MATERIALS

1 skein of Kind Feather colour 3 – Yarn A 1 skein of Kind Feather colour 10 – Yarn B 1 skein of Kind Feather colour 19 – Yarn C

Straight needle and/or DPN 3.75 mm (US 5) HB Plastic 2 cm – 0.79" wide headband Stitch marker Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

Kind Feather, Hobbii
100% Premium Acrylic
100 g (3.5 oz) = 235 m (257 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 30 sts x 34 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

K = Knit P = PurlSt(s) = Stitch(es)C/on = Cast on C/off = Cast off M = Marker PM = Place marker SM = Slide marker RM = Remove marker K2tog = Knit the next two stitches together K3tog = Knit the next three stitches together P3tog = Purl the next three stitches together Kf&b = knit in the front and then the back of the same stitch with the yarn at the back of the work

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Flower diameter: 8 cm – 3.15" Headband length: 37 cm – 14.57"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Lovely gift to make for a little child, great for a last minute gift. The flower is knitted in 3 layers then sewn

together, the leaves are knitted separately then sewn to the headband.

Pattern



BAND

C/on 8 sts with yarn A (If you are working this lcord on DPN then just slide the sts to the other end of the same needle)

Row 1 – K row Slide all your sts back on the left needle without turning your work Row 2 – K row Slide all your sts back on the left needle without turning your work

Repeat the first 2 rows until your piece is 1 cm – 0.39" shorter than your headband, check by sliding it in regularly.

The knit won't look very tight at the beginning, but it will after a few cm, just make sure to pull tight on the first 2 sts of each row.

C/off all 8 sts, pull the band to reach the end of the headband and sew shut each ends around the headband, cut the yarn and make secure.

LARGE FLOWER

C/on 60 sts with yarn B

Row 1 – P row Row 2 – P row Row 3 – (K4, K2tog) repeat to the end of the row (50 sts) Row 4 – P row Row 5 – (K3, K2tog) repeat to the end of the row (40 sts) Row 6 – P row Row 7 – (K2, K2tog) repeat to the end of the row (30 sts) Row 8 – P row Row 9 – (K1, K2tog) repeat to the end of the row (20 sts)



Row 10 – P row

Thread through all the remaining 20 sts twice, cut the yarn and make secure

MIDDLE FLOWER

C/on 50 sts with yarn B

Row 1 – P row Row 2 – (K3, K2tog) repeat to the end of the row (40 sts) Row 3 – P row Row 4 – (K2, K2tog) repeat to the end of the row (30 sts) Row 5 – P row Row 6 – (K1, K2tog) repeat to the end of the row (20 sts) Row 7 – P row

Thread through all the remaining 20 sts twice, cut the yarn and make secure

SMALL FLOWER

C/on 40 sts with yarn B

Row 1 – P row Row 2 – (K2, K2tog) repeat to the end of the row (30 sts) Row 3 – P row Row 4 – (K1, K2tog) repeat to the end of the row (20 sts) Row 5 – P row

Thread through all the remaining 20 sts twice, cut the yarn and make secure

LEAF (MAKE 2)

C/on 5 sts with yarn C

Row 1 – K row Row 2 – P row Row 3 – K1, Kf&b, PM, K1, PM, Kf&b, K1 (7 sts) Row 4 – P row Row 5 – K up to 1 st before M, Kf&b, SM, K1, SM, Kf&b, K to the end of the row (9 sts) Row 6 – P row Repeat the last 2 rows 3 more times (15 sts)

Row 13 – K up to 2 sts before M, K2tog, SM, K1, SM, K2tog, K to the end of the row (13 sts) Row 14 – P row Repeat the last 2 rows 4 more times (5 sts) and RM during the last P row



Row 23 – K1, K3tog, K1 (3 sts) Row 24 – P3tog

C/off the remaining st, cut the yarn and make secure

FINISHING UP

Sew through the middle of all three flowers on the top of each other in size order.

Then add the leaves under the big flower with the right side facing up.

To finish, attach the lot to the headband in few different places to make it very secure.

Weave in all ends.
