Velvet Sunset

Blanket

MATERIALS

Honey Bunny

2 skeins of col. 27 **Col. A**

2 skeins of col. 62 **Col. B**

2 skeins of col. 94 **Col. C**

3 skeins of col. 09 **Col. D**

Knitting needles 6 mm (US 10)

Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Honey Bunny**, Hobbii

100% Polyester

300 g (10.5 oz) = 120 m (131 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 10 sts x 21 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

st/s = stitch/es

k = knit

p = purl

CO = Cast On

BO = Bind Off

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 110 cm / 43.3"

Height: 165 cm / 64.9"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Soft and cozy blanket with a modern character with intarsia technique. The blanket is made of lovely, very thick yarn which makes it quick to knit.

INFO AND TIPS

Insert colors on the right side of the blanket.

Cross the threads on the wrong side of the blanket.

Stitches used in the pattern:

Stockinette stitch (st.st.): purl on the wrong side, knit on the right side.

Reverse stockinette stitch (Rst.st.): purl on the right side, knit on the wrong side.

Seed stitch (s.st.): single knits and purls worked alternately horizontally and vertically.

BLANKET

With 6 mm (US 10) needles, and col. D CO 110 sts. Work 26 rows in a s.st. In the 27th row work 15 sts with col. D in a s.st., 80 sts with col. C in a Rst.st., and 15 sts with col. D in a s.st. Work this way the next 17 rows.

In the next row work:

15 sts col. D in a s.st.,

10 sts col. C in a Rst.st.,

1 sts col. B in a st.st.,

59 sts col. A in a st.st.,

10 sts col. C in a Rst.st.,

15 sts col. D in a s.st.

As shown on the diagram, 15 sts col. D in s.st., and 10 sts col. C in a Rst.st. at the beginning and at the end of the row forms a frame for the col. B and A worked in a st.st.

The number of sts in these colors changes, **in every 4th row expand col. B by 1 st. Work this way until there are 59 sts in col. B and 1 st. in col. A.**

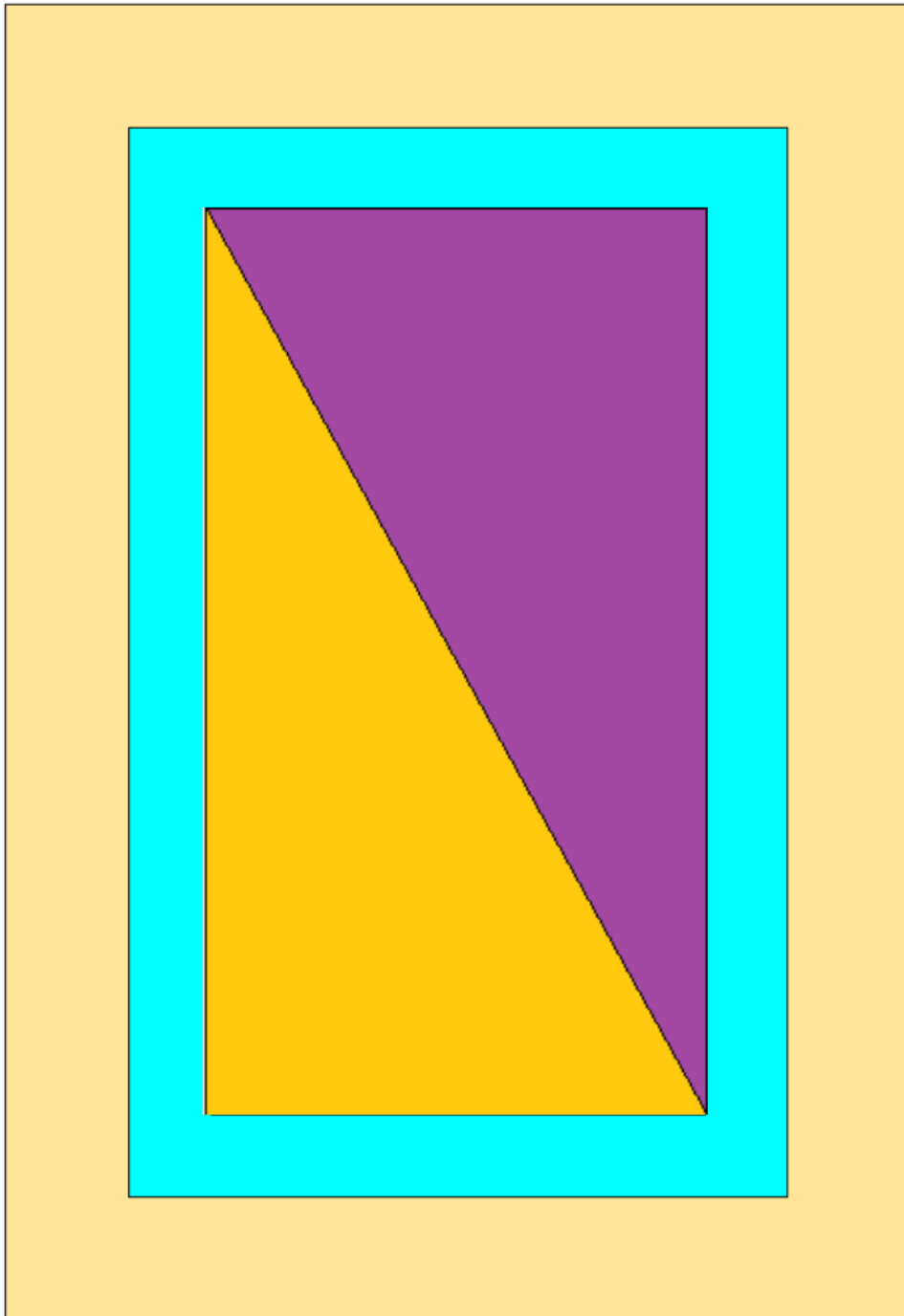
Then, in the next row, work 15 sts col. D in a s.st., 80 sts col. C in a Rst.st., 15 sts col. D in a s.st. Work this way through 17 rows. The next 26 rows work with col. D in a s.st.

BO all sts.
