# Bloom

Keyring


Design: Au Bout du Pré | Hobbii Design

## MATERIALS

1 skein of Rainbow Lace colour 25 – Yarn A  
1 skein of Rainbow Lace colour 42 – Yarn B  
1 skein of Rainbow Lace colour 34 – Yarn C  
1 skein of Rainbow Lace colour 40 – Yarn D

Straight needle 2.25 mm (US 1)  
Metal Keyring Snap Hook  
Darning needle  
Stuffing

## YARN QUALITY

 **Rainbow Lace**, Hobbii  
100% Mercerized Cotton  
50 g (1.75 oz) = 280 m (306 yds)

## GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 40 sts x 55 rows

## ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit  
P = purl  
St(s) = Stitch(es)  
C/on = Cast on  
C/off = Cast off  
K2tog = Knit the next two stitches together  
K3tog = Knit the next three stitches together  
Kf&b = knit in the front and then the back of the same stitch with the yarn at the back of the work

## SIZE

One size

## MEASUREMENTS

Diameter: 11cm / 4.33"

## PATTERN INFORMATION

Lovely gift to make, great to add a touch of colour to a bag or set of keys.

The keyring is knitted flat in a multitude of layers and then sewn together.

# Pattern



## LARGE FLOWER (MAKE 2)

C/on 120 sts with yarn A

Row 1 – P row

Row 2 – K row

Repeat the first 2 rows 4 times

Row 11 – (K4, K2tog) x 20 (100 sts)

Row 12 – P row

Row 13 – K row

Row 14 – P row

Row 15 – (K3, K2tog) x 20 (80 sts)

Row 16 – P row

Row 17 – K row

Row 18 – P row

Row 19 – (K2, K2tog) x 20 (60 sts)

Row 20 – P row

Row 21 – K row

Row 22 – P row

Row 23 – (K1, K2tog) x 20 (40 sts)

Row 24 – P row

Row 25 – (K2tog) x 20 (20 sts)

Row 26 – P row

Row 27 – (K2tog) x 10 (10 sts)

Thread through all the remaining 10 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

## MIDDLE FLOWER (MAKE 6)

C/on 5 sts with yarn B

Row 1 – P row

Row 2 – Kf&b, K to the last st, Kf&b

Repeat the first 2 rows 4 times (15 sts)

Row 11 – P row

Row 12 – K row

Row 13 – P row

Row 14 – K row

Row 15 – P row

Row 16 – K2tog, K to the last 2 sts, K2tog (13 sts)

Row 17 – P row

Row 18 – K2tog, K to the last 2 sts, K2tog (11 sts)

Row 19 – P row

Row 20 – (K2tog) x 2, K3tog, (K2tog) x 2 (5 sts)

C/off all 5 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

## **SMALL FLOWER**

C/on 50 sts with yarn C

Rows 1 to 7 – K 7 rows

Row 8 – (K2tog) repeat to the end of the row (25 sts)

Row 9 – K row

Row 10 – (K2tog) repeat to the last 3 sts, K1, K2tog (13 sts)

Row 11 – K5, K2tog, K6 (12 sts)

Row 12 – (K2tog) repeat to the end of the row (6 sts)

Thread through the remaining 6 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

## **BIG BALL**

C/on 5 sts with yarn B

Row 1 – K f&b, (K1, Kf&b) x 2 (8 sts)

Row 2 – P row

Row 3 – (Kf&b, K1) x 4 (12 sts)

Row 4 – P row

Row 5 – K row

Repeat row 4 & 5 twice more

Row 10 – P row

Row 11 – (K2tog, K1) x 4 (8 sts)

Row 12 – P row

Row 13 – (K2tog) x 4 (4 sts)

Thread through the remaining 4 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

## **SMALL BALL (MAKE 6)**

C/on 3 sts with yarn D

Row 1 – K f&b, K1, Kf&b (5 sts)

Row 2 – P row

Row 3 – Kf&b, K to the last st, Kf&b (7 sts)

Row 4 – P row

Row 5 – K row

Row 6 – P row

Row 7 – K2tog, K3, K2tog (5 sts)

Row 8 – P row

Row 9 – K2tog, K1, K2tog (3 sts)

Thread through the remaining 3 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

## **ICORD STRING**

C/on 3 sts with yarn D

Row 1 – K row

Slip all the sts back on the left needle without turning your work

Row 2 – K row

Slip all the sts back on the left needle without turning your work

Repeat row 1 & 2 until your Icord measure 14 cm – 5.51”

C/off all 3 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

## **FINISHING UP**

Join the seam on each of the two large flowers to create a circle.

Sew around each petal of the middle flower in a circle with the c/on edge in the centre of one of the large flowers.

Join the seam of the small flower to create a circle and sew it on the top of the petals of the middle flower.

Thread around the big ball and pull to create the ball, slightly fill it in to keep the shape and make secure. Then sew the ball in the centre of your keyring on the top of the small flower.

Thread around the small balls and pull to create the balls, slightly fill it in to keep the shape and make secure. Then sew the balls in between all the petals of the middle flower.

Slide the Icord into the keyring, fold the string in two and sew it under the big flower.

Get the second big flower underneath the first one with the right side facing out and sew all around the two big flowers together.... Now everything is hiding away.

Weave in all ends.
