MATERIALS

Rainbow Lace 1 skein of color 40 (A) 1 skein of color 98 (B)

Crochet hook 1.5 mm / US 7 Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

Rainbow Lace, Hobbii
 40 % cotton, mercerised
 50 g / 1.75 oz = 280 m / 308 yds

GAUGE

32 sc x 43 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain sc = single crochet hdc = half double crochet dc = double crochet sl st = slip stitch ps = puff stitch sts = stitches

SIZE

S (M, L, XL, XXL)

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 1 cm / 0.4" Length - S: 22 cm / 8.6" Length - M: 23 cm / 9" Length - L: 24 cm / 9.4" Length - XL: 25 cm / 9.8" Length - XXL: 26 cm / 10.2"


LAVENDER FLOWER

Start with col **A** Leave a 20 cm/ 8" tail at the beginning and Ch 5.



Row 1: make a ps in the 5th chain from your hook.

To make a puff stitch (ps) in this pattern you should yarn over and insert your hook into the designated stitch 5 times. You should pull the yarn through when you have 11 loops on your hook.





Row 2: ch 3, turn, make a ps in the space created by the previous chain:



Row 3: ch 3, turn, make a ps in the space created by the previous chain.



Keep repeating row 3 until you have a total of 15 puff stitches. Fasten off and cut the yarn.



STEM & LEAVES

Now attach the col **B** where we ended our flower. You can make a knot between the end of your purple yarn and your green yarn to secure it.





Ch **45** (51, 57, 63, 69) - or as many you need to wrap your wrist and close the bracelet. Crochet along the side of the chain.

Sl st into the second ch from the hook, sc, hdc, dc, hdc, sl st. This will create the first leaf in the stem. Continue making sl sts in the chain and make one leaf every 10 sl sts.



To make one new leaf in the stem:

Ch 6, sl st in the second ch from the hook, sc, hdc, dc, hdc, sl in the stem.


Note: You can space out your leaves however you like. Have fun!

Once you get back to the beginning of your chain, fasten off and weave in the ends.





Now return to the top of the flower where we left our long tail and chain 9. Create a loop by slip stitching in the first chain and fasten off. You can now cut the yarn and weave in all the ends.



To wear Fairy, simply insert the stem into the loop and tie a knot like any other friendship bracelet. You can also sew a small button to the end of the stem and use that as a closing mechanism instead.

Another option is to make the flower and stem long enough to wrap your waist and you can use it as a decorative and cool belt.
