



KNITTING PATTERN

Jules

Stole


Design: Pia Stær | Hobbii Design

MATERIALS

4 skeins Friends Kid Silk color 54

Straight needles 4.5 mm
Straight needles 9 mm
Wool needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Kid Silk**, Hobbii
72% Mohair, 25% Silk, 3% Wool
25 g (0.9 oz) = 200 m (218 yds)

GAUGE

20 sts in pattern alternating between 4.5
and 9 mm needles = 10 cm / 4 inches

ABBREVIATIONS

K: Knit
P: Purl
s1k: slip 1 knit-wise
k1tbl: knit 1 through back loop
Rep: repeat
K2tog: Knit 2 stitches together
P2tog: Purl 2 stitches together

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

30 x 142 cm / 11.8 x 56 inches

PATTERN INFORMATION

Jules stole is worked in two strands of Friends Kid Silk and is a light, soft, and lovely project.

The fine structure is made with a rib pattern of purl and knit back loop stitches. Besides that, two different needle sizes are used. Jules stole can be used as a shawl around the shoulders or as an ordinary scarf.

Pattern



STOLE

Cast on 60 sts on 4.5 mm needle with two strands of Friends Kid Silk

Frilled rib edge

Row 1: *k2, p2* repeat *-* until end of row

Row 2: s1k, k1tbl, p2, *k1tbl x 2, p 2* repeat *-* until end of row

Work Row 2 6 times in total

Body

Row 8: *k2tog through back loop, p2tog* repeat *-* until end of row
= 30 sts on the needle

Row 9: slip 1 st knitwise, p1, * k1tbl, purl 1* repeat *-* until end of row
Repeat Row 9 until work measures 15 cm.

Cross tie

Turn work. Distribute the 30 stitches on 2 needles in the following way:

Place the 1st stitch on needle 1, 2nd stitch on needle 2, 3rd stitch on needle 1, 4th stitch on needle 2 and so on, distributing the stitches alternating between needle 1 and needle 2.

Work the stitches on needle 1 in the following way:

Work 2 stitches in each stitch (k1 in both the front and back loop of the same stitch) until end of row.

= 30 sts on the needle

Then work Row 9 until work measures 22 cm.

On next row work *K2tog through the back loop* repeat *-* until end of row.
= 15 sts on the needle

Let the stitches on needle 1 rest and work the stitches on needle 2 in the same way as needle 1.

Gather the stitches on the same needle again - alternating 1 stitch from needle 1 and needle 2, so the stitches are placed in the same order they were cast on.

Repeat Row 9 once more.

Body continued

From the right side of the work:

Work 2 stitches in each stitch (k1 in both the front and back loop of the same stitch)
= 60 sts on the needle

Then work Row 9 until work measures 22 cm.

Continue working Row 9, but on the wrong side of the work use a 9 mm needle, and on the right side of the work a 4.5 mm needle.

Work with alternately 9 mm and 4.5 mm needles until the work measures 122 cm / 48 inches.

End on a wrong side row.

Continue with 4.5 mm needles.

On next row work *k2tog, p2tog* repeat *-* until the end of the row.
= 30 sts on the needle

Repeat Row 9 for an additional 19 cm

Work 2 stitches in each stitch (k1 in both the front and back loop of the same stitch)
= 60 sts on the needle

Fripped rib edge

Work 6 rows as follows:

s1k, k1tbl, p2,*k1tbl x 2, p 2* repeat *-* until end of row

Bind off in pattern.

Weave in ends.
