



CROCHET PATTERN

Apu

Poncho

Design: Knit Gang | Hobbii Design




MATERIALS

10 (11) 12 skeins of Friends Wool color 88

Crochet hook 5 mm / US H/8
Stitch Markers
Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Wool**, Hobbii
100 % Wool
50 g / 1.75 oz = 100 m / 109 yds

GAUGE

14 sts x 7 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain
sc = single crochet
hdc = half double crochet
dc = double crochet
sl st = slip stitch
sm = stitch marker
puff = puff stitch: insert the hook in the st, pull out the loop, *yarn over, insert the hook into the st, pick up the yarn* repeat from * to * 2 times, yarn over and pull through all the loops on the hook.

SIZE

S (M) L

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 55 (61) 69 cm / 21.7" (24") 27"
Length: 55 (58) 61 cm / 21.7" (22.8") 24"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Cozy poncho in a minimalist style, with a high turtleneck, made of soft and stretchy wool. It is very easy to make, as it is worked straight in two panels back and front and sewn together at the end. Lastly, the turtleneck is worked in the rounds and the cord for the sides are added.

The pattern is beginner-friendly.

INFO AND TIPS

The poncho in the pictures is in size S, if you want the poncho to be wider or longer, you can easily modify the number of rows/stitches. Just remember to calculate more/less skein(s) of yarn.

BACK PIECE

Ch 81 (89) 97.

Row 1: dc in the 3rd ch from the hook (ch 2 counts as 1 st every time), 39 (43) 47 dc, place a sm in the next st, 40 (44) 48 dc, ch 2, turn,

Row 2: dc to one st before sm, ch 1, skip 1 st, 2 puffs in the marked st, ch 1, skip 1 st, dc to the end, ch 2, turn,

Row 3: dc to one st before puffs, ch 1, skip 1 st, 2 puffs between the puffs from the other row, ch 1, skip 1 st, dc to the end, ch 2, turn,

Row 4 - 40 (42) 44: repeat Row 3.

FRONT PIECE

Work just like the back piece up to the 38th (40th) 42nd row.

Row 39 (41) 43: 25 (29) 33 dc, ch 2, turn,

Row 40 (42) 44: 25 (29) 33 dc, ch 2, cut the yarn, leaving long tail to sew.

Join the thread on the other side and repeat the last two rows.

ASSEMBLING

Turtleneck

Place the two parts with the right sides facing each other and sew the shoulders together with your preferred method, I joined them with sc. Do not flip the piece to the right side and start working the turtleneck further on the wrong side. Join the thread to any st on the neckline and work dc around in a spiral, marking the beginning of the round with a sm. Work to the desired height, I did 15 cm, finish with 1 hdc, 1 sc and 1 sl st.



Cords

To make the cords on the sides, attach the thread to the 15th row, ch 20, start to work sc from the 2nd ch from the hook, sc to the end, fasten off, then attach the yarn to the 8th row, and repeat the same steps. Repeat on the other sides of the poncho. Of course, you can make the cords longer, or place them in a different position. Weave in all ends.
