. You have now decreased 12 sts.

On the next round, purl bind off the last 12 sts evenly. Then the hat is joined by discreetly sewing the top closed, so it can be used reversibly.

JOINING AND WASH

Weave in ends discreetly, as both hat and scarf can be used reversibly. The set must be hand washed in water max. 30 degrees celsius with good wool soap, and must be laid out to dry on a towel over a drying rack.
