MATERIALS

Tweed Delight 1 ball of each colour: Geranium (13) Pink Confetti (16) Azurite (26) Dark Raspberry (11)

Pearly Haze

1 ball of each colour: Artichoke (110) Aster (69) Wild Berry (56)

Tweed Dreams

Golden Spices (11) X 1 Ball

5mm Needles (US H-8) Yarn needle Scissors

YARN QUALITY

Tweed Delight, Hobbii 85% wool, 10% acrylic, 5% viscose 50 g (1.75 oz) = 100 m (109 yds)

Pearly Haze, Hobbii

73% Viscose, 27% Wool 50 g (1.75 oz) = 110 m (120 yds)

Tweed Dreams, Hobbii 100 % premium acrylic 50 g / 1.75 oz = 100 m (109 yds)

GAUGE

Worked in SS 16 stitches x 22 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm /4" x 4"

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 26 cm / 10" Length: 70 cm / 27.6"

PATTERN INFORMATION

The Sweet Treat stocking pattern is a bold, fun Fair Isle design, which is knitted flat. The pattern is aimed at Intermediate & Advanced beginner knitters, and is the perfect pattern to try out knitted colourwork as all the Fair Isle sections are un-shaped. The pattern includes photos and Fair Isle colour charts to follow. The design uses a mix of tweed and pearly yarn to give it great texture and shine, with the addition of bobbles to add some 3d elements.

Pattern



ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit
P = Purl
K2tog = Knit 2 together
SSK = slip 2 stitches knitwise, knit these 2 stitches together through back loops; single left-leaning decrease
P2tog tbl = purl 2 together through the back loop
KFB = knit 1 into front and back of a stitch; single knit increase
PFB = purl 1 into front and back of a stitch; single purl increase
MB = Make Bobble : In contrast colour [KFB, KFB, K) all in next st. 5 Sts total. Turn. P5. Turn.
K5, Turn P5, Turn K5tog - bobble made
SS = Stocking Stitch: [1 row knit, 1 row purl] repeat

INFO AND TIPS

- 1. The pattern is worked flat in one long piece and seamed to create the final stocking.
- 2. The pattern uses the Fair Isle technique, when working with multiple colours it's important to make sure you don't pull your tension too tight (long knitting needles help this) and twist at the back to trap the carrying yarn and make sure you don't leave long floats.
- 3. When colour changing and using lots of different colours, you can secure the ends and starting tails by twisting every st on the wrong side at the beginning of the row, this means you don't need to secure your ends at the end of the project.





COLOUR KEY

Colour A: Tweed Delight / Pink Confetti (16)
Colour B: Tweed Delight / Dark Raspberry (11)
Colour C: Tweed Delight / Geranium (13)
Colour D: Pearly Haze/ Aster (69)
Colour E: Tweed Dreams/ Golden Spices (11)
Colour F: Tweed Delight / Azurite (26)
Colour G: Pearly Haze/ Artichoke (110)
Colour H: Pearly Haze/ Wild Berry (56)

PATTERN

Rib

Cast on: Cable Cast on 44 sts in Colour A
Row 1: [K2, P2] repeat across
Row 2: [P2, K2] repeat across
These 2 Rows create your 2 X 2 Rib repeat
Rows 3-4 : In Colour B work 2 rows in Rib repeat
Rows 5-7: In Colour F work 3 rows in Rib repeat
Rows 8- 12: In Colour C work 5 rows in Rib repeat
Rows 13-32: In Colour A work 20 rows in Rib repeat

STOCKING FRONT


Starting on a Knit row and working in Stocking Stitch (SS), follow along with Fair Isle Chart. Work from the top down, work 3 repeats of the pattern. For Row 37 of pattern which is the Bobble row, create each Bobble in contrast colour working in colour order D/G/H across the row. Bobble is shown by a dot on the pattern grid. Secure contrast colour by tying ends together when fastening off.

Work a total of 118 rows in SS

Top Tip: When working Fair Isle with 2 colours make sure to not pull the tension too tight. Twist colours at the back of work to avoid long floats, twist at least every 3-4 sts.







TOE

Row 1: Continuing in Colour A, K2, SSK, K36, K2tog, K2

Row 2: P

Row 3: K2, SSK, K across till last 4 sts, K2tog, K2

Row 4: P

Repeat Row 3 & 4 until you have 26 sts, this works a decrease each end every Knit row

Row 19: K2, SSK, K across till last4 sts, K2tog, K2

Row 20: P2, P2tog, P across till last 4 sts, P2tog tbl, P2

Repeat Rows 19 & 20 until you have 16 sts, this works a decrease each end, every row. Row 24: P

Row 25: Now working the increase, K2, KFB, K across until last 4 sts, KFB, K3

Row 26: P2, PFB, P across until last 4 sts, PFB, P3

Repeat Rows 25-26 until you have 44 sts, this works an increase each end every row.

Row 38: P

Sole Stripes

Follow Fair Isle chart working SS, starting on a knit row for a total of 42 rows

HEEL

Row 1: In Colour F, K
Row 2: P2, P2tog, P across till last 4 sts, P2tog tbl, P2
Row 3:K2, SSK, K across till last 4 sts, K2tog, K2
Repeat Rows 2 & 3 until you have 16 sts, this works a decrease each end, every row.
Row 15: K
Row 16: Now working the increase, P2, PFB, P across until last 4 sts, PFB, P3
Row 17: K2, KFB, K across until last 4 sts, KFB, K3
Repeat Rows 16-17 until you have 44 sts, this works an increase each end every row.
Row 30: P

LEG STRIPES

Follow Fair Isle chart working SS, starting on a knit row for a total of 76 rows



RIB

Row 1: In Colour A [K2, P2] repeat across
Row 2: [P2, K2] repeat across
These 2 Rows create your 2 X 2 Rib repeat
Rows 3-20: Continue 18 rows in Rib repeat
Rows 21-25: In Colour C work 5 rows in Rib repeat
Rows 26-28: In Colour F work 3 rows in Rib repeat
Rows 29- 30: In Colour B work 2 rows in Rib repeat
Rows 31-32: In Colour A work 2 rows in Rib repeat
Cast Off in Rib

HANGING LOOP

Working in Colour G Cable Cast on 80 sts. Knit 12 rows Cast Off, leave ends long and use to join



Block: Block stocking to flatten out colourwork before joining. Use a steam iron 20 cm above the piece to steam block or wet block in warm water.



JOIN

Join your stocking by sewing together the heel and toe seams using backstitch on the wrong side of the piece. Sew together working 1 st in from the edge using the same colour to match joins.

- 1. Fold toe section at smallest part. Sew along outside diagonal edges. Ease the top of the toe seam into the under toe seam, the toe halves are not equal and this creates more volume in the front of the toe.
- 2. Fold heel section at smallest part. Sew along outside diagonal edges. Join heel seams together.
- 3. Join the long seams along the sides of the sole. Work in Colour C, the bobble row should meet up with the heel join.
- 4. Join the leg stripe section to the front panel in Colour H.
- 5. Complete stocking join by joining the top rib, as the rib will fold back join the first half on the wrong side, changing to join on the right side for the last half, so the seam is not shown when turned down.
- 6. Attach the loop by folding it in half and securing on the inside at the centre back, at the point where the rib meets the stripe.



Finish up by sewing in any remaining ends, turning the right way round and filling up with goodies!
