Cropped cardigan

## MATERIALS

$2(2,3,3,3)$ skeins of Diablo Wild Print color 03
1 skein of Friends Kid Silk color 13

Circular needles 12 mm (US17), 60 cm (23.6")

Stitch markers
Tapestry needle

## YARN QUALITY

(ab) Diablo Wild Print, Hobbii
40\% Acrylic, 30\% Mohair, 30\%
Polyamide
25 g / 0.9 oz = 225 m / 246 yds
(00) Friends Kid Silk, Hobbii

72\% Mohair, 25\% Silk, 3\% Wool
25 g / 0.9 oz = $200 \mathrm{~m} / 218 \mathrm{yds}$

## GAUGE

7 sts $\times 12$ rows $=10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm} / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$ with two strands of Friend Kid Silk in stockinette

## ABBREVIATIONS

$K=$ knit
P = Purl
St(s) = stitch(es)
RS = right side
WS = wrong side
SKPO = slip - knit - pass over
M1 = make one sts
$\mathrm{PO}=$ pass over
k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

XS (S, M, L, XL)

## MEASUREMENTS

Chest circumference: 67-76 ( 77-86, 87-96, 97-106, 107-116) cm / 26.5-30 ( 30.5-34, 34.5-37.5, 38-41.5, 42-45.5) in

Length: 32 (33, 35, 37, 38) cm / 12.5 (13.5, 14, $14.5,15$ ) in

## PATTERN INFORMATION

Vignale Cardigan is knitted from the bottom-up where the body is worked flat, with two strands of Diablo Wild Print.
The sleeves are knitted flat too separately and to be sewn together, with two strands of Diablo Wild Print alternated by two strands of Friends Kid Silk. Quite easy to work.

If you are in between two sizes, I recommend choosing the bigger one if you would like a more oversized fit or choosing the smaller one for a more fitted look.

## INFO AND TIPS

When there is only one number given, it means it applies to all sizes. When there is a " 0 " on your size, it means that instruction doesn't apply to your size.

A comma separates each size indication. A dash separates instructions for the same size. The word '*indications* - repeat **' means you have to repeat indications between asterisks across the row, if not differently subsequent specifications.

I recommend circling the number in the pattern which corresponds to the size you are making before starting to knit to prevent any confusion.

Remember a knitted garment will never be exactly the same as another. Each one is unique. It's absolutely normal, measurements will be a little bit different from the ones indicated in the pattern.

Remember that if you change the number of needles or stitches to match the measurements specified in the pattern or to achieve a different fit, you will need to recalculate and adjust the other pattern instructions accordingly. If you don't feel confident in performing this calculation due to your level of experience, I advise you to avoid making such modifications.

## BACK

Work with 2 strands of Diablo Wild Print.
Cast on $35(37,41,45,47)$ sts. Two are edge sts.
Row 1 (RS): knit all sts.
Row 2 (WS): purl all sts.

Row 3 to row 30 (32, 34, 36, 38): repeat Row 1 and Row 2, paying attention to the following decreases.

## Shaping the shoulders:

A. Row $25(27,29,31,33)$ or when the piece measures approx. $22.5(24.5,26.5,28,30)$ cm/ $9(9.5,10.5,11,12) \mathrm{in}$ : Bind off 2 sts - *knit st* - repeat **.
B. Row $26(28,30,32,34)$ : Bind off purling 2 sts - *purl st* - repeat **.
C. Row 27 (29, 31, 33, 35 ): instructions as in point A.
D. Row $28(30,32,34,36)$ : instructions as in point B.

Row 29 (31, 33, 35, 37): Bind off all the sts.

## FRONT RIGHT

Work with 2 strands of Diablo Wild Print. Cast on 16 ( $18,20,22,22$ ) sts. One is edge st.
Row 1 (RS): knit all sts.
Row 2 (WS): purl all sts.

Row 3 to Row 26 (28, 30, 32, 34): repeat Row 1 and Row 2, paying attention to the following decreases.

## Shaping the edge:

E. Row $3(3,5,5,5)$ and Row $11(9,11,9,9)$ and Row $19(15,15,13,13)$ and Row 25 (19, $19,17,17)$ and Row $0(23,23,21,21)$ and Row $0(27,27,25,25)$ and Row $0(0,0,29$, 29) and Row 0 ( $0,0,31,33$ ): k2 - SKPO - *knit st* - repeat **.

## Shaping the shoulders:

F. Row $24(26,28,30,32)$ or when the piece measures approx. 22 (23.5, 25.5, 27.5, 29) cm/ $8.5(9.5,10,10.5,11.5) \mathrm{in}$ : Bind off purling 2 sts - *purl st* - repeat **.
G. Row 26 (28, 30, 32, 34): instructions as in point F.

You have $8(8,10,10,10)$ sts on your needle.

Row 27 (29, 31, 33, 35): Bind off all the sts of the front right.
Remember that sts you have to join with the back are $12(12,14,14,14)$.

## FRONT LEFT

Work with 2 strands of Diablo Wild Print. Cast on 16 (18, 20, 22, 22) sts. One is edge st. Row 1 (RS): knit all sts.
Row 2 (WS): purl all sts.

Row 3 to Row 26 (28, 30, 32, 34): Repeat Row 1 and Row 2, paying attention to the following decreases.
Be sure to read all the points below before start knitting. Rows are categorized according to the purpose of the decreases, which may not always align with the numerical order. When encountering duplicated instructions for a single row, ensure that you follow both sets of instructions.

## Shaping the edge:

H. Row $3(3,5,5,5)$ and Row $11(9,11,9,9)$ and Row $19(15,15,13,13)$ and Row 25 (19, $19,17,17)$ and Row $0(23,23,21,21)$ and Row $0(27,27,25,25)$ and Row $0(0,0,29$, 29) and Row 0 ( $0,0,31,33$ ): *knit st* - repeat ** until there are 4 sts remaining: k2tog - k2.

Shaping the shoulders:
I. Row $23(25,27,29,31)$ or when the piece measures approx. $21(22.5,24.5,26.5,28)$ cm/ $8(9,9.5,10.5,11)$ in: Bind off 2 sts - *knit st* - repeat **.
J. Row $25(27,29,31,33)$ : as point I.

You have $8(8,10,10,10)$ sts on your needle.

Row 27 (29, 31, 33, 35): Bind off all the sts of the front left.
Remember that sts you have to join with the back are $12(12,14,14,14)$.

## SLEEVES

Work with 2 strands of Diablo Wild Print.
Cast on 31 (33, 35, 39, 41) sts. Two are edge sts.
Row 1 (RS): knit all sts.
Row 2 (WS): purl all sts.

Row 3 to Row 46 (48, 50, 50, 54): repeat Row 1 to Row 2, paying attention to the following yarn change and increases:

- Row 33 (35, 37, 37, 41): change from two strands of Diablo Wild Print to two strands of Friends Kid Silk.
- Row $37(39,41,41,45)$ or when the piece measures approx. $31.5(33.5,35.5,39) \mathrm{cm} /$ $12.5(13,14,14,15.5) \mathrm{in}: \mathrm{k} 1-* k 2-m 1-\mathrm{k} 2 *$ - repeat ** until there are $2(4,2,2,4)$ sts remaining:
- SIZE 1, SIZE 3, SIZE 4: k2.
- SIZE 2, SIZE 5: k2 - m1-k2.

You have $38(41,43,48,51)$ sts on your needle.

Row 47 (49, 51, 51, 55): Bind off all the sts.
Repeat for the second sleeve.

## JOIN

Join the neck by sewing the bound off edges of the fronts to the bound off edge of the back.
Join the sleeve hole by sewing 4 sts of the front left lateral side with4 sts of the back left lateral side; do the same with the right side, as well.

Sew the side sleeve seams by stitching through the first and last stitch of each row of the sleeve.

Sew the sleeve to the body by aligning and joining all stitches of the sleeve with
approximately $2 / 3$ of the body stitches, in this way: *sew 1 st - skip 1 st - sew 1 st* - repeat ** until there are $3(1,2,3,1)$ sts remaining:

- SIZE XS, SIZE S, SIZE L, SIZE XL: sew all sts.
- SIZE M: skip 1 st - sew 1 st.
