MATERIALS

Friends Extra Fine Merino

1 skein of col 02 1 skein of col 50

Crochet hook 2.5 mm / US B/1 Tapestry needle

YARN QUALITY

Friends Extra Fine Merino, Hobbii 100 % Wool 50 g / 1.75 oz = 165 m / 180 yds

GAUGE

One square = $5 \text{ cm x } 5 \text{ cm} / 2^{\prime\prime} \text{ x } 2^{\prime\prime}$

ABBREVIATIONS

mr = magic ring ch = chain dc = double crochet slpst = slip stitch inc = increase

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 5 cm / 2" Length: 175 cm / 68.9"

SQUARE 1 (make 7)



Start with pink, mr

Round 1: ch 3, dc2, ch, dc3, ch, dc3, ch, dc3, ch, change to white, slpst

Round 2: ch 3, dc 2, (inc dc, ch, inc dc) in chain space, (dc 3, (inc dc, ch, inc dc) in chain

space)x3

change to pink, slpst

Round 3: ch 3, dc 4, (inc dc, ch, inc dc) in chain space, dc 3, change to white, dc 4, (inc dc, ch, inc dc) in chain space, dc 4, change to pink, dc 3, inc dc in chain space, change to white, (ch, inc dc) in chain space, dc 7, (inc dc, ch, inc dc) in chain space, dc2, slpst.

Fasten off and weave in ends.



SQUARE 2 (make 7)



Start with pink, mr

Round 1: ch 3, dc2, ch, dc3, ch, dc3, ch, dc3, ch, change to white, slpst

Round 2: ch 3, dc 2, (inc dc, ch, inc dc) in chain space, (dc 3, (inc dc, ch, inc dc) in chain space)x3, slpst

Round 3: ch 3, dc 4, inc dc in chain space, change to pink, (ch 1, inc dc) in chain space, dc 6, change to white, dc, (inc dc, ch, inc dc) in chain space, dc 5, change to pink, dc 2, (inc dc, ch, inc dc) in chain space, dc 7, change to white, (inc dc, ch, inc dc) in chain space, dc 2, slpst

Fasten off and weave in ends.

SQUARE 3 (make 7)



Start with white, mr

Round 1: ch 3, dc2, ch, dc3, ch, dc3, ch, dc3, ch, slpst

Round 2: ch 3, dc 2, (inc dc, ch, inc dc) in chain space, dc 3, (inc dc, ch, inc dc) in chain space, dc, change to pink, dc 2, (inc dc, ch, inc dc) in chain space, dc 3, inc dc in chain space, change to white, (ch 1, inc dc) in chain space, slpst

Round 3: ch 3, dc 4, inc dc in chain space, change to pink, (ch 1, inc dc) in chain space, dc 7, inc dc in chain space, change to white, (ch 1, inc dc) in chain space, (dc 7, (inc dc, ch 1, inc dc) in chain space) x2, dc 2, slpst

Fasten off and weave in ends.



SQUARE 4 (make 7)



Start with pink, mr

Round 1: ch 3, dc2, ch, dc3, ch, dc3, ch, dc3, ch, change to white slpst

Round 2: ch 3, dc 2, (inc dc, ch, inc dc) in chain space, (dc 3, (inc dc, ch, inc dc) in chain space)x3, slpst

Round 3: ch 3, dc 4, (inc dc, ch, inc dc) in chain space, dc 7, inc dc in chain space, change to pink, (ch 1, inc dc) in chain space, dc 7, (inc dc, ch, inc dc) in chain space, dc 7, inc dc in chain space, change to white, (ch 1, inc dc) in chain space, dc 2, slpst

Fasten off and weave in ends.

SQUARE 5 (make 7)



Start with white, mr

Round 1: ch 3, dc2, ch, dc3, ch, dc3, ch, dc3, ch, slpst

Round 2: ch 3, dc 2, inc dc in chain space, change to pink, (ch 1, inc dc) in chain space, dc 3, (inc dc, ch 1, inc dc) in chain space, dc 3, change to white, (inc dc, ch 1, inc dc) in chain space, dc 2, change to pink, dc 1, inc dc in chain space, change to white, (ch 1, inc dc) in chain space, slpst

Round 3: change to pink, ch 3, dc 4, inc dc in chain space, change to white, (ch 1, inc dc) in chain space, dc 7, (inc dc, ch 1, inc dc) in chain space, dc 7, change to pink, (inc dc, ch 1, inc dc) in chain space, dc 2, change to white, dc 5, (inc dc, ch 1, inc dc) in chain space, dc 2, slpst

Fasten off and weave in ends.



ASSEMBLE

Block all squares

To assemble the scarf, attach one square on top of the other with a "Mattress Stitch", this makes an invisible seam. The process involves inserting the crochet hook under both loops of the edge stitches of each piece and pulling the yarn through, alternating between the two pieces. Mix the squares as you like and have fun!

To finish the scarf, make sc stitches all around and weave in the ends. I decided to use the white yarn to make a fringe on both ends, but you can skip this step:)

To attach fringes to the scarf follow these steps:

Cut several pieces of yarn to your desired length (mine are 10 cm / 4" long), fold the yarn to create a loop, using your hook insert the looped end of the yarn through a stitch along the edge of your scarf, pull those ends of the yarn through your loop creating a knot, tighten the knot secure. Continue attaching yarn loops along the scarf's edge. You can space them as closely or as far apart as you like. Use scissors to trim them to your desired length, ensuring they are even.
