# MATERIALS

1 (1) 1 (1) 2 (2) 2 skeins of Portobello col. 31

Crochet hook 3.75mm / US E/5

# YARN QUALITY

**Hobbii Portobello,** Hobbii 60% Cotton, 28% Acrylic, 12% Wool 50g (1.75oz), 120m (131y),

# GAUGE

18 sts x 9 rows in dc = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

### **ABBREVIATIONS**

**st(s)** – stitch(es) yo – yarn over **ch** – chain stitch sc - single crochet dc – double crochet **hdc** – half double crochet sp - space **sl st** – slip stitch WS – wrong side **RS** – right side **BPdc** - back post double crochet **FPdc** - front post double crochet **CL** – cluster **CL shell** - cluster shell **bo** – bobble **dc2tog** – two dc together

### SIZE

Premature (0-3m) 3-6m (6-9m) 9-12m (1-2y) 2-4y

# **MEASUREMENTS**

**Head Circumference**: 34 (41) 44 (45) 47 (48) 50 cm / 13.4" (16.1") 17.3" (17.7") 18.5" (18.9") 19.7"

**Bonnet Depth (front to back)**: 11 (13) 13 (15) 15 (17) 19 cm /4.3" (5.1") 5.1" (5.9") 5.9" (6.7") 7.5"

**Bonnet Height (top to button):** 14 (16) 17 (18) 19 (21) 22 cm / 5.5" (6.3") 6.7" (7.1") 7.5" (8.3") 8.7"

TIPS AND INFO Special stitches

### Back post double crochet (BPdc)

yo, insert hook from back to front around next stitch, yo, pull through (photo 1); 3 loops on hook (photo 2), finish back post double crochet as normal dc (photo 3)

### Front post double crochet (FPdc)

yo, insert hook from front to back around next stitch, yo, pull through (photo 1); 3 loops on hook (photo 2); finish front post double crochet as normal dc (photo 3)

### Cluster (CL)

\*yo, insert hook in specified st and draw up a loop, yo and draw through 2 loops\*\*, two loops on hook (photo1), repeat from \* to \*\* once more working in same stitch (photo 2), yo and draw through all three loops; CL made (photo 3)

**CL shell** (CL, ch2, dc, ch2, CL) in specified stitch



#### Bobble (bo)

\*yo, insert hook in specified st and pull up a loop, yarn over and pull through 2 loops\*; two loops on hook (photo1), repeat from \* three more times working in same stitch, (photo 2) yarn over and pull through all five loops (photo 3)

### Two dc together (dc2tog)

Begin to work dc in next st, but don't complete it, leaving 2 loops on hook (photo1), work another incomplete dc in next st, so that you have 3 loops on hook (photo 2); yo and pull through all 3 loops on hook (photo 3)

# BONNET

Ch1 at the beginning of each row doesn't count as a stitch

### Back of the head and the main body

**Row 1 (RS):** ch7 (9) 10 (11) 13 (15) 16, dc in 4th ch from hook (ch3 counts as first dc), dc in each ch to last ch, 7dc in last ch, rotate the work and work on opposite side into remaining loop of foundation chain, dc in each of next 4 (6) 7 (8) 10 (12) 13 sts, turn; 15 (19) 21 (23) 27 (31) 33 sts (photo 1)

**Row 2 (WS):** ch1, but pull it to the height of dc (here and throughout where next st is dc), dc in first st and in each of next 3 (5) 6 (7) 9 (11) 12 sts, 2dc in each of next 7sts, dc in each of next 4 (6) 7 (8) 10 (12) 13 sts, turn; 22 (26) 28 (30) 34 (38) 40 sts (photo 2)

**Row 3 (RS):** ch1, dc in first st and in each of next 3 (5) 6 (7) 9 (11) 12 sts, 2dc in each of next 14sts, dc in each of next 4 (6) 7 (8) 10 (12) 13 sts, turn; 36 (40) 42 (44) 48 (52) 54 sts (photo 3)

**Row 4 (WS):** ch1, dc in first st and in each of next 4 (4) 3 (4) 6 (8) 9 sts, \*2dc in next st, dc in next st\*\*, repeat from \* to \*\* 12 (14) 16 (16) 16 (16) 16 more times, dc in each of next 5 (5) 4 ( 5) 7 (9) 10 sts, turn; 49 (55) 59 (61) 65 (69) 71 sts (photo 4)

**Row 5 (RS):** ch1, dc in first st, dc in each of next 1 (4) 1 (2) 4 (1) 2 sts, \*skip next 2sts, CL shell in next st, skip next 2sts, dc in each of next 5sts\*\*, repeat from \* to \*\* to end, ending the last repeat with dc in each of next 2 (5) 2 (3) 5 (2) 3 sts, turn; 59 (65) 71 (73) 77 (83) 85 sts including all chs (photo 5)

**Row 6 (WS):** ch1, sc in first st, sc in next 1 (4) 1 (2) 4 (1) 2 sts, \*ch3, skip next CL and skip next ch2, sc in next dc, ch3, skip next ch2, skip next CL, sc in each of next 2sts, bo in next st, sc in each of next 2sts\*\*, repeat from \* to \*\* to end, ending the last repeat with sc in each of next 2 (5) 2 (3) 5 (2) 3 sts, turn; 59 (65) 71 (73) 77 (83) 85 sts including all chs (photo 6)

**Row 7 (RS):** ch1, dc in first st, dc in each of next 1 (4) 1 (2) 4 (1) 2 sts, \*skip next ch3, CL shell in next sc, skip next ch3, dc in each of next 5sts\*\*, repeat from \* to \*\* to end, ending the last repeat with dc in each of next 2 (5) 2 (3) 5 (2) 3 sts, turn; 59 (65) 71 (73) 77 (83) 85 sts including all chs (photo 7)

**Repeat Rows 6 and 7** – 2 (3) 3 (4) 4 (5) 6 more times or until desired depth



### **Repeat Row 6** once more and work Last Row (photo 8)

**Last Row (RS):** ch1, dc in first st, dc in each of next 1 (4) 1 (2) 4 (1) 2sts, \*skip next ch3, CL shell in next sc, skip next ch3, dc2tog, dc in next st, dc2tog\*\*, repeat from \* to \*\* to end, ending the last repeat with dc in each of 2 (5) 2 (3) 5 (2) 3 sts, turn; 51 (57) 61 (63) 67 (83) 53 sts including all chs, fasten off (photo 9)

### Strap

**Row 1:** ch50 (50) 50 (54) 54 (60) 62, join yarn in the first st at the base of the bonnet (photo 10) and work evenly sc across the bonnet's base, stitch amount is not important but it has to be an even number, don't work stitches too close to each other as it has to gather a bit the base of the bonnet, ch52 (52) 52 (56) 56 (62) 64, dc in 4th ch from hook (ch3 counts as first dc) dc in each next ch, dc in each next sc, dc in each next ch to the end of second strap, turn (photo 11)

**Row 2:** ch1, hdc in first st, \*FPdc around next st, BPdc around next st\*\*, repeat from \* to \*\* to last st, hdc in last st, fasten off

Weave in all ends
