# Marilyn Tube Top

### **MATERIALS**

6 (6, 7, 7, 8) skeins of Friends Cotton 8/8 color 108 1 skein of Flash it! color 01

Crochet hook 3.5 mm / US E/4 Glitter Buttons - green - 15mm Tapestry needle

# **YARN QUALITY**

Friends Cotton 8/8, Hobbii 100 % Cotton 50 g / 1.75 oz = 75 m / 82 yds

**Flash it!**, Hobbii 80 % Viscose, 20 % Metallised Fibres 50 g / 1.75 oz = 90 m / 98 yds

#### **GAUGE**

20 hdc blo x 14 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

### **ABBREVIATIONS**

ch = chain sc = single crochet hdc = half double crochet inc = increase dec = decrease blo = back loop only

#### SIZE

S (M, L, XL, XXL)

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Sizes above correspond to the following chest circumference:

**86** (94, 100, 108, 116) cm / **33.9** (37, 39.4, 42.5, 45.7)"

### **PATTERN INFORMATION**

This casual and chic *intermediate level* crochet top captures the essence of Monroe's timeless glamour while adding a contemporary twist. The neckline of the top is designed to flatter, offering a gentle shape that accentuates the collarbones and frames the face. This crochet top embraces confidence, femininity, and a touch of retro flair.

## **INFO AND TIPS**

Photos above: Size S / Bust: 86 cm

#### **BODY**

ch **41** (47, 53, 59, 65) If you want to make your top longer or shorter you can change the number of chains here:)

Row 1: skip the first stitch, sc 10, hdc **20** (26, 32, 38, 44), sc 10

Row 2: ch 1, turn, sc blo 10, hdc blo 20 (26, 32, 38, 44), sc blo 10

Row 3: ch 1, turn, sc blo 10, inc hdc blo, hdc blo 19 (25, 31, 37, 43), sc blo 10

Row 4: ch 1, turn, sc blo 10, hdc blo 21 (27, 33, 39, 45), sc blo 10

Row 5: ch 1, turn, sc blo 10, inc hdc blo, hdc blo 20 (26, 32, 38, 44), sc blo 10

Keep increasing and repeating these steps until you get to row 41.

Row 42 - 80: ch 1, turn, sc 10, hdc **40** (46, 52, 58, 64), sc 10 (repeat the same for 39 rows total for size **S**)

For size M: 49 rows total For size L: 57 rows total For size XL: 69 rows total For size XXL: 81 rows total

Row 81: ch 1, turn, sc 10, dec hdc, hdc 38 (44, 50, 56, 62), sc 10

Row 82: ch 1, turn, sc 10, hdc 39 (45, 51, 57, 63), sc 10

Row 83: ch 1, turn, sc 10, dec hdc, hdc 37 (43, 49, 55, 61), sc 10

Row 84: ch 1, turn, sc 10, hdc 38 (44, 50, 56, 62), sc 10

Row 85: ch 1, turn, sc 10, dec hdc, hdc 36 (42, 48, 54, 60), sc 10

Keep decreasing and repeating these steps until you get to row 119.

Row 120 - 122: ch 1, turn, sc 10, hdc **20** (26, 32, 38, 44), sc 10

Row 123: ch 1, turn, sc 40 (46, 52, 58, 64)



Row 124: ch 1, turn, (sc 4, ch 2 and skip two stitches) x until the end of the row. Make sure to end with sc 4. Fasten off and weave in ends.

To add the buttons I will reattach the yarn on the other side of our top and add 2 more rows of sc. Add your buttons and align them with the buttonholes that we did on row 124. Your top should be a little bit stretchy.

# **NECKLINE/STRAP**

Now let's make the neckline/strap part. With someone's help, try on your tube top and measure with a measuring tape the size of your strap. Follow the image below for reference:



Here are some reference measurements, but they may vary from person to person. That's why it is important to take your own measurements:

#### S: 65 cm

M: 70 cm L: 75 cm XL: 80 cm XXL: 85 cm



Make sure it is not too tight.

Start with your main color ch **108** (117, 125, 133, 142)

Row 1: ch 1, turn, sc 108 (117, 125, 133, 142)

Row 2: Change to your Flash It yarn. ch 1, turn, sc 108 (117, 125, 133, 142)

Keep repeating Row 1 and Row 2 until you get to row 9. You can make your strap thicker or thinner by adding or subtracting rows.

With your tapestry needle sew the strap to your top. I sewed mine leaving a gap of approx. 3 cm/ 1.5" between the buttons and the strap. Make sure your strap is not twisted!
