## Angel

Blanket

## MATERIALS

Amigo Chunky
A: 3 skeins color A56
B: 3 skeins color A47
C: 3 skeins color A49
D: 1 skein color A16

Needles 9 mm (US 13)
Darning needle

## YARN QUALITY

(a53) Amigo Chunky, Hobbii
100\% Acrylic
$100 \mathrm{~g}(3.5 \mathrm{oz})=100 \mathrm{~m}(109 \mathrm{yds})$

## GAUGE

$10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}\left(4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}\right)=10$ sts $\times 15$ rows

## ABBREVIATIONS

$\mathrm{K}=$ knit
P = purl
St(s) = Stitch(es)
C/on = Cast on
C/off = Cast off

## SIZE

One size

## MEASUREMENTS

Height: $111 \mathrm{~cm}-43.70^{\prime \prime}$
Width: $94 \mathrm{~cm}-37{ }^{\prime \prime}$

## PATTERN INFORMATION

This graphic blanket will add a beautiful dash of color to any room. The blanket is an easy and quick knit with bulky yarn on needles 9 mm (US 13). The blanket is knitted with intarsia technique in stockinette stitch with a contrast line in garter sts and a wide border in moss stitch.

## INFO AND TIPS

First you knit the bottom border, then you work a pattern repeat with squares in intarsia and a contrast color line in garter sts, and then finally knit the top border in moss stitch.

## Intarsia

Twist your yarns when changing colours at the back of your work (on the wrong side only). The change of colour will be marked with the yarn letters A, B, C or D.

## BLANKET

C/on 100 sts with yarn A

## Border, bottom

Row 1: (K1, P1) repeat to the end of the row with yarn A
Row 2: (P1, K1) repeat to the end of the row with yarn A Work Row 1 and Row 2 a total of 6 times $=12$ rows in total

Start a new ball at each change of colour

## Pattern

Squares
**Row 1: $(K 1 A, P 1 A) \times 4,(K 14 B, K 14 C) \times 3,(K 1 A, P 1 A) \times 4$
Row 2: (P1A, K1A) x 4, (P14C, P14B) $\times 3,(P 1 A, K 1 A) \times 4$
Knit Row 1 and Row 2 a total of 7 times $=14$ rows in total
Row 3: $(\mathrm{K} 1 \mathrm{~A}, \mathrm{P} 1 \mathrm{~A}) \times 4,(\mathrm{~K} 14 \mathrm{C}, \mathrm{K} 14 \mathrm{~B}) \times 3,(\mathrm{~K} 1 \mathrm{~A}, \mathrm{P} 1 \mathrm{~A}) \times 4$
Row 4: $(P 1 A, K 1 A) \times 4,(P 14 B, P 14 C) \times 3,(P 1 A, K 1 A) \times 4$
Work Row 3 and Row 4 a total of 7 times $=14$ rows in total

Line
Row 5: $(\mathrm{K} 1 \mathrm{~A}, \mathrm{P} 1 \mathrm{~A}) \times 4, \mathrm{~K}$ with D until the last 8 sts, $(\mathrm{K} 1 \mathrm{~A}, \mathrm{P} 1 \mathrm{~A}) \times 4$
Row 6: $(P 1 A, K 1 A) \times 4, K$ with D until the last 8 sts, $(P 1 A, K 1 A) \times 4$

Work Row 5 and Row 6 a total of 3 times** $=6$ rows in total

Repeat from ** to ** 3 times

Work Squares Row 1 and Row 2 a total of 7 times

Work Squares Row 3 and Row 4 a total of 7 times

## Border, top

Row 1: (K1, P1) repeat to the end of the row with yarn A
Row 2: (P1, K1) repeat to the end of the row with yarn A
Work Row 1 and Row 2 a total of 6 times $=12$ rows in total

C/off loosely all the sts, cut the yarn and make secure

## FINISHING UP

Weave in all ends.
