## Beret

Design: It Was Yarn - Kate Kosenko (Veselunka)| Hobbii Design

## MATERIALS

1 skein of Friends Cotton 8/4 in col.:
38, 47, 48, 51, 62, 63

Crochet hook 3 mm / US D-3
Scissors
Darning needle
Measuring tape

## YARN QUALITY

(10) Friends cotton 8/4, Hobbii

100 \% Cotton
$50 \mathrm{~g} / 1.75 \mathrm{oz}=160 \mathrm{~m} / 174 \mathrm{yds}$

## GAUGE

$25 \mathrm{dc} \times 12$ rows $=10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm} / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$ Diameter of 1 flower $\approx 2.8$ inches ( $\approx 7 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

## SIZE

M, L

## MEASUREMENTS

Size M: head circumference: 21.3-22 in (54-56 cm ).
Size L: head circumference: 22.4-23.2 in (57-59 cm).

## PATTERN INFORMATION

This floral beret is a great project for those who appreciate color therapy. However, if you want to make this beret in solid color yarn, you only need 4 skeins of yarn instead of 6 .
The floral part of the beret is the same for both sizes. The size is adjustable thanks to the brim: you can choose the option that is more convenient for you.

Stitches used: slip stitch, chain, single crochet, reverse single crochet, double crochet, front post double crochet, back post double crochet.

## INFO AND TIPS

The Flower is the main motif of this pattern. We will be making 36 Flowers ( 18 in each color combination).

Each Flower consists of 3 colors in two different color combinations.
Combination 1: col. 51 (color A), 63 (color B) and 47 (color C)
Combination 2: col. 38 (color D), 48 (color E) and 62 (color F)

We will join flowers into four lines and add a brim:
Line 1: (along the face): For odd flowers use combination 1. For even flowers use combination 2
Line 2: For odd flowers use combination 1. For even flowers use combination 2
Line 3: Make 4 flowers using combination 1, and then 4 flowers using combination 2.
Line 4 (top of the beret): For odd flowers use combination 1. For even flowers use combination 2.

Flowers in combination 1 and 2: First make all the details with Color A / Color D Then you can go two ways:

1) Complete the Flowers with Color B/Color E, joining them to each other to form the beret. Then do all Flowers with Color C / Color F and finish with Brim.
2) Make one Flower completely with Color B / Color E and Color A / Color D. Join each next Flower one after another, making rounds with Color B / Color E and Color A / Color D. Finish with Brim.

Here are completed pictures of the Flower in Combination 1 :


## Beginning of flowers

Make 18 in color A and 18 in color D
Make a magic ring.
Rnd 1: Ch2 (does not count as a st), 16 dc into the ring, join with a sl st to $1^{\text {st }}$ dc. (Total: 16 dc).

Rnd 2 (work in FLO): Ch1 (does not count as a st), rsc in next 16 dc , drop the loop from your hook, insert hook in last dc of Rnd 1 from back to front, grab the dropped loop with your hook and pull through. (Total: 16 rsc).
Rnd 3 (work in BLO): Ch1 (does not count as a st), (sc in next dc of Rnd 1, ch2, sk dc)×8, drop the loop from your hook, insert hook in $1^{\text {st }}$ sc from back to front, grab the dropped loop with your hook and pull through. (Total: $8 \mathrm{sc}, 8 \mathrm{ch} 2$-sps).
Rnd 4 (work in BLO): Ch1 (does not count as a st), (sc in next skipped dc of Rnd 1, ch3)x8, join with a sl st to $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc}$. (Total: $8 \mathrm{sc}, 8 \mathrm{ch} 3$-sps).
Rnd 5: Sl st in next ch3-sp, ch1 (does not count as a st), 3 sc in same ch3-sp, ch3, (3 sc in next ch3-sp, ch3)x7, join with a sl st to $1^{\text {st }}$ sc. (Total: $24 \mathrm{sc}, 8$ ch3-sps).
Cut the yarn and secure ends.
Make 18 centres of Flowers in color \#51 and 18 centres in color \#38.

## LINE 1. FLOWERS 1-12

## Flower 1

With color B / color E

Rnd 6: Slip knot, (sc in the middle sc of 3 sc-group, 5 dc in next ch3-sp)x8, join with a sl st to $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc}$. (Total: $40 \mathrm{dc}, 8 \mathrm{sc}$ ).
Rnd 7: (Ch5, sl st in next sc)x7, ch5, sl st in $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc}$. (Total: 8 sl st, 8 ch5-sps).
Cut the yarn and secure ends.
Repeat Rnd 6 for all the next Flowers and join them as you go in Rnd 7.

Note: The Lines of Flowers join as you go in a counter clockwise direction. Keep Flower you are working on to the left of the previous one you are joining to. Please read the diagram before connecting the Flowers - now and throughout the pattern. Especially when joining the last flower in the Line.

Rnd 7 of Flower 2: [Remember the sequence of using color combinations for even and odd rounds] Ch2, dc in ch5-sp of Flower 1, ch2, sl st in next sc of Flower 2, ch2, sc in next ch5-sp of Flower 1, ch2, sl st in next sc of Flower 2, ch2, tr in ch5-sp of Flower 1, ch2, sl st in next sc of Flower 2, (ch5, sl st in next sc)x5. Cut the yarn and secure ends.
Rnd 7 of Flowers 3-11: Ch2, dc in ch5-sp of previous Flower (2-10) skipping 1 ch5-sp from previous join, ch2, sl st in next sc of Flower 3-11, ch2, sc in next ch5-sp of Flower 2-10, ch2, sl st in next sc of Flower 3-11, ch2, tr in ch5-sp of Flower 2-10, ch2, sl st in next sc of Flower $3-11$, (ch5, sl st in next sc)×5. Cut the yarn and secure ends.
Rnd 7 of Flower 12: Ch2, dc in ch5-sp of Flower 11 skipping 1 ch5-sp from previous join, ch2, sl st in next sc of Flower 12, ch2, sc in next ch5-sp of Flower 11, ch2, sl st in next sc of Flower 12, ch2, tr in ch5-sp of Flower 11, ch2, sl st in next sc of Flower 12, ch5, sl st in next sc, ch2, tr in ch5-sp of Flower 1 skipping 1 ch5-sp from previous join, ch2, sl st in next sc of

Flower 12, ch2, sc in next ch5-sp of Flower 1, ch2, sl st in next sc of Flower 12, ch2, dc in ch5-sp of Flower 1, ch2, sl st in next sc of Flower 12, ch5, sl st in next sc. Cut the yarn and secure ends.

Note: You will notice that this Line of 12 Flowers is too big for your head circumference. But don't worry: the brim will reduce it to the right size.

## LINE 2. FLOWERS 13-24

With color B/color E
Note: The first join occurs to Flower 1 of Line 1 to the right of Flower 13 and continues to Flower 12 of Line 1 to the left of Flower 13. The next Flower 14 continues the joining counter clockwise: first to Flower 2 of Line 1, then to Flower 1 of Line 1, finally to Flower 13 (previous Flower) of Line 2.

Rnd 7 of Flower 13: Ch5 [keep the petal in front of work], sl st in next sc, ch2, dc in ch5-sp of Flower 1, ch2, sl st in next sc, ch2, dc around the post of joining tr, ch2, sl st in next sc, ch2, dc in ch5-sp of Flower 12, ch2, sl st in next sc, *ch5, sl st in next sc* 4 times. Cut the yarn and secure ends.

Rnd 7 of Flowers 14-23: Ch5 [keep the petal in front of work], sl st in next sc, ch2, dc in ch5-sp of Line 1 Flower on right side, ch2, sl st in next sc, ch2, dc around the post of joining tr, ch2, sl st in next sc, ch2, dc in used ch5-sp of Flower of Line 1 on left, ch2, sl st in next sc, ch2, sc in next ch5-sp of previous Flower of Line 2, ch2, sl st in next sc, ch2, dc in next ch5-sp of previous Flower of Line $2, \mathrm{ch} 2$, $s l$ st in next $\mathrm{sc},{ }^{*} \mathrm{ch} 5, \mathrm{sl}$ st in next sc* 2 times. Cut the yarn and secure ends.

Rnd 7 of Flower 24: Ch2, sc in ch5-sp of Flower 13, ch2, sl st in next sc, ch2, dc in used ch5-sp of Flower of Line 1 on right [Flower 12], ch2, sl st in next sc, ch2, dc around the post of joining tr [of Flower 11 \& 12], ch2, sl st in next sc, ch2, dc in used ch5-sp of Flower of Line 1 on left [Flower 11], ch2, sl st in next sc, ch2, sc in next ch5-sp of Flower 23, ch2, sl st in next sc, ch2, dc in next ch5-sp of previous Flower of Line 2 [Flower 23], ch2, sl st in next sc, ch5, sl st in next sc, ch2, dc in next ch5-sp of Flower 13, ch2, sl st in next sc. Cut the yarn and secure ends.

LINE 3. FLOWERS 25-32
This line includes only 8 Flowers.
With color B / color E
Rnd 7 of Flowers 25-28. On this step, you will have 4 flowers joined to two Flowers of the previous line but not joined to each other: Ch5 [keep the petal in front of work], sl st in next sc, ch2, dc in ch5-sp of right Flower of Line 2, ch2, sl st in next sc, ch2, dc around the post of joining dc, ch2, sl st in next sc, ch2, dc in ch5-sp of left Flower of Line 2, ch2, sl st in next sc, *ch5, sl st in next sc* 4 times. Cut the yarn and secure ends.

## Diagram:



Rnd 7 of Flowers 29-32: Ch5 [keep the petal in front of work], sl st in next sc, ch2, dc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ (from last joining dc) unused ch5-sp of Flower on right of Line 3, ch2, sl st in next sc, ch2, sc in next ch5-sp of same Flower on right, ch2, sl st in next sc, ch2, dc around the post of joined dc, ch2, sl st in next sc, ch2, sc in next ch5-sp of Flower of Line 2, ch2, sl st in next sc, ch2, dc around the post of joined dc, ch2, sl st in next sc, ch2, sc in next ch5-sp of Flower on left of Line 3, ch2, sl st in next sc, ch2, dc in next ch5-sp of same Flower on left, ch2, sl st in
next sc. Cut the yarn and secure ends.

## LINE 4 (TOP). FLOWERS 33-36

Top includes 4 Flowers that close the beret.
With color B / color E

Rnd 7 of Flower 33: Ch5 [keep the petal in front of work], sl st in next sc, ch2, sc in ch5-sp of Flower $25, \mathrm{ch} 2, \mathrm{sl}$ st in next sc, ch2, dc around the post of joining dc, ch2, sl st in next sc, ch2, sc in ch5-sp of Flower 29, ch2, sl st in next sc, ch2, dc around the post of joining dc, ch2, sl st in next sc, *ch5, sl st in next sc* 3 times. Cut the yarn and secure ends.

## Diagram:



Rnd 7 of Flowers 34-35: Ch5 [keep the petal in front of work], sl st in next sc, ch2, sc in ch5-sp of Flower 26 [27], ch2, sl st in next sc, ch2, dc around the post of joining dc, ch2, sl st in next sc, ch2, sc in ch5-sp of Flower 30 [31], ch2, sl st in next sc, ch2, dc around the post of joining dc, ch2, sl st in next sc, *ch2, sc in ch5-sp of Flower 33 [36], ch2, sl st in next sc* 2 times, ch5, sl st in next sc. Cut the yarn and secure ends.

Rnd 7 of Flower 36: *Ch2 [keep the petal in front of work], sc in ch5-sp of Flower 33, ch2, sl st in next sc* 2 times, ch2, sc in ch5-sp of Flower 28, ch2, sl st in next sc, ch2, dc around the post of joining $\mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2$, sl st in next sc, ch2, sc in ch5-sp of Flower 32, ch2, sl st in next sc, ch2, dc around the post of joining dc, ch2, sl st in next sc, *ch2, sc in ch5-sp of Flower 35, ch2, sl st in next sc* 2 times. Cut the yarn and secure ends.

Diagram:


With color C / Color F we complete each Flower, giving it volume.
Rnd 8: Slip knot, (sc in next sc of Rnd 3, 3 dc in next ch2-sp)x8, join with a sl st to $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc}$.
(Total: $24 \mathrm{dc}, 8 \mathrm{sc}$ ).
Cut the yarn and secure ends.
Rnd 9: Slip knot, (fpdc around next sc of Rnd 6, continue working in BLO, sc in next 5 dc ) x8, join with a sl st to $1^{\text {st }}$ fpdc. (Total: $8 \mathrm{fpdc}, 40 \mathrm{sc}$ ).
Cut the yarn and secure ends.

## BRIM

Keep the work right side facing you. Rounds 1 and 4 work for both sizes. Rounds 2, 3, 5, 6 follow instructions for each size separately.

Rnd 1 (color B): Slip knot, *(sc, ch3, sc) in next ch5-sp, ch3, dc around post of joining dc between flowers, ch3* 12 times, join with a sl st to $1^{\text {st }}$ sc. Do not cut the yarn. (Total: 36 ch3-sps, $24 \mathrm{sc}, 12 \mathrm{dc}$ ).

## Size M

Rnd 2: Sl st in next ch3-sp, ch1 (does not count as a st), sc in same st as ch1, ( 5 dc in next ch3-sp, sc in next ch3-sp)x18, omitting last sc , join with a sl st to $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc}$. Cut the yarn. (Total: $90 \mathrm{dc}, 18 \mathrm{sc}$ ).
Rnd 3 (color C): Slip knot, (fpdc around next sc, continue working in BLO, sc in next 5 dc$) \times 18$, join with a sl st to $1^{\text {st }}$ fpdc. Cut the yarn. (Total: $18 \mathrm{fpdc}, 90 \mathrm{sc}$ ).

## Size L

Rnd 2: SI st in next ch3-sp, ch1 (does not count as a st), sc in same st as ch1, (ch1, 5 dc in next ch3-sp, ch1, sc in next ch3-sp) $\times 18$, omitting last sc, join with a sl st to $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc}$. Cut the yarn. (Total: $90 \mathrm{dc}, 36$ ch1-sps, 18 sc ).
Rnd 3 (color C): Slip knot, (fpdc around next sc, ch1, continue working in BLO, sc in next $5 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1$ ) x 18 , join with a sl st to $1^{\text {st }}$ fpdc. Cut the yarn. (Total: $18 \mathrm{fpdc}, 36$ ch1-sps, 90 sc ).

Rnd 4 (color E): Slip knot, working around sts of Rnd 1 , bpdc around post of last dc, *(ch3, bpdc around post of next sc)×2, ch3, bpdc around post of next dc* 12 times, omitting last bpdc, join with a sl st to $1^{\text {st }}$ bpdc. Do not cut the yarn. (Total: $36 \mathrm{bpdc}, 36 \mathrm{ch} 3-\mathrm{sps}$ ).
Rnd 5: Repeat Rnd 2, working in sts of Rnd 4. Cut the yarn.
Rnd 6 (color F): Repeat Rnd 3, working in sts of Rnd 5. Cut the yarn.
Secure ends.
Wash the beret in cool water. No spin. Dry flat.
