Basic Brioche

Beanie

MATERIALS

Friends Wool

1 (1) 2 skein(s) of color 89

1 (1) 2 skein(s) of color 12

Circular needle 3.75 mm, 60 cm / US 5, 24" Set of DPNs 3.75 mm / US 5 Cable needle Tapestry needle Stitch marker

YARN QUALITY

Friends Wool, Hobbii 100 % Wool 50 g / 1.75 oz = 100 m / 109 yds

GAUGE

14 sts x 20 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

SIZE

S (M) L

MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 46 (51) 56 cm / 18" (20") 22" Length: 26 (28) 30 cm /10" (11") 12"

PATTERN INFORMATION

This fully reversible two-color brioche beanie is the perfect go-to hat to add to your winter wardrobe.

Using a simple brioche rib, this hat is knit in the round from the bottom up with a crown comprised of five right-leaning decreases. It's a quick, straightforward pattern for both experienced brioche knitters and for those who are just looking for their first brioche project.

The green and blue version on the pictures is made with color 110 and 89.

ABBREVIATIONS

{ } = repeat

[] = work as many times as directed

CO = cast on

st(s) = stitch(es)

CC = contrasting color

MC = main color

K = knit

 $\mathbf{P} = \mathbf{purl}$

Sl1yo = slip 1, yarn over

Sl2yo = slip 2 sts and their yarnover together purlwise, yarnover

Rep = repeat

Rnd = round

BRK = brioche knit

BRP = brioche purl

C1B = slip 1 to cable needle, hold in back

BRK2tog = brioche knit 2 sts and their yarnovers together

BRP2tog = brioche purl the next two sts and their yarnover together

BrkRsI = slip the next st and its yarnover to right needle, C1B, move slipped st and its yarnover to left needle, BRK2tog, slip st from cable needle to left needle

INFO AND TIPS

To determine your size, simply measure the circumference of your head. The 46 cm/18" hat will fit most youths; 51 cm/20" is perfect for both teens and smaller adults; and 56 cm/22" is a great size for a standard male adult or for anyone who wishes to have additional "slouch" in the back of their beanie.

- Always hold your yarn in front for slipped stitches. All stitches are slipped purlwise.
- If you are using circular needles or magic loop, you may need to switch to DPNs to work the crown of the hat.
- Brioche is very stretchy, so when blocking your hat, don't stretch it out and pin it. Just lay it flat and gently pat it into the desired shape. This will keep it fluffy and soft!



HAT

Set-Up

Using 3.75 mm/US 5 circular needles and two-color tubular cast-on method, CO 60 (70) 80 sts beginning with CC.

Row 1 (CC): {sl1yo, P1} to end of row.

Row 1 (MC): {BRK, sl1yo} to end of row.

Place stitch marker and Join in round, careful not to twist.

Continue in Pattern

Rnd 1 (CC): {sl1yo, BRP} to end of rnd. Rnd 1 (MC): {BRK, sl1yo} to end of rnd.

Rep [Rnd 1 (CC) and Rnd 1 (MC)] 41 (50) 56 times.

DECREASE

Rnd 1A (CC): {sl1yo, BRP} to end of rnd.

Rnd 1A (MC): {[BRK, sl1yo] 4 (5) 6 times, BrkRsl, sl2yo} to end of rnd. Rnd 1B (CC): {[sl1yo, BRP] 4 (5) 6 times, sl1yo, BRP2tog} to end of rnd.

Rnd 1B (MC): {BRK, sl1yo} to end of rnd. 50 (60) 70 sts remain.

Rnd 2A (CC): {sl1yo, BRP} to end of rnd.

Rnd 2A (MC): {[BRK, sl1yo] 3 (4) 5 times, BrkRsl, sl2yo} to end of rnd.

Rnd 2B (CC): {[sl1yo, BRP] 3 (4) 5 times, sl1yo, BRP2tog} to end of rnd.

Rnd 2B (MC): {BRK, sl1yo} to end of rnd. 40 (50) 60 sts remain.

Rnd 3A (CC): {sl1yo, BRP} to end of rnd.

Rnd 3A (MC): {[BRK, sl1yo] 2 (3) 4 times, BrkRsl, sl2yo} to end of rnd.

Rnd 3B (CC): {[sl1yo, BRP] 2 (3) 4 times, sl1yo, BRP2tog} to end of rnd.

Rnd 3B (MC): {BRK, sl1yo} to end of rnd. 30 (40) 50 sts remain.

Rnd 4A (CC): {sl1yo, BRP} to end of rnd.

Rnd 4A (MC): {[BRK, sl1yo] 1 (2) 3 times, BrkRsl, sl2yo} to end of rnd.

Rnd 4B (CC): {[sl1yo, BRP] 1 (2) 3 times, sl1yo, BRP2tog} to end of rnd.

Rnd 4B (MC): {BRK, sl1yo} to end of rnd. 20 (30) 40 sts remain.

Medium and Large Only

Rnd 5A (CC): {sl1yo, BRP} to end of rnd.

Rnd 5A (MC): {[BRK, sl1yo] 0 (1) 2 times, BrkRsl, sl2yo} to end of rnd.

Rnd 5B (CC): {[sl1yo, BRP] 0 (1) 2 times, sl1yo, BRP2tog} to end of rnd.

Rnd 5B (MC): {BRK, sl1yo} to end of rnd. 20 (20) 30 sts remain.



Large Only

Rnd 6A (CC): {sl1yo, BRP} to end of rnd.

Rnd 6A (MC): {[BRK, sl1yo] 0 (0) 1 times, BrkRsl, sl2yo} to end of rnd. Rnd 6B (CC): {[sl1yo, BRP] 0 (0) 1 times, sl1yo, BRP2tog} to end of rnd.

Rnd 6B (MC): {BRK, sl1yo} to end of rnd. 20 (20) 20 sts remain.

All Sizes

Rnd 7A (CC): {sl1yo, BRP} to end of rnd. Rnd 7A (MC): {BrkRsl, sl2yo} to end of rnd. Rnd 7B (CC): {sl1yo, BRP2tog} to end of rnd.

Rnd 7B (MC): {BRK, sl1yo} to end of rnd. 10 (10) 10 sts remain.

Rnd 8A (CC): {sl1yo, BRP} to end of rnd.

Rnd 8A (MC): {BrkRsl, sl2yo} to last 2 sts, BRK, sl1yo. 6 (6) 6 sts remain.

FINISHING

Cut MC and CC leaving a 30cm/12" tail. Use a tapestry needle to pull both MC and CC tails through remaining sts. Weave in ends and block.
