Brilliance

Shawl

MATERIALS

1 skein of Dahlia Mixo color 03 (A) 3 skeins of Friends Wheel color 02 (B)

Crochet hook 3.5 mm / US E/4 Blocking Materials Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

Dahlia Mixo, Hobbii 100% Cotton 200 g / 7.0 oz = 800 m / 874 yds

Friends Wheel, Hobbii 55% cotton, 45% acrylic 100 g / 3.5 oz = 400 m / 437 yds

GAUGE

After 8 rounds worked of the center square, square should measure about 11.5 cm / 4.5" across

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

sk = skip

sp = space

sc = single crochet

dc = double crochet

sc2tog = single crochet 2 stitches together dc2tog = double crochet 2 stitches together

SIZE

Scarf (Shawl)

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 18 (34) cm / 7" (13.5") steam blocked Length: 226 (218) cm / 89" (86") steam blocked

PATTERN INFORMATION

This pattern can be made in either a scarf size or a shawl size.

The pattern starts by working a square. Each side of the shawl/scarf will then be worked off of opposite sides/corners of the square. The pattern uses basic stitches such as chains, single crochet, double crochet and decrease stitches.

With the stated number of skeins you can make both the shawl and scarf versions.

INFO AND TIPS

- Once the initial square is made using one color, each side of the shawl/scarf is worked off of opposite sides/corners of the square and two colors are used.
- When a color is not being used, carry it up the side of the work until it is needed next.
- Parentheses () indicate a set of stitches all worked into the same stitch/space.
- Brackets [] indicate repeating that set of instructions the stated number of times or around.
- The (ch 2, sc to first st to join) at the end of each round of the square counts as a ch-3 corner space.
- The center square is worked in turned rounds.
- The scarf uses 430 m / 470 yds of Color A (Yellow) Dahlia Mixo and 206 m / 225 yds Color B (White) Friends Wheel.
- The shawl uses 348 m / 380 yds of Color A (Yellow) Dahlia Mixo and 777 m / 850 yds Color B (White) Friends Wheel.

SPECIAL STITCH:

(beg dc) beginning double = do not ch to start (unless stated in the pattern), sc in first st, sc in left vertical bar of sc just made (aka - stacked single crochet)

CENTER SQUARE

With **A** for scarf, with **B** for shawl, create a magic ring.

Round 1: Ch 1, work into the magic ring, 2 dc, [ch 3, 2 dc] 3 times, ch 2, sc in first st to join, TURN - (8 dc, 4 ch-3 sps).

Round 2: Ch 1, beg dc in previous ch sp made, dc in same sp, ch 2, sk 2, * (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in ch-3 sp, ch 2, sk 2; repeat from * around to first ch-3 sp, 2 dc in ch-3 sp, ch 2, sc in first st to join, TURN - (16 dc, 4 ch-3 sps, 4 ch-2 sps).

Round 3: Ch 1, 2 sc in previous ch sp made, ch 2, sk 2, 2 sc in ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk 2, [(2 sc, ch 3, 2 sc) in ch-3 sp, ch 2, sk 2, 2 sc in ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk 2] around to first ch-3 sp, 2 sc in first ch-3 sp, ch 2, sc in first st to join, TURN - (24 sc, 8 ch-2 sps, 4 ch-3 sps).

Round 4: Ch 1, 2 sc in previous ch sp made, ch 2, sk 2, [2 sc in ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk 2] repeat across to corner, [(2 sc, ch 3, 2 sc) in ch-3 sp, ch 2, sk 2, *2 sc in ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk 2; repeat from * across to corner] around to first ch-3 sp, 2 sc in first ch-3 sp, ch 2, sc in first st to join, TURN - (32 sc, 12 ch-2 sps, 4 ch-3 sps).



Round 5: Ch 1, beg dc in previous ch sp made, dc in same sp, ch 2, sk 2, [2 dc in ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk 2] repeat across to corner, [(2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in ch-3 sp, ch 2, sk 2, *2 dc in ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk 2; repeat from * across to corner] around to first ch-3 sp, 2 dc in first ch-3 sp, ch 2, sc in first st to join, TURN - (40 dc, 16 ch-2 sps, 4 ch-3 sps).

Round 6: Repeat Round 5 (48 dc, 20 ch-2 sps, 4 ch-3 sps).

Rounds 7-8: Repeat Round 4 (64 sc, 28 ch-2 sps, 4 ch-3 sps).

Stop here if working the scarf size and continue to Scarf Side 1. Do not fasten off A.

Rounds 9-10: Repeat Round 5 (80 dc, 36 ch-2 sps, 4 ch-3 sps).

Rounds 11-12: Repeat Round 4 (96 sc, 44 ch-2 sps, 4 ch 3 sps).

Rounds 13-14: Repeat Round 5 (112 dc, 52 ch-2 sps, 4 ch 3 sps).

Rounds 15-16: Repeat Round 4 (128 sc, 60 ch-2 sps, 4 ch 3 sps).

Rounds 17-18: Repeat Round 5 (144 dc, 68 ch-2 sps, 4 ch 3 sps).

Join A, do not fasten off B. Continue to Shawl Side 1.

SCARF SIDE 1

Turn after last round worked of the square, continue working with A.

Row 1: Beg dc in ch-3 corner sp, ch 2, sk 2, *2 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk 2; repeat from * across to ch-3 sp, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in ch-3 sp, ch 2, sk 2; repeat from * across to ch-3 sp, dc in ch-3 sp, turn (34 dc, 16 ch-2 sps, 1 ch-3 sp).

Row 2: Ch 2, dc2tog the first st and ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk 2, *2 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk 2; repeat from * across to ch-3 sp, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in ch-3 sp, ch 2, sk 2; repeat from * across until 1 ch-2 sp remains, dc2tog the last ch-2 sp and last st, turn (34 dc, 16 ch-2 sps, 1 ch-3 sp).

Rows 3-4: Ch 1, sc2tog the first st and ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk 2, *2 sc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk 2; repeat from * across to ch-3 sp, (2 sc, ch 3, 2 sc) in ch-3 sp, ch 2, sk 2; repeat from * across until 1 ch-2 sp remains, sc2tog the last ch-2 sp and last st, turn (34 sc, 16 ch-2 sps, 1 ch-3 sp).

Rows 5-6: Repeat Row 2.

Rows 7-58: Repeat Rows 3-6, join B after Row 58.

Rows 59-60: With **B**, repeat Row 3.

Rows 61-62: With A, Repeat Row 2.

Rows 63-74: Repeat Rows 59-62. Fasten off **A** after Row 74.

Rows 75-88: With B, repeat Rows 3-6. Fasten off B.

SCARF SIDE 2

Join **A** to the same corner space as the start of Row 1 for Side 1.

Repeat row instructions from Scarf Side 1. Do not Fasten off **B** after last row.

Continue to Border.

SHAWL SIDE 1

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in ch-3 corner sp, sc in same ch-3 corner sp, ch 2, sk 2, *2 sc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk 2; repeat from * across to ch-3 sp, (2 sc, ch 3, 2 sc) in ch-3 sp, ch 2, sk 2; repeat from * across to ch-3 sp, sc in ch-3 sp, turn (74 sc, 36 ch-2 sps, 1 ch-3 sp).

Row 2: Ch 1, sc2tog the first st and ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk 2, *2 sc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk 2; repeat from * across to ch-3 sp, (2 sc, ch 3, 2 sc) in ch-3 sp, ch 2, sk 2; repeat from * across until 1 ch-2 sp remains, sc2tog the last ch-2 sp and last st, turn (74 sc, 36 ch-2 sps, 1 ch-3 sp).

Rows 3-4: With **B**, ch 2, dc2tog the first st and ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk 2, *2 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk 2; repeat from * across to ch-3 sp, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in ch-3 sp, ch 2, sk 2; repeat from * across until 1 ch-2 sp remains, dc2tog the last ch-2 sp and last st, turn (74 sc, 36 ch-2 sps, 1 ch-3 sp).



Rows 5-6: With A, repeat Row 2.

Rows 7-76: Repeat Rows 3-6 ending on a Row 4 repeat. Fasten of A and B.

SHAWL SIDE 2

Join **B** to the same corner space as the start of Row 1 for Side 1. Repeat row instructions from Shawl Side 1. Do not fasten off **B** after last row. Continue to Border.

BORDER

Round 1: With **B**, ch 1, sc evenly around. On the long edges place 2 sc per dc row and 1 sc per sc row, place 3 sc at any point/corner, sc in each st of short edges and 1 sc in each ch-2 sp of short edges, join with a sl st, turn.

Round 2: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join with a sl st, turn.

Round 3: Repeat Round 2. Fasten off and weave in ends.

FINISHING

Steam block or wet block scarf/shawl to open up the stitches.
