



KNITTING PATTERN

Flower Kids

Headband

Design: Au Bout du Pré | Hobbii Design



MATERIALS

1 skein of Diablo colour 02 – Yarn A 1 skein of Diablo colour 35 – Yarn B

1 skein of Diablo colour 51 – Yarn C

Straight needle and/or DPN 2.25 mm (US 1) HB Plastic 2 cm – 0.79" wide headband Sewing needle

YARN QUALITY

Diablo, Hobbii 40% Acrylic, 30% Mohair, 30% Polyamide 25 g (0.9 oz) = 225 m (246 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4'' x 4'') = 50 sts x 60 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

K = Knit

P = Purl

St(s) = Stitch(es)

C/on = Cast on

C/off = Cast off

K2tog = Knit the next two stitches together Kf&b = knit in the front and then the back of the same stitch with the yarn at the back of the work

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Headband length: 37 cm - 14.57"

INFO AND TIPS

The headband cover is knitted flat but could be easily knitted in the round on DPN. The flowers are knitted all individually in two different colours then the centre is added afterwards before being sewn to the headband.

BAND

C/on 16 sts with yarn A

Row 1 - K row

Row 2 - P row

Repeat the first 2 rows until your piece measure 33 cm – 12.99" (If worked in the round on DPN then K every row for 33 cm – 12.99")

C/off all 16 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

LARGE FLOWER (MAKE 7)

C/on 3 sts with yarn A

Row 1 - P row

Row 2 – C/on 2, K to the end of the row (5 sts)

Row 3 - P row

Row 4 – C/on 2, K to the end of the row (7 sts)

Row 5 - P row

Row 6 - K row

Row 7 - P row

Row 8 – C/off 2, K to the end of the row (5 sts)

Row 9 - P row

Row 10 – C/off 2, K to the end of the row (3 sts)



Row 11 - Prow

Repeat these 11 rows 3 more times to create a 4 petals flower.

C/off the remaining 3 sts, then thread through the continuous side (opposite to the petals) and pull to form a flower, finish by sewing each end together to secure the shape. Cut the yarn and make secure

SMALL FLOWER (MAKE 6)

C/on 3 sts with yarn B

Row 1 - P row

Row 2 – C/on 2, K to the end of the row (5 sts)

Row 3 - P row

Row 4 - K row

Row 5 - P row

Row 6 – C/off 2, K to the end of the row (3 sts)

Row 7 - Prow

Repeat these 7 rows 3 more times to create a 4 petals flower.

C/off the remaining 3 sts, then thread through the continuous side (opposite to the petals) and pull to form a flower, finish by sewing each end together to secure the shape. Cut the yarn and make secure

LARGE FLOWER CENTRE (MAKE 7)

C/on 3 sts with yarn C

Row 1 - P row

Row 2 – Kf&b, K1, Kf&b (5 sts)

Row 3 - P row

Row 4 - K2tog, K1, K2tog (3 sts)

Row 5 - P row

C/off the remaining 3 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

SMALL FLOWER CENTRE (MAKE 6)

For the smaller flowers you will use a bullion stitch to make the middle.

With yarn C and your sewing needle bring the yarn from the back of the flower to the front and wrap your yarn 10 times around your needle then pass your needle to the back of the flower again. You have now created your middle, cut the yarn and make secure.



FINISHING UP

If you have knitted this part flat, sew the back of the band together, slide the headband inside and pull the band to reach the end bits and sew shut each end around the headband.

Make sure that all your flowers are sewn shut and sew the middle of the large flowers on.

To finish, attach all your flowers to the headband from the middle so the petals can curl a bit. Do not sew them in a line but try to cover the edges of the headband to make it fluffier.

Weave in all ends
