MATERIALS

8 (9) 10 (11) skeins of Highland Wool col. 14
7 (8) 9 (10) skeins of Friends Kid Silk col. 86

Knitting needles 6 mm (US 10)
Circular needles 6 mm (US 10), 4 mm (US 6)
Tapestry needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Highland Wool**, Hobbii
100% Peruvian Highland Wool
50 g (1.8 oz) = 175 m (191 yds)

 **Friends Kid Silk**, Hobbii
72% Mohair, 25% Silk, 3% Wool
25 g (0.9 oz) = 200 m (218 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 18 sts x 22 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

st/s = stitch/es
k = knit
p = purl
CO = Cast On
BO = Bind Off

SIZE

XL (2XL) 3XL (4XL)

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 62 (67) 72 (77) cm / 24.4 (26.3) 28.3 (30.3)"
Length: 50 (52) 54 (60) cm / 19.6 (20.4) 21.2 (23.6)"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Soft and fluffy, easy to make sweater with an interesting stand-up neck. The sweater consists of separate pieces sewn together at the end.

INFO AND TIPS

The sweater is made with 1 thread of Highland Wool and 1 thread of Friends Kid Silk together.

Stitches used in the pattern

Rib stitch: k 2, p 2;

Stockinette stitch: purl on the wrong side, knit on the right side;

Neckline: according to the chart.

BODY

The back and front are made the same way.

CO 112 (120) 130 (140) sts on 6 mm needles. Work 12 (14) 16 (16) rows in a rib stitch, then work 88 (90) 94 (106) rows in a stockinette stitch.

In the next row, BO the middle 36 sts (all sizes) for the neckline, then BO in every other row 4 x 1 st. BO the remaining sts.

SLEEVE

CO 42 (42) 46 (46) sts on 6 mm needles. Work 11 (11) 15 (15) rows in a rib stitch.

In the next row increase 1 st every 5 sts. Start to work in a stockinette stitch. Increase 1 st in every 4th row on the both sides of the sleeve.

Work this way 50 (54) 60 (60) rows. BO all the sts.

Finishing

Sew the shoulders together, sew the sleeves, and then the front and back.

Pick 96 sts (all sizes) around the head opening on 4 mm circular needles, starting at the middle of the back.

Purl 1 round. Change to 6 mm circular needles. Work the chart. All even rounds - knit all stitches. After knitting the full chart BO all stitches in purl.

CHART

Repeat 3 times. In even rows knit all stitches and yarn overs.

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- - purl sts
- blank - knit sts
- U - yarn over
- ▲ - slip 2 sts knitwise, k 1, pass 2 sts over the knitted st
