Night Sky Pillow

#### MATERIALS

3 skeins of Amigo Chunky, color A20 (**MC**) 1 skein of Amigo Chunky, color A35 (**CC**)

Crochet hook 6.5 mm / US K/10.5 Stitch Marker Yarn Needle Scissors Pillow Form 16.5 x 16.5" / 42 cm x 42 cm

#### YARN QUALITY

Amigo Chunky, Hobbii
100% HB Acrylic
100 g / 3.5 oz = 100 m / 109 yds

#### GAUGE

11 blo sc x 10 rounds = 4" x 4" / 10 cm x 10 cm

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

ch = chain sc = single crochet blo = back loop only sl st = slip stitch MC = Main Color CC = Contrast Color

#### SIZE

One size

## MEASUREMENTS

16 x 16" / 41 cm x 41 cm

#### **PATTERN INFORMATION**

This pillow is worked in the round using the tapestry crochet technique (following a colorwork graph) where the non-working color is carried under the active yarn stitches. Some knowledge or experience with colorwork may be helpful when completing this project.

#### **INFO AND TIPS**

- This pillow is worked in a continuous round. Use a stitch marker to mark the first st of a round and keep moving it up with the first st of each new round worked.

- Changing color in a round: before working the last yarn over to complete the stitch before the new color, grab the new color to finish the current stitch.

- When the pillow is ready to stuff, the bottom will be seamed first, then the pillow form will be inserted and the top opening is seamed last.

#### PILLOW

With MC, leave a 36" / 92 cm tail for seaming, ch 78, join with a sl st to the first ch. Follow graph and graph instructions to complete the pillow.

#### **GRAPH INSTRUCTIONS**

- Each square of the graph represents 1 blo sc st.

- Start where the arrow indicates and place a stitch marker in the first st.


- Once the first 39 sts of the graph are worked in a round, continue the round with the MC working blo sc sts around. Once you have finished the round, start the next round by following the graph again.

- Remember to work in a continuous round marking the first st of each round with the stitch marker.

- After the last st of the last round, sl st into the next st to join, fasten off a 36" / 92 cm tail for seaming.

- Once you complete the graph, continue to the Finishing instructions.

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#### FINISHING

Weave in any ends except the tails for seaming.

With a yarn needle and the bottom tail, seam closed the bottom of the pillow, weave in end. Insert pillow form through the top opening, with a yarn needle and the top tail, seam closed the top of the pillow, weave in end.
