## MATERIALS

6 (6) 7 (7) 8 skeins of Pearly Haze colour 09 2 (2) 3 (3) 4 skeins of Party Deluxe colour 18175

Circular needles 4.5mm (US 7) Crochet hook 3mm (US D/3 ) Stitch holders or cables Stitch markers Measuring tape Pair of scissors Yarn needle

# **YARN QUALITY**

Pearly Haze, Hobbii
 73% Viscose, 27% Wool
 50 g / 1.75 oz = 100 m / 109 yds

Party Deluxe, Go Handmade
 100 % Polyester
 50 g / 1.8 oz = 250 m / 273 yds

**GAUGE** 18 sts x 27 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

# **ABBREVIATIONS**

WS = wrong side RS = right side

## SIZE

XS (S) M (L) XL

## MEASUREMENTS

Width: 42 (46) 48 (54) 61 cm / 16" (18") 19" (21") 24" Length: 44 (47) 49 (50) 53 cm /17" (18") 19" (20") 21"

# **PATTERN INFORMATION**

This top is worked bottom-up, in the round using 4.5mm circular needles and double strands. First, the body is worked in one piece as far as the armholes. Then, the front and the back are worked separately, back and forth. The collar is made by adding up new stitches in the round and worked using double stockinette stitch to provide more elasticity and comfort. At the end, the fringes are placed on the neckline using a crochet hook.

# **INFO AND TIPS**

#### **Double Stockinette Stitch (in the round)**

R1: \*Slip 1 purlwise with the yarn in front, Knit 1\*, repeat from \* to \* until the end of the row. R2: \*Purl 1, slip 1 purlwise with the yarn in back\*, repeat from \* to \* until the end of the row.

#### **Double-stranded knitting**

Knit with 2 strands (1 of Pearly Haze and 1 of Party Deluxe) of yarn instead of one. In other words, treat both strands as one and go through both loops when you work a stitch. The top is entirely worked this way.

#### Knit 2 together or K2tog

Instead of knitting a single stitch, knit 2 stitches together.

## Knit 3 together or K3tog

Instead of knitting a single stitch, knit 3 stitches together.

#### SK2P

Slip 1 knitwise, knit 2 stitches together, pass slipped stitch over K2tog.

#### TIPS

#### Fit

This top is fitted close to the body. If you want a little more ease, knit one size larger than your usual size.

## BODY

#### **Rib edge**

Cast on 150 (164) 172 (194) 218 sts using the German Twisted Cast On with 4,5mm circular needles. Place a stitch marker to easily identify the beginning of the row. Then, work double stockinette stitch in the round for 3 cm/ 1".



After that, continue working in the round with the stockinette stitch for 30 (32) 33 (34) 35 cm/ 12" (13") 13" (13") 14". From here, the front and the back are worked back and forth separately.

# **FRONT PIECE**

For the moment, put on hold the 75 (82) 86 (97) 109 sts for the back and work only with the 75 (82) 86 (97) 109 sts of the front.

Bind off 4 (4) 7 (7) 7 sts, knit 71 (78) 79 (90) 102 sts, turn the piece. Bind off 4 (4) 7 (7) 7 sts, purl 64 (71) 69 (80) 92 sts, slip the 3 last stitches purlwise with the yarn in front and turn the piece. Knit 64 (71) 69 (80) 92 sts, slip the 3 last stitches purlwise with yarn in back and turn the piece. Purl 64 (71) 69 (80) 92 sts, slip the last 3 stitches purlwise with yarn in front .

## Decreases

From here, each side of the front will be decreased as follows every second row. RS: knit 3 stitches, SK2P, knit until 6 stitches before end of the row, k3tog, slip the 3 last stitches with yarn in back.

WS: purl until the 3 last stitches and slip the 3 last sts purlwise with yarn in front.

Repeat these 2 rows a total of 9 (10) 9 (11) 13 times Once the decreases are done, 31 (34) 36 (39) 43 sts should remain on your needles.

## Upper part

Continue working the 2 following rows back and forth until the piece measures 44 (47) 49 (50) 53 cm/ 17" (18") 19" (20") 21":

RS: knit until 3 stitches before the end of the row, slip the last 3 stitches purlwise with yarn in back.

WS: Purl until 3 stitches before the end of the row, slip the last 3 stitches purlwise with yarn in front.

Then put on hold the remaining 31 (34) 36 (39) 43 stitches.

# **BACK PIECE**

Take back the 75 (82) 86 (97) 109 stitches put previously on hold, and proceed in the same way as for the front part.

# **COLLAR PIECE**

Cast on 16 (16) 18 (20) 22 sts, take back the 31 (34) 36 (39) 43 stitches from the front piece, cast on 16 (16) 18 (20) 22 sts and take back the 31 (34) 36 (39) 43 sts from the back piece. Then, work the 94 (100) 108 (118) 130 sts in the round using double stockinette stitch for 4 cm/ 2". Once the band is 4 cm/ 2' long, bind off all the remaining stitches using the Italian Bind Off technique.

## **Decorative neckline (optional)**

Cut 50 (50) 60 (60) 70 threads of 30 cm long, fold them in half two by two. Then, using a 3mm (US D/3) crochet hook, place them on the beginning of the collar section. Once the fringe is set up, cut the threads gradiently.
