MATERIALS

Friends Wool: 2 skeins of color White (01)

Friends Cotton 8/4: 1 skein color Tomato (40) 1 skein color Black (124) 1 skein color Orange (30)

Crochet hook 4 mm / US G/6 Crochet hook 2.5 mm / US C/2 Sewing pins Darning needle Stuffing Mini rubber bands for braids

YARN QUALITY

Friends Wool, Hobbii
100% wool
50 gr (1.75 oz) = 100 m (109 yds)

Friends Cotton 8/4, Hobbii
100 % cotton
50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (175 yds)

GAUGE

In dc, worked in rounds with Friends Wool and hook 4 mm (G/6) 16 dc x 11 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm SIZE 2-4 years (4-6 years) 6-9 years

MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: **19.7 (20.5) 21.25"/ 50 (52) 54** cm Length (from neck to forehead): **14 (15) 15.4" / 36 (38) 39** cm

PATTERN INFORMATION

Dimitri is a happy Snowman that will never melt! Therefore, he will be able to amuse your child for the whole winter period.

Dimitri Hat is made with Friends Wool, a thick, soft and very elastic yarn which makes it perfect for a hat. The details are worked with friends cotton 8/4 yarn.

The pattern is beginner-friendly as it uses basic stitches.

ABBREVIATIONS

st = stitch ch = chain sl st = slip stitch sc = single crochet dc = double crochet inc = crochet 2 sts in the same st dec = crochet 2 sts together mr = magic ring beg = beginning flo / blo = front / back loop only

INFO AND TIPS

The first part of the hat is worked in rounds, then earflaps are worked in rows and the hat is finished with a round of sc. The details are crochet and sewn on the hat.

Ch1 at the beginning of the round/row doesn't count as a st. Ch 2 ou ch3 at the beginning of the round/row count as a st.

How to work reverse single crochet: you work normal single crochet, but instead of going from right to left, you go from left to right. Insert crochet in the next st on the right, yo, pull loop, yo, pass through the two loops on hook.

HAT

With Friends Wool yarn color White and hook 4 mm (G/6)

Start with a mr.

Round 1: Ch3, work 11 dc in the ring, join with sl st to top of ch3. (12 sts)

Round 2: Ch3, 1 dc in the same st, inc in each sts. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (24 sts)

Round 3: Ch3, *inc, 1 dc in the next st* repeat from * to * until 1 st left, inc in the last st. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (36 sts)

Round 4: Ch3, 1 dc in the same st, *1 dc in the next 2 sts, inc in the next st* repeat from * to * until 2 sts left, 1 dc in the next 2 sts. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (48 sts)

Round 5: Ch3, 1 dc in the next 2 sts *inc, 1 dc in the next 3 sts* repeat from * to * until 1 st left, inc in the last st. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (60 sts)

Round 6: Ch3, 1 dc in the same st, *1 dc in the next 4 sts, inc in the next st* repeat from * to * until 4 sts left, 1 dc in the next 4 sts. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (72 sts)

Size 2-4 years only:

Round 7: Ch3, 1 dc in next 8 sts, *inc in next st, 1 dc in next 9 sts*. repeat from * to * until 1 st left, inc in last st. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (80 sts)

Size 4-6 years only:

Round 7: Ch3, *1 dc in next 5 sts, inc in next st, 1 dc in next 6 sts, inc* repeat from * to * until 6 sts left, 1 dc in next 5 sts, inc in next st. Join with sl st to top of beg ch3. (83 sts)

Size 6-9 years only:

Round 7: Ch3, 1 dc in next st, inc in next st, 1 dc in next 2 sts, inc. *dc in next 5 sts, inc* repeat from * to * until 6 sts left. 1 dc in next 2 sts, inc next st, 1 dc in next 2 sts, inc. (86 sts)

For all sizes:

Rounds 8 to 14 (16) 17: Ch3, 1 dc in each sts around. Fasten off. (**80 (83) 86** sts, **7 (9) 10** rounds in total).

Try the hat on your child to check the circumference and the length, 2 rows will be added on the neck. Fasten off.

EARFLAPS

With Friends Wool yarn color White and hook 4 mm (G/6)

First Earflap

From the end of the round, count **27 (28) 29** sts to the right. The first st counted is the st at the right of the ch3. And join the yarn on the **27th (28th) 29th** st.

Row 1: Ch2, 1 dc in the next **53 (55) 57** sts. Turn (**54 (56) 58** sts)

Row 2: Ch2, work 1 dec, 1 dc in each st until 3 sts left. Work 1 dec and 1 dc on top of ch2. Turn (**52 (54) 56** sts)

Row 3: Ch2, 1 dec, 1 dc in the next 6 sts, 1 dec, 1 dc on top of ch2. Turn. (10 sts)

Row 4: Ch2, 1 dec, 1 dc in the next 4 sts, 1 dec, 1 dc on top of ch2. Turn. (8 sts)

Row 5: Ch2, 1 dec, 1 dc in the next 2 sts, 1 dec, 1 dc on top of ch2. Turn. (6 sts)

Row 6: Ch2, 2 dec, 1 dc on top of ch2. Fasten off. (4 sts) Weave in ends.



Second Earflap

With the right side facing you. Go to the start of Row 2, count 12 to the right and insert crochet in the 12th st.

Repeat Rows 3 to 6. DO NOT fasten off and continue with *Border*.

Border

Ch1 and work with right side facing. Sc all around the hat, work 2 sc in each corner, and 2 sc around each dc and ch2 on the earflaps' sides, and 1 sc in each st. Be sure to don't make too much or not enough sc to avoid ripple or shrink. Weave in ends.

HAT

With col Black and Tomato, hook 2.5 mm (C/2).

With Black yarn, make a magic circle **Round 1:** Ch1 (doesn't count as a st), 6 sc in mc. Sl st in first st. (6 sts)

Round 2: ch1, inc in each st. Sl st in first st. (12 sc)

Round 3: ch1, *1 sc in next st, inc* repeat from * to * around. Sl st in first st. (18 sts)

Round 4: ch1, *inc, 1 sc in next 2 sts* repeat from * to * around. Sl st in first st. (24 sts)

Round 5: ch1, *1 sc in next 3 sts, inc* repeat from * to * around. Sl st in first st. (30 sts)

Round 6: ch 1, 1 sc in next 2 sts, *inc, 1 sc in next 4 sts* repeat from * to * until 3 sts left. Inc in next st, 1 sc in last 2 sts. Sl st in first st. (36 sts)

Round 7: ch1, *1 sc in next 5 sts, inc* repeat from * to * around. Sl st in first st. (42 sts)

Round 8: ch 1, 1 sc in next 2 sts, *inc, 1 sc in next 6 sts* repeat from * to * until 5 sts left. Inc in next st, 1 sc in last 4 sts. Sl st in first st. (48 sts)

Round 9: ch1, *1 sc in next 7 sts, inc* repeat from * to * around. Sl st in first st. (54 sts)

Round 10: ch1, 1 sc blo in each st. Sl st in first st. (54 sts)

Rounds 11 to 21 : ch1, 1 sc in each st. Sl st in first st. (54 sts, 11 rounds)

Round 22: ch1, *1 sc flo in next 8 sts, inc flo* repeat from * to * around. Sl st in first st. (60 sts)

Round 23: ch1, 1 sc in next 2 sts, *inc, 1 sc in next 9 sts* repeat from * to * until 8 sts left. Inc in next st, 1 sc in last 7 sts. Sl st in first st. (66 sts)

Round 24: ch1, *1 sc in next 10 sts, inc* repeat from * to * around. Sl st in first st. (72 sts) **Round 25:** ch1, 1 sc in next 2 sts, *inc, 1 sc in next 11 sts* repeat from * to * until 10 sts left. Inc in next st, 1 sc in last 9 sts. Sl st in first st. (78 sts)

Round 26: ch1, *1 sc in next 12 sts, inc* repeat from * to * around. Sl st in first st. (84 sts)

Round 27: ch1, work 1 reverse single crochet in each st (see info and tips). Sl st in first st. (84 sts)

Fasten off, weave in ends. Stuff.

Ribbon

With Tomato yarn, ch 54 and join in round with sl st. **Round 1 to 3:** ch1, work 1 sc in each st. Sl st in first st. (54 sts, 3 rounds)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail to sew.

Place the ribbon on the hat. Be careful to place the beginning of the rounds from the ribbon and the hat together, and sew it on the 19th round and the 21th round from the hat (where the border began).

NOSE

With col Orange, hook 2.5 mm (C/2).

Ch4, (count as a dc) **Row 1:** work 2 dc in the fourth ch from the hook. Turn. (3 sts)

Row 2: ch3, 1 dc in the same st, 1 dc in next st, 2 dc in last st. Turn. (5 sts)

Row 3: ch3, 1 dc in the same st, 1 dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc in last st. Turn. (7 sts)

Row 4: ch3, 1 dc in each st. DO NOT TURN.

Round 5: ch1, work around the nose, work 2 sc around each dc and ch 3 in the ends of the rounds. 3 sc in the tip of the nose (the very first ch). Work 2 sc around each dc and ch 3 in the ends of the rounds, and 2 sc in the corner, 1 sc in each st from the previous row. Work 1 sc in the last corner and finish with an invisible join.

Fasten off leaving a long tail to sew.

EYES (make 2)

With col Black, hook 2.5 mm (C/2).

Make a magic circle **Round 1:** Ch1 (doesn't count as a st), 6 sc in mc. Sl st in first st. (6 sts)

Round 2: ch1, inc in each st. Sl st in first st. (12 sc)

Round 3: ch1, *1 sc in next st, inc* repeat from * to * around. Sl st in first st. (18 sts)

Round 4: ch1, *inc, 1 sc in next 2 sts* repeat from * to * around. (24 sts)



Finish with an invisible join, fasten off leaving a long tail to sew.

BRAIDS

Cut 24 strands of approx 16" (40 cm) of Friends Wool yarn color White

With the hook insert 4 strands in the first st at the bottom of the first ear flap. Pull the strands to their middle and fold in half. Repeat in the next 2 sts. You have 3 groups of 4 strands. Make a braid and use the mini rubber band to secure it. Repeat for the other earflap. Cut the strands to even out.

ASSEMBLY

- Place the top of eyes on round 8, and the bottom on round 11 with 7 sts between them, centering them on the forehead space. And sew them in place.
- Place the nose between the eyes. The corner with the tail is placed on round 11, the tip of the nose round 13 and the last corner in round 14. And sew it in place.
- With 2 strands of black, sew the mouth. The start is on round 13, aligned with the right side of the right eye. Count 3 rounds down and 7 sts to the left and here it's the end of the mouth. Sew the mouth with little sts in the shape of a smile.
- Place the hat on one side of the beanie, the border must meet the center of the magic ring. The end of rounds are on the back. With Black yarn, sew it in place.
 Before the hole is completely closed add some stuff if necessary but not too much.
- Weave in all ends.
