MATERIALS

Friends Cotton 8/6:

1 skein of color 51

1 skein of color 26

1 skein of color 88

1 skein of color 40

1 skein of color 03

1 skein of color 94

1 skein of Glitter Deluxe - Pure Gold (18135)

Crochet hook 2.75 mm / US C2 2 safety eyes 8 mm Stuffing Tapestry needle

YARN QUALITY

2 Friends Cotton 8/6, Hobbii 100% Cotton 50 g / 1.75 oz = 105 m / 115 yds

Glitter Deluxe 30g, Go Handmade 100% Polyester 30 g / 1.1 oz. = 1200-1800 m / 1950-2300 yds

ABBREVIATIONS

BLO = back loop only ch = chain dec = decrease inc = increase mr = magic ring sc = single crochet slst= slip stitch st = stitch Rnd = round

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Height: Approx. 19 cm / 7.5"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Luna Cockatoo is an intermediate project, worked in a continuous spiral. To keep track of the rounds you may use a stitch marker or safety pin to mark the beginning of a round. The head and the body are worked in a single piece. Luna Cockatoo also has 1 accessory: a wreath that she uses as a nest. Remember that it's always advisable to give the entire pattern a read before starting crocheting and, most importantly, be patient with yourself!

INFO AND TIPS

Head and body are worked in one piece. The beak and the big feather are worked in one piece. Some parts are worked with two strands in order to create a blend of colors. One is made by using color (26) and Glitter Deluxe Pure Gold, and the other is made by using color (94) and Glitter Deluxe Pure Gold.

CHEEKS (make 2)

Work with color (26)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr [6]

Rnd 2: inc in all 6 st [12]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

BEAK AND BIG FEATHER

Start with color (88)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr [6]

Rnd 2: sc in all 6 st [6]

Rnd 3: (sc in next st, inc in next st) repeat 3 times [9]

Rnd 4-6: sc in all 9 st [9]

Change to color (51)

Rnd 7: (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st) repeat 3 times [12]

Rnd 8-10: sc in all 12 st [12]

Rnd 11: (sc in next 3 st, inc in next st) repeat 3 times [15]

Rnd 12-14: sc in all 15 st [15]

Rnd 15: (sc in next 4 st, inc in next st) repeat 3 times [18]

Rnd 16-25: sc in all 18 st [18]

Stuff and continue stuffing as you go.

Change to color (26)

Rnd 26-30: sc in all 18 st [18]

Rnd 31: (sc in next 4 st, dec) repeat 3 times [15]

Rnd 32: sc in all 15 st [15]

Rnd 33: (sc in next 3 st, dec) repeat 3 times [12]

Rnd 34: (sc in next 2 st, dec) repeat 3 times [9]

Rnd 35: (sc in next st, dec) repeat 3 times [6]



Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Using a tapestry needle, weave the yarn tail through the front loop of each remaining stitch and pull tight to close. Weave in the yarn end.

HEAD AND BODY

Start with color (51)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr (6)

Rnd 2: inc in all 6 st [12]

Rnd 3: (sc in next st, inc in next st) repeat 6 times [18]

Rnd 4: (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st) repeat 6 times [24]

Rnd 5: (sc in next 3 st, inc in next st) repeat 6 times [30]

Rnd 6: (sc in next 4 st, inc in next st) repeat 6 times [36]

Rnd 7: (sc in next 5 st, inc in next st) repeat 6 times [42]

Rnd 8: (sc in next 6 st, inc in next st) repeat 6 times [48]

Rnd 9-19: sc in all 48 st [48]

Insert the safety eyes on the opposite side of the start of the round, between rounds 13 and 14, with an interspace of 11 stitches. Sew the cheeks behind the safety eyes.

Change to color (03) and continue working in a jacquard pattern, alternating color (03) and color (40) according to the diagram.

Rnd 20-30: sc in all 48 st [48]

Change to color (51)

Rnd 31: BLO sc in all 48 st [48]

Rnd 32: Find the middle back of the cockatoo body. If you are not there yet, continue crocheting until that point. Then, ch 7 (Place a stitch marker in the next st you make -the first you will make on the foundation chain, this will mark the beginning of the next rounds.) Crochet back on the chain, start in second ch from the hook, inc in next st, sc in next 5 st, sc in the stitch where the foundation chain starts, continue on the body and sc in next 48 st, continue on the other side of the chain and sc in next 5 st, inc in last st [63]

Rnd 33: inc in next 2 st, sc in next 59 st, inc in last 2 st [67]

Rnd 34-35: sc in all 67 st [67]

Stuff the body and continue stuffing as you go.

Rnd 36: sc in next 3 st, dec, sc in next 57 st, dec, sc in next 3 st [65]

Rnd 37: sc in next 3 st, dec, sc in next 20 st, dec, sc in next 10 st, dec, sc in next 21 st, dec, sc in next 3 st [61]

Rnd 38: sc in next 24 st, dec, sc in next 8 st, dec, sc in next 25 st [59]

Rnd 39: sc in next 3 st, dec, sc in next 19 st, dec, sc in next 6 st, dec, sc in next 20 st, dec, sc in next 3 st [55]

Rnd 40: sc in next 23 st, dec, sc in next 4 st, dec, sc in next 24 st [53]

Rnd 41: sc in next 3 st, dec, sc in next 20 st, dec, sc in next 21 st, dec, sc in next 3 st [50]

Rnd 42: sc in next 3 st, dec, sc in next 40 st, dec, sc in next 3 st [48]

Rnd 43: (sc in next 6 st, dec) repeat 6 times [42]

Rnd 44: (sc in next 5 st, dec) repeat 6 times [36]

Rnd 45: (sc in next 4 st, dec) repeat 6 times [30]

Rnd 46: (sc in next 3 st, dec) repeat 6 times [24]

Rnd 47: (sc in next 2 st, dec) repeat 6 times [18]

Rnd 48: (sc in next st, dec) repeat 6 times [12]

Rnd 49: dec 6 times [6]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Add more stuffing if needed. Using a tapestry needle, weave the yarn tail through the front loop of each remaining stitch and pull tight to close. Weave in the yarn end.



MEDIUM FEATHER

Start with color (26)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr [6]

Rnd 2: sc in all 6 st [6]

Rnd 3: (sc in next st, inc in next st) repeat 3 times [9]

Rnd 4: (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st) repeat 3 times [12]

Rnd 5-6: sc in all 12 st [12]

Rnd 7: (sc in next 3 st, inc in next st) repeat 3 times [15]

Change to color (51)

Rnd 8: sc in all 15 st [15]

Rnd 9: (sc in next 4 st, inc in next st) repeat 3 times [18]

Rnd 10-12: sc in all 18 st [18]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Stuff a little with fiberfill.

SMALL FEATHER

Start with color (26)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr [6]

Rnd 2: sc in all 6 st [6]

Rnd 3: (sc in next st, inc in next st) repeat 3 times [9]

Rnd 4: (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st) repeat 3 times [12]

Rnd 5: sc in all 12 st [12]

Rnd 6: (sc in next 3 st, inc in next st) repeat 3 times [15]

Change to color (51)

Rnd 7: sc in all 15 st [15]

Rnd 8: (sc in next 4 st, inc in next st) repeat 3 times [18]

Rnd 9-10: sc in all 18 st [18]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Stuff a little with fiberfill.

ASSEMBLY

Place the beak/big feather on to the head so the beak is in between the eyes, with the point of the beak over round 15. Sew the beak and big feather onto the head over round 15 on the front to round 5 on the back of the head. Place the medium feather under the big feather, and sew it between rounds 5 and 8. Place the small feather under the medium feather, and sew it between rounds 8 and 10.

WINGS (make 2)

Start with color (51)

Leave a long starting yarn tail to sew the wings to the body.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr (6)

Rnd 2: inc in all 6 st [12]

Rnd 3: (sc in next st, inc in next st) repeat 6 times [18]

Rnd 4-5: sc in all 18 st [18]

Rnd 6: (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st) repeat 6 times [24]

Rnd 7-8: sc in all 24 st [24]

Change to color 26 and Glitter Deluxe Pure Gold

Rnd 9: sc in all 24 st [24]

Rnd 10: (sc in next 2 st, dec) repeat 6 times [18]

Rnd 11: sc in all 18 st [18]

Rnd 12: (sc in next 4 st, dec) repeat 3 times [15]



Rnd 13: sc in all 15 st [15]

Rnd 14: (sc in next 3 st, dec) repeat 3 times [12]

Rnd 15: sc in all 12 st [12] Rnd 16: dec 6 times [6]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Do not stuff. Using a tapestry needle, weave the yarn tail through the front loop of each remaining stitch and pull tight to close. Weave in the yarn end. Sew the wings to both sides, over rounds 32 and 39.

FEET (make 2)

Work with color (88)

Rnd 1: 8 sc in mr [8]

Rnd 2-3: sc in all 8 st [8]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Stuff a little with fiberfill. Sew the feet to the front, over rounds 40 to 44.

TAIL/BIG POMPON

Start with color (03)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr [6]

Change to color (40)

Rnd 2: inc in all 6 st [12]

Continue in a stripe pattern, changing color every round, alternating color (40) and color (03)

Rnd 3: (sc in next st, inc in next st) repeat 6 times [18]

Rnd 4: (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st) repeat 6 times [24]

Rnd 5-9: sc in all 24 st [24]

Rnd 10: (sc in next 2 st, dec) repeat 6 times [18]

Rnd 11: (sc in next st, dec) repeat 6 times [12]

Stuff.

Rnd 12: dec 6 times [6]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew the pompom centered to the back of the cockatoo body.

WREATH

Work with color (94) and Glitter Deluxe Pure Gold.

Ch 30. Make sure your chain isn't twisted. Insert the hook in the first chain stitch and join the foundation chain with a slst.

Rnd 1: (sc in next 4 st, inc in next st) repeat 6 times [36]

Rnd 2: (sc in next 5 st, inc in next st) repeat 6 times [42]

Rnd 3: (sc in next 6 st, inc in next st) repeat 6 times [48]

Rnd 4: (sc in next 7 st, inc in next st) repeat 6 times [54]

Rnd 5: (sc in next 8 st, inc in next st) repeat 6 times [60]

Rnd 6-13: sc in all 60 st [60]

Rnd 14: (sc in next 8 st, dec) repeat 6 times [54]

Rnd 15: (sc in next 7 st, dec) repeat 6 times [48]

Rnd 16: (sc in next 6 st, dec) repeat 6 times [42]

Rnd 17: (sc in next 5 st, dec) repeat 6 times [36]

Rnd 18: (sc in next 4 st, dec) repeat 6 times [30]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew round 18 to round 1 to make a ring. Stuff as you go.




LITTLE SPOTS (make 4 in color 26 and 4 in color 51)

Rnd 1: 8 sc in mr [8]

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew the little spots on the wreath.
