MATERIALS

Col. A: 1 ball of Rainbow Lace color 66
Col. B: 1 ball of Rainbow Lace color 75

Crochet hook 1.75 mm / US No. 0

Yarn needle

Scissors

2 earring fish hook findings

Stiffening spray

Plastic wrap

Blocking mat

Blocking pins

Needle nose pliers

YARN QUALITY

 **Rainbow Lace**, Hobbii

100 % Mercerised Cotton

2.5 g / 0.09 oz = 12 m / 13 yds

GAUGE

Gauge is not essential, however, tighter stitches will result in an earring that keeps its shape better.

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 5 cm / 2"

Length: 5 cm / 2"

PATTERN INFORMATION

The June Bloom Earrings are a fun splash of color. The earrings are a fun and quick project with lots of opportunities for color pairings - you'll be sure to have a pair for every outfit in no time!

Pattern is crocheted in continuous-joined rounds.

Pattern is crocheted using a small steel hook. Pattern uses puff stitches, double crochet clusters, and others.

Pattern contains special stitch directions, 'end of round' photos, and a complete pattern stitch diagram.

ABBREVIATIONS

- ch(s) = chain(s)
- dc = double crochet
- dccl = double crochet cluster
- mr = magic ring
- puff = puff stitch
- sc = single crochet
- sk = skip
- sl st = slip stitch
- sp = space
- st(s) = stitch(es)
- yo = yarn over

INFO AND TIPS

- Stitches within brackets are worked the total number of times specified.
- Stitches within parentheses are worked into the same stitch/space.
- Blocking your earrings upon completion is highly recommended. Blocked earrings will hold their proper shape for a longer period of time.
- Stitch counts are listed at the end of each round's direction.
- If using more than one color, sl st to close the current round with the new color, then continue.

Each round can be made with different colors.

SPECIAL STITCHES

- Puff stitch | puff
[Yo, insert hook in mr, yo, pull up a loop] twice, yo pull through all 5 loops on hook.
- Double crochet cluster | dccl
[Yo, insert hook in designated sp, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull through 2 loops on hook] twice, yo, pull through all 3 loops on hook.

EARRINGS: MAKE 2

Tip: Each round can be made with either the same or different colors.

Round 1 (Col. A) : Mr, ch 1, [puff, ch 1, puff] 7 times, sl st to first puff. *14 puff, 7 ch-1*

Adjust the mr by pulling your beginning tail tightly to close the center of the earring.

Cinching the mr is sometimes easier to do before completing the sl st that closes the round.

Round 2 (Col. B): *First ch-2 and first dc count together as the first dccl.* Sl st in next ch sp, (ch 2, dc, ch 3, dccl) in ch-sp, [sk 2, (dccl, ch 3, dccl) in ch-sp] 6 times, sl st to first dccl. *14 dccl, 7 ch-3 sps*


Round 3 (Col. B): Beginning ch-3 counts as the first dc. Sl st in next ch-3 sp, (ch 3, dc 3, ch 2, dc 4) in ch-3 sp, [sk 1, sc in sp between the two dccl sts from round two, sk 1, (dc 4, ch 2, dc 4) in ch-3 sp] 6 times, sk 1, sc in sp between the two dccl sts from round two, sk 1, sl st to top of beginning ch-3. *56 dc, 7 ch-2 sps, 7 sc*

Fasten off. Weave in all ends and proceed to blocking.

What your June Bloom Earrings should look like at the end of each round (Shown with 3 colors).



STITCH DIAGRAM



Magic ring



Chain



Puff stitch



Slip stitch



Double crochet



Double crochet cluster



Single crochet

BLOCKING

Place plastic wrap over your blocking surface and set your earrings on top. Mist both sides of your June Bloom Earrings with fabric stiffening spray and give them a little squish to absorb the liquid. Stretch the earrings to shape and pin each ch-2 space of the final round to your blocking mat. Allow your earrings to dry completely before removing the pins.

FINISHING

Using your needle nose pliers, open your earring finding to the side and slip the finding around one of the ch-2 sps from the final round of your earring. Close the circle on your earring finding. Repeat on the second earring.
