# Marmor 

Shawl

## MATERIALS

2 skeins of Diablo color (03) A
2 skeins of Diablo Glitter color (09) B

Circular needles $3 \mathrm{~mm}, 80 \mathrm{~cm}$
Wool needle

## YARN QUALITY

(a03) Diablo, Hobbii
40\% acrylic, 30\% mohair, 30\% polyamide $25 \mathrm{~g}=225 \mathrm{~m}$
(60) Kid Silk, Hobbii

37\% acrylic, 31\% polyamide, 28\% mohair, 4\% polyester
$25 \mathrm{~g}=205 \mathrm{~m}$

## GAUGE

$10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}\left(4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}\right)=23$ stitches $\times 48$ rows in garter stitch

## SIZE

One size

## MEASUREMENTS

Length: measured along the increases in the middle: approx. 73 cm/ 28.7 inches
Width: approx. $155 \mathrm{~cm} / 61$ inches

## PATTERN INFORMATION

The Marmor Shawl is worked flat in garter stitch using circular needles. You will start with a few stitches in the center of the longest side (the neck) and end with many stitches for the two diagonal sides.
You will increase in the beginning and middle of each row. Color changes are made in the center of the shawl.

## TIPS AND INFO

Increasing/yarn over: yarn over, on the next row, knit yarn-over through the back.
f\&b: knit the same stitch first through the front loop and then through the back loop.
Changing color: When winding the strand around one another, make sure to do it in the same direction.

1 pattern repeat is worked across $2 \times 20$ rows and $2 \times 10$ rows $=60$ rows.

## FIRST PART

Using color $\mathbf{A}$, cast on 2 stitches and using color $\mathbf{B}$, cast on 2 stitches $=4$ stitches.

1. row: color $\mathbf{B}$, knit 1, yarn over, Knit next stitch $f \& b$, wind the strands around each other, color $\mathbf{A}$, knit $2=6$ stitches. ( 4 stitches color $\mathbf{B}$ and 2 stitches color $\mathbf{A}$ ).
2. row: color $\mathbf{A}$, knit 1, yarn over, Knit next stitch f\&b, wind the strands around each other, color $\mathbf{B}$, knit until end of row (knit yarn-over through the back loop) $=8$ stitches.
( 4 stitches color $\mathbf{A}$ and 4 stitches color $\mathbf{B}$ ).
3. row: color $\mathbf{B}$, , yarn over, knit 2, yarn over, knit 1, wind the strands around each other, color $\mathbf{A}$, knit until end of row (knit yarn-over through the back loop) $=10$ stitches. ( 6 stitches color $\mathbf{B}$ and 4 stitches color $\mathbf{A}$ ).
4. row: color $\mathbf{A}$, slip 1 stitch, yarn over, knit 2, yarn over, knit 1, wind the strands around each other, color $\mathbf{B}$, knit $=12$ stitches. ( 6 stitches color $\mathbf{A}$ and 6 stitches color $\mathbf{B}$ ).
5. row: color B, slip 1 stitch, yarn over, 4 ret, yarn over, knit 1, wind the strands around each other, color $\mathbf{A}$, knit $=14$ stitches. ( 8 stitches color $\mathbf{B}$ and 6 stitches color $\mathbf{A}$ ).
6. row: color $\mathbf{A}$, slip 1 stitch, yarn over, knit until 1 stitch remains in color $\mathbf{A}$, yarn over, knit 1, wind the strands around each other, color $\mathbf{B}$, knit $=16$ stitches.
( 8 stitches color $\mathbf{A}$ and 8 stitches color $\mathbf{B}$ ).
7. row: color B, slip 1 stitch, yarn over, knit until 1 stitch remains in color B, yarn over, knit 1, wind the strands around each other, color $\mathbf{A}$, knit $=18$ stitches.
(10 stitches color $\mathbf{B}$ and 8 stitches color $\mathbf{A}$ ).
8. row: color $\mathbf{A}$, slip 1 stitch, yarn over, knit until 1 stitch remains in color $\mathbf{A}$, yarn over, knit 1, wind the strands around each other, color $\mathbf{B}$, knit $=20$ stitches.
( 10 stitches color $\mathbf{A}$ and 10 stitches color $\mathbf{B}$ ).

NOTE: remember to check your stitch count in each color.
Continue like this, increasing 2 stitches on each row before the center, until you have worked 20 rows and have 22 stitches color $\mathbf{A}$ and 22 stitches color $\mathbf{B}$.

## SECOND PART

You will now switch the colors and wind the strands around each other like before.

1. row: color $\mathbf{B}$, slip 1 stitch, yarn over, knit until 1 stitch remains in color $\mathbf{B}$, yarn over, knit 1, knit until end of row using color $\mathbf{B}=46$ stitches.
( 46 stitches color $\mathbf{B}$ and 0 stitches color $\mathbf{A}$ ).
2. row: color B, slip 1 stitch, yarn over, knit until 1 stitch remains in color B, yarn over, knit 1, wind the strands around each other, color $\mathbf{A}$, knit $=48$ stitches.
( 24 stitches color $\mathbf{B}$ and 24 stitches color $\mathbf{A}$ ).
3. row: color A, slip 1 stitch, yarn over, knit until 1 stitch remains in color $\mathbf{A}$, yarn over, knit 1, wind the strands around each other, color $\mathbf{B}$, knit $=50$ stitches.
( 26 stitches color $\mathbf{A}$ and 24 stitches color $\mathbf{B}$ ).

Continue until you have worked 20 rows and have 42 stitches color $\mathbf{A}$ and 42 stitches color B.

## THIRD PART

You will now switch the colors and wind the strands around each other like before. 1. row: color $\mathbf{A}$, slip 1 stitch, yarn over, knit until 1 stitch remains in color $\mathbf{A}$, increase one stitch, knit until end of row using color $\mathbf{A}$.
( 86 stitches color $\mathbf{A}$ and 0 stitches color $\mathbf{B}$ ).
2. row: color $\mathbf{A}$, slip 1 stitch, yarn over, knit until 1 stitch remains in color $\mathbf{A}$, yarn over, knit 1, wind the strands around each other, knit until end of row using color $\mathbf{B}$.
(44 stitches color A and 44 stitches color B).

Continue until you have worked 10 rows and have 52 stitches color $\mathbf{A}$ and 52 stitches color B.

## FOURTH DEL

You will now switch the colors and wind the strands around each other like before.

1. row: color B, slip 1 stitch, yarn over, knit until 1 stitch remains in color $\mathbf{B}$, yarn over, knit until end of row using color $\mathbf{B}$.
(106 stitches color B and 0 stitches color $\mathbf{A}$ ).
2. row: color B, slip 1 stitch, yarn over, knit until 1 stitch remains in color B, yarn over, knit 1, wind the strands around each other, knit until end of row using color $\mathbf{A}$.
(54 stitches color A and 54 stitches color B).

Continue until you have worked 10 rows and have 62 stitches color $\mathbf{A}$ and 62 stitches color B.

These four parts make one pattern repeat and will be worked until you are almost out of yarn. Remember to stop while you still have enough yarn for binding off.
Bind off.
