Puppy Dog Pouch

MATERIALS

6 skeins of Ribbon col. 15 2 skeins of Friends Cotton 8/4 col. 05

Crochet hooks: 8 mm / US L/11 5 mm / US H/8/6 Stitcher markers Yarn needle

YARN QUALITY

Ribbon, Hobbii
 100 % Cotton
 250 g / 8.8 oz. = 125 m / 137 yds

Friends Cotton 8/4, Hobbii
 100 % Cotton
 50 g / 1.75 oz. = 160 m / 175 yds

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 7.5 sts x 6 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain sc = single crochet Hdc = half double crochet Dc = double crochet Fpdc = front post double crochet Bpdc = back post double crochet Sm = stitch markers Bor = beginning of round Sc2tog = 2 single crochet together

SIZE

One size - made for small dogs under 4.5 kg/ 10 lbs

MEASUREMENTS

Base Width: 51 cm/20" x 19 cm/7.5" Depth: 20 cm/ 8" Strap Length: 84 cm/ 33" Strap Width: 6 cm/2.5"

PATTERN INFORMATION

This is a heavy duty bag that is made to carry your small dog around.

It is made with two strands of Ribbon held together which makes it a rather fast project. The bag has two practical pockets and a small decorative heart made in Friends Cotton 8/4.

INFO AND TIPS

The base of the bag is with 2 strands of Ribbon yarn held together, worked around the chain and bottom up. The strap length is customizable to your preference. Beginning ch does not count as st unless otherwise specified.

BASE OF BAG

Holding 2 strands of Ribbon yarn held together and 8 mm / US L/11 hook Ch 21

Round 1: 2 hdc in 2nd ch from hook(skipped ch and hdc count as 2 hdc), hdc in the next 19 chs, in the next ch work 3 hdc, turn to the opposite side, hdc in next 20, sl st in ch 1 at bor. (44 hdc)

You will need 4 stitch markers. Place a sm in the 1st and last hdc of 3 hdc on both edges and remove and replace as instructed in each round as you go.

Round 2: ch 1(counts as st), in next st, (hdc, ch 2, hdc), place sm in ch 2 space, *hdc in each st to next sm, in next st work (hdc, ch 2, hdc), place sm in ch 2 space*, hdc in next st**, in next st work (hdc, ch 2, hdc), place sm in ch 2 space, REPEAT from * ending last repeat at ** then, sl st in ch 1 at bor.

(21 hdc across, 3 hdc down side)

Continue to remove and replace sm in ch 2 spaces each round as you go.

Round 3: ch 1(counts as st), *hdc in each st to sm, in the ch 2 space work (hdc, ch 2, hdc)**, REPEAT from * ending last repeat at ** then, hdc to end, sl st in of ch 1 at bor. (23 hdc across, 5 hdc down side)

REPEAT Round 3, 5 more times, leaving stitch markers in place, making sure you are adding 2 hdc to each space between stitch markers or an additional 8 hdc each round. (25 hdc across, 7 hdc down side)

Next Round: working in blo, *hdc in each st to sm, work 2 hdc in each ch 2 space, placing a sm between them**, REPEAT from * ending at ** then hdc to end, sl st in ch 1 at bor.(104 sts; 35 hdc across, 17 hdc down side)



SIDE OF BAG

Sl st to 1st st after nearest stitch marker then continue, **Rounds 4-8:** ch 1, hdc in each st around making sure to leave all the sm in place, sl st in ch 1 at bor. (104 sts).

Rounds 9-11: ch 1, *hdc in each st to sm, ch 1, skip 1st st, then [hdc, ch 1, skip next st] repeat to sm, repeat from * then, sl st in ch 1 of bor. Cut yarn and sew in the ends.

STRAP

Holding 2 strands of Ribbon yarn together and an 8 mm / US L/11 hook

Moving to the shorter side sm, you should have 17 sts including stitch markers, skip 3 sts, in next st attach yarn, and ch 1

Row 1: ch 1, hdc in same st, hdc2tog, hdc in next 5 sts, hdc2tog in next 2 sts, hdc in last st, turn.

(9 sts)

Row 2: ch 1, hdc in same st, hdc2tog, hdc in next 3 sts, hdc2tog in next 2 sts, hdc in last st, turn.

(7sts)

Row 3: ch 1, hdc in same st, hdc2tog, hdc in next 1 sts, hdc2tog in next 2 sts, hdc in last st, turn.

(5sts)

Rows 4-30: ch 1, hdc in same st, hdc in next 4 sts, turn. (5 sts)

Cut the yarn, and sew in the ends.

You can adjust the length best for your personal needs as you go. Work fewer rows for a tighter fit.

Row 31: ch 1, hdc in same st, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in last st, turn (7sts)

Row 32: ch 1, hdc in same st, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 3 sts, 24 hdc in next st, hdc in last st, turn (9 sts)

Row 33: ch 1, hdc in same st, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 5 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in last st, turn (11 sts)

Now moving to the opposite side of the bag, turn bag inside out. Starting with the sm on the side skip 3 sts and attach yarn in the next st, sl st across, cut yarn and sew in ends.

POCKETS

Holding 2 strands of Friends cotton 8/4 together and an 5 mm / US H/8/6 hook

Ch 26, turn

Row 1: in 2nd ch from hook hdc, hdc in each ch to end, turn

Row 2: ch 1, hdc in same st, hdc in each st to end, turn.

Repeat Row 2-11 more times then,

Rows 12-15: CH 3(counts as st), fpdc in next st, bpdc in next st, REPEAT from * to last st, dc in last st, turn

Cut yarn leaving an extra long tail for sewing onto the bag.

Sew pockets on the side of the bag and look at the photos above for placement and use a slip st, a whip stitch, or whatever sewing method of choice. Sew onto the bottom left corner of the bag.



HEART APPLIQUE

Holding 2 strands of Friends cotton 8/4 together and an 5 mm/US H/8/6 hook Ch 2, working in 2nd ch from hook work 3 sc **Row 1:** ch 1, 2 sc in 1st st, sc in next st, 2 sc in last st, turn (5sts) Rows 2-6: ch 1 sc in same st, sc inc in next st, sc to last 2 sts, sc inc, sc in last st, turn(7 sts) (15 sts) Rows 7-9: ch 1, sc in each st across, turn (15 sts) Row 10: ch 1, sc in 1st, sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog, sc in last st, turn (6 sts) Row 11: ch 1, sc in 1st, sc2tog, sc2tog, sc in last st, turn (4 sts) **Row 12:** ch 1, (sc2tog)2x Row 13: sc2tog Cut yarn and sew in the ends. Attach yarn in the 8th st & the center of the heart and repeat Rows 10-13. Cut yarn leaving an extra long tail for sewing onto the bag. Look at the photos above for placement and using a slip st, a whip stitch or sewing method of choice, sew onto the bottom left corner of the bag.
