MATERIALS

Friends Cotton 8/4

1 skein of each col. 55, 08, 114, 58

Crochet hook 3 mm / US D Glass beads 30g color Pearl Creme 15012 Filling Tapestry needle

YARN QUALITY

Friends Cotton 8/4, Hobbii 100 % Cotton 50 g / 1.75 oz = 160 m / 174 yds

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain sc = single crochet slpst = slip stitch inc = increase dec = decrease blo = back loop only mr = magic ring

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 4 cm / 1.6" Length: 7 cm / 2.7"

CHOCOLATE STRAWBERRY

With col. 55. MR

Round 1: 6 sc

Round 2: (inc, sc) x3

Round 3: (inc, 2 sc) x3

Round 4: sc 12

Round 5: (inc, 3sc) x 3

Round 6: sc 15

Cut the thread and repeat one more time. Do not cut the thread the second time. You should have 2 cups that we will join together to make the top of the strawberry.

Round 7: With the loop from the second cup on the hook, join to the first cup and sc 12. Skip the last 3 stitches from the first cup and return to the second cup. On the second cup, skip 3 stitches and crochet 12 sc. Leave the remaining hole between the two cups open for stuffing at the end.



Round 8: sc 24

Round 9: change to chocolate color 08 and sc 24

Round 10: sc 24 blo Round 11: (sc 4, dec) x 4



Round 12: sc 20

Round 13: (sc 3, dec) x 4

Round 14: sc 16

Round 15: (sc 2, dec) x 4 Round 16: (sc, dec) x 4

Round 16: dec x 4

Cut the yarn and close the remaining space with your tapestry needle. Weave in the ends.

Stuff your strawberry through the opening we made above.

LEAVES

With color 114

MR

Round 1: (ch 5, slpst on the fourth chain, 3 sc , slpst inside magic ring) x 2 Tighten your mr and cut the yarn. Leave a long tail.

Using your tapestry needle sew the leaves and at the same time close the opening on top of the strawberry.



DETAILS

With your tapestry needle embroider cream stripes on your strawberry: Use color 58 Thread one end of the yarn through the eye of your needle, and tie a knot at the other end to create a secure starting point.





Before you begin, decide on the placement and pattern of the cream lines on your crochet strawberry. You can create a spiral pattern, vertical lines, or any other design you prefer. Insert the needle from the inside of the strawberry (where the stuffing is) to the outside, bringing it up to the starting point of your design. Start embroidering!:) When you've finished the design, secure the thread on the inside of the strawberry with a knot and trim any excess thread.

Embroider the seeds in random order on the red part of your strawberry using your glass beads, thread and needle.
