The Granny Bag

MATERIALS

Friends Cotton 8/4, 1 skein of each of the following colors:

122 (A)

50 (B)

105 (C)

56 (D)

21 (E)

05 (F)

30 (G)

86 (H)

Crochet hook 3.0 mm Stitch markers

YARN QUALITY

Friends Cotton 8/4, Hobbii 100% Cotton 50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (175 yds)

GAUGE

One granny square with 15 rounds measures 25 x 25 cm (9.8" x 9.8")

ABBREVIATIONS

Sl st = slip stitch
Dc = double crochet
Sc = single crochet
Ch= chain

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

The bag measures 30 x 30 cm (11.8" x 11.8")

Pattern







SQUARE

Start with a magic ring - Color (A)

Round 1: Ch 3, 2 dc in the ring, ch 2, *3 dc in the ring, ch 2, repeat from * two times (in the end there are going to be 4 groups of 3 dc each), join with a sl st in the third ch, pull the thread to close the ring.

Round 2: Ch 3, 2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc in the same ch-space (corner space). In the next ch-space (corner space) work 3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc, repeat this twice. So in the end after 4 ch-spaces (corner spaces with 3 dc - ch 2 - 3 dc), join with a sl st in the third ch.

Then fasten off, cut the yarn and change to color (B)

Round 3: Ch 3, 2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc in the same ch-space. Work 3 dc in the next ch-space, in the next ch-space (corner space) work 3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc. Repeat this 3 times. Join with a sl st in the third ch

Round 4: Like Round 3 (1 dc-cluster is added between each corner with each round)

Then fasten off, cut the yarn and change to color (C)

Round 5: Like Round 3 (1 dc-cluster is added between each corner with each round)

Round 6: Like Round 3 (1 dc-cluster is added between each corner with each round)

Then fasten off, cut the yarn and change to color (D)

Round 7: Like Round 3 (1 dc-cluster is added between each corner with each round)

Round 8: Like Round 3 (1 dc-cluster is added between each corner with each round)



Then fasten off, cut the yarn and change to color (E)

Round 9: Like Round 3 (1 dc-cluster is added between each corner with each round)

Round 10: Like Round 3 (1 dc-cluster is added between each corner with each round)

Then fasten off, cut the yarn and change to color (F)

Round 11: Like Round 3 (1 dc-cluster is added between each corner with each round)

Round 12: Like Round 3 (1 dc-cluster is added between each corner with each round)

Then fasten off, cut the yarn and change to color (G)

Round 13: Like Round 3 (1 dc-cluster is added between each corner with each round)

Round 14: Like Round 3 (1 dc-cluster is added between each corner with each round)

Then fasten off, cut the yarn and change to color (H)

Round 15: Like Round 3 (1 dc-cluster is added between each corner with each round)

(The square will now consist of 15 rounds , with a total of 8 colors) The square measures $25 \times 25 \text{ cm}$ (9.8" \times 9.8")

NOW MAKE TWO MORE OF THESE SQUARES - you need a total of three!

Assembling the three squares

With color (H):

Start with two of the squares.

Place them on top of each other so the wrong sides touch.

Work a sl st through both corner spaces at the same time, then continue to crochet the two squares together with sl sts

In the end, two of the sides will be joined

To attach the third square, connect it to one of the squares already joined in the same way as just described.



THE BAG STRAP

Now that the bag is assembled, it will have a square bottom and a V-shaped top.

In the one V-shaped top, work the following: ch 3 three stitches from the corner, 2 dc, 2 sl sts in the ch-space, 3 dc, ch 1 to finish

Turn your work, 8 sc, ch 1

Turn your work, 8 sc, ch 1

Continue like this until the strap is about 40-50 cm (15.7"- 19.7") long.

Finishing and attaching the strap:

1 sl st in the first stitch, Ch 3, 2 dc, 2 sl sts, 3 dc

Now make sure the strap is not twisted and attach it to the bag with 8 sl sts
