Pocket Shawl

MATERIALS

Rainbow Bamboo

3 skeins of color Ballerina (18) **A** 3 skeins of color Ginger (21) **B**

Crochet hook 4 mm (G-6)
Darning needle
8 (10) Buttons 12 mm
Needle and sewing thread

YARN QUALITY

Rainbow Bamboo, Hobbii 60% bamboo viscose, 40% cotton 100 g (3.5 oz) = 250 m (273 yds)

GAUGE (after blocking)

2 repeats pattern = 16 (6.2") cm (wide) x 6 cm (2.3") (height)

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain slst = slip stitch sc = single crochet hdc = half double crochet dc = double crochet tc = treble crochet ch-sp = chain space

SIZE

S/M/L (XL/XXL/XXXL)

MEASUREMENTS

Measures taken after blocking Back width: 39 (45) cm / 15.4" (17.7") Total Length: 157 (162) cm / 61.8" (163.7")

PATTERN INFORMATION

A pocket shawl with a little secret! An easy and quick to work pattern for a stylish shawl with a delicate thread. Perfect to wear as a shawl with a dress for a distinguished event or as a jacket with pants or shorts for a casual look. Yes! it's a shawl with pockets, that you can turn into a jacket to have your hands free thanks to a few buttons! There is nothing more useful!

The pattern is beginner-friendly.

INFO AND TIPS

Ch1 at the beginning of each row doesn't count as a st. The first st is work in the same st as ch1. Ch4 at the beginning of each row counts as 1 tc. When you crochet the next row, the last st is work into the 4th.

I recommend weaving in your ends as you go. You just have to work over your ends to hide them.

How to change color: change to the next color when crocheting the last st of the row of the previous color. Work the very last "yo, pull through all loops on hook" with the color of the following row.

SHAWL

Start with color A and ch114

Row 1: work 1 sc in the second chain from the hook, and in each ch to the end of the row. Turn. (113)

Row 2: ch 1, work 1 sc in each st to the end of the row. Turn.

Rows 3 & 4: Ch1, 1 sc, *sc in next st, ch 1, skip 1 st, 1 hdc in next st, ch 1, skip 1, 1 dc in next st, (ch 1, skip 1, 1 tc in next st) x2, ch 1, skip 1, 1 dc in next st, ch 1, skip 1, 1 hdc in next st, ch 1, skip 1, 1 sc in next st**, ch 1, skip 1* repeat from * to * 6 times. Repeat from * to **, finish with 1 sc in the last st. Turn.

Row 5: ch 1, work 1 sc in each st and ch-sp to the end of the row. Change to color B. Turn.

Row 6: ch 1, work 1 sc in each st to the end of the row. Turn.

Rows 7 and 8: ch 4, *1 tc in next st, ch 1, skip 1, 1 dc in next st, ch 1, skip 1, 1 hdc in next st, (ch 1, skip 1, 1 sc in next st) x2, ch 1, skip 1, 1 hdc in next st, ch 1, skip 1, 1 dc in next st, ch 1, skip 1, 1 tc in next st**, ch 1, skip 1* repeat from * to * 6 times. Repeat from * to **, finish with 1 tc in last st. Turn.



Row 9: ch 1, work 1 sc in each st and ch-sp to the end of the row. Change to color A. Turn.

Row 10: ch 1, work 1 sc in each st to the end of the row. Turn.

Rows 11 and 12:

Ch 1, 1 sc in next 2 sts, *Ch 1, skip 1, 1 hdc in next st, ch 1, skip 1, 1 dc in next st, (ch 1, skip 1, 1 tc in next st) x2, ch 1, skip 1, 1 dc in next st, ch 1, skip 1, 1 hdc in next st, (ch 1, skip 1, 1 sc in next st) x2* repeat from * to * twice in total. Ch 1, skip 1, 1 hdc in next st, ch 1, skip 1, 1 dc in next st, ch 1, skip 1,

1 tc in next 3 sts, 1 dc in next 3 sts, 1 hdc in next 2 sts, 1 sc in next 3 sts, 1 hdc in next 2 sts, 1 dc in next 3 sts repeat from * to * twice in total, 1 tc in next 3 sts.

ch 1, skip 1, 1 dc in next st, ch 1, skip 1, 1 hdc in next st, (ch 1, skip 1, 1 sc in next st) x2 Ch 1, skip 1, 1 hdc in next st, ch 1, skip 1, 1 dc in next st, (ch 1, skip 1, 1 tc in next st) x2 repeat from * to * twice in total, ch 1, skip 1, 1 dc in next st, ch 1, skip 1, 1 hdc in next st, ch 1, skip 1, 1 sc in the last 2 sts. Turn

Row 13: ch 1, work 1 sc in each st and ch-sp to the end of the row. Change to color B. Turn.

Row 14: ch 1, work 1 sc in each st to the end of the row. Turn.

Rows 15 and 16: Ch4, 1 tc in next st, ch 1, skip 1, 1 dc in next st, ch 1, skip 1, 1 hdc in next st, * (ch 1, skip 1, 1 sc in next st) x2, ch 1, skip 1, 1 hdc in next st, ch 1, skip 1, 1 dc in next st, (ch 1, skip 1, 1 tc in next st) x2, ch 1, skip 1, 1 dc in next st, ch 1, skip 1, 1 hdc in next st* repeat from * to * twice in total.

Ch 1, skip 1, *1 sc in next 3 sts, 1 hdc in next 2 sts, 1 dc in next 3 sts, 1 tc in next 3 sts, 1 dc in next 3 sts, 1 hdc in next 2 sts* repeat from * to * twice, 1sc in the next 3 sts.

Ch 1, skip 1, 1 hdc in next st, ch 1, skip 1, 1 dc in next st, (ch 1, skip 1, 1 tc in next st) x2, ch 1, skip 1, 1 dc in next st, ch 1, skip 1, 1 hdc in next st, (ch 1, skip 1, 1 sc in next st) x2 repeat from * to * twice. Ch 1, skip 1, 1 hdc in next st, ch 1, skip 1, 1 dc in next st, ch 1, skip 1, 1 tc in the last 2 sts. Turn

Row 17: ch 1, work 1 sc in each st and ch-sp to the end of the row. Change to color A. Turn.

Rows 18 to 33: Repeat Rows 10 to 17, two more times.

Rows 34 to 81: Repeat Rows 2 to 9, six times.

ARMHOLE

Row 82: ch 1, 1 sc in the next 16 sts. Ch 37 (49), skip 37 (49) sts, 1 sc in each st to the end of the row. Turn.

Note: Try to see if the armhole fits you, if necessary make more or less ch but skip the same amount of st that your ch.



BACK

Rows 83 to 89: Repeat Rows 3 to 9 once.

Size S to L only:

Rows 90 to 129: repeat Rows 2 to 9 five times.

Rows 130 to 133: repeat Rows 2 to 5 once.

Size XL to XXXL only:

Rows 90 to 137: repeat Rows 2 to 9 six times.

Rows 138 to 141: repeat Rows 2 to 5 once.

ARMHOLE

Row 134 (145): ch 1, 1 sc in the next 16 sts. Ch 37 (49), skip 37 (49) sts, (or do the same as your first armhole). 1 sc in each st to the end of the row. Turn.

Rows 135 (146) to 137 (145): repeat Rows 7 to 9.

Rows 138 (146) to 177 (185): repeat Rows 2 to 9 five times

Rows 178 (186) to 181 (189): repeat Rows 2 to 5 once.

Rows 182 (190) to 185 (193): repeat Rows 14 to 17 once.

Rows 186 (194) to 189 (197): repeat Rows 10 to 13 once.

Rows 190 (198) to 205 (213): repeat Rows 182 to 189 two more times.

Rows 206 (214) to 209 (217): repeat Rows 6 to 9 once

Rows 210 (218) to 213 (221): repeat Rows 2 to 5 once

Rows 214 (222): ch 1, work 1 sc in each st to the end of the round. Do not cut the yarn.

BORDER

Turn to work along the ends of the rows. Work with color A around the stitches color A, and with color B around the stitches color B. Do not cut the yarn each time, just carry the unused color under stitches.

The amount of stitches can vary depending on your tension. Be sure to don't make too much or not enough sc to avoid ripple or shrink.

I work like this 1 sc in each sc side, and 3 sc around each ch 4 and tc.



Work the border in sc until the end of the long side. Finish with a sl st in the last st. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Rejoin the yarns and work the other long side in the same way.

FINISHING ARMHOLES

With the wrong side facing you. On top of the armhole, join the yarn of the corresponding color in the first st. *Work 1 sc in each st/ch to the next tc, ch 3, skip 1 st* repeat all around the armhole, changing color at the bottom of the armhole. You will have 4 (5) buttonholes. Still with the wrong yarn facing, sew the buttons in front of each buttonholes.

POCKETS

With color A, ch 34.

Row 1: work 1 sc in the second chain from the hook, and in each ch of the row. Turn. (33 sts)

Rows 2 and 3: ch 4, *1 tc in next st, 1 dc in next 3 sts, 1 hdc in next 2 sts, 1 sc in next 3 sts, 1 hdc in next 2 sts, 1 dc in next 3 sts, 1 tc in next 2 sts* repeat twice. Turn. (33 sts, 2 rows)

Row 4: ch1, work 1 sc in each st and ch-sp to the end of the row. Change to color B. (33 sts)

Row 5: ch1, work 1 sc in each st to the end of the row. (33 sts)

Rows 6 and 7: Ch 1, 1 sc in first st. *1 sc in next st, 1 hdc in next 2 sts, 1 dc in next 3 sts, 1 tc in next 3 sts, 1 dc in next 3 sts, 1 hdc in next 2 sts, 1 sc in next 2 sts* repeat twice. Turn. (33 sts, 2 rows)

Row 8: ch1, work 1 sc in each st and ch-sp to the end of the row. <u>Change to color A</u>. Turn. (33 sts)

Rows 9: ch1, work 1 sc in each st to the end of the row. Turn.

Rows 10 to 24: Repeat Rows 2 to 9 twice and Rows 2 to 8 one last time.

Border

Turn to work along the ends of the rows. Work with color A around the stitches color A, and with color B around the stitches color B. Do not cut the yarn each time, just carry the unused color under stitches.

The amount of stitches can vary depending on your tension. Be sure to don't make too much or not enough sc to avoid ripple or shrink.

I work like this 1 sc in each sc side, and 3 sc around each ch 4 and tc.

Work sc until the end of the long side. Secure and cut color B.

Turn and work sl st with color A into each foundation ch.

Turn again and sc along the long side in the same way that the first side, joining B when needed. Secure and cut color A.



Turn one last time and work slst with color B in the last short side. Join in round with a sl st. Secure and cut color B.

FINISHING

Wash your shawl and your pockets. Lay the shawl flat and pin it according to the measures. Lay the pockets on top of the shawl where they'll be sewn (the part without lace). This allows the pockets to be the same size as their final places. Let it dry to block your work.

Sew the pockets to the shawl. Make sure to sew the pockets respecting the undulations of the pattern. Weave in ends.
