## **MATERIALS**

Friends Cotton 8/4 - 1 skein of each: Malachite (106) (col. A) Coral (35) (col. B) Pink Berry Smoothie (54) (col. C) Cream (04) (col. D)

Crochet hook 3 mm Stitch markers Scissors Darning needle

# YARN QUALITY

**Friends Cotton 8/4**, Hobbii 100% Cotton 50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (175 yds)

## **GAUGE**

1 square measures approx. 7 x 7 cm / 2.8" x 2.8"

### **ABBREVIATIONS**

st(s) = stitch(es) sc = single crochet dc = double crochet ch = chain hdc = half double crochet tr = triple crochet slst = slip stitch

#### SIZE

One size

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Length without the straps: 32 cm / 12.6 in. Width: 7 cm / 2.8 in.



# **GRANNY SQUARE FLOWER**

#### Col. A

The ring: ch 4, join the last ch to the first on with a slst

**Round 1:** ch 3 (= 1 dc), work another 15 dc in the ring, join with a slst to the first dc

# Change to col. B

**Round 2:** ch 2, 3 unfinished dc in the same st, yarn over and pull through all loops (7 loops), repeat a total of 16 times, finish with 1 slst in the space between the first and the second cluster

# Change to col. C

**Round 3:** ch 2, work 1 half-finished dc (only pull the yarn through the first two loops, do this 4 times in total, so you end up with 5 loops on your hook, yarn over and pull through all 5 loops) ch 2, work 4 half-finished dc between the next two dc clusters, continue all the way around, so you end up with 16 clusters. Ch 2 to finish and join with 1 slst in the space between the first and the second cluster.

## Outer edge - col. D

**Round 4:** ch 4, 2 tr in the same ch-space. 3 dc in the next ch.space, 3 hdc, 3 dc, 3 tr, ch 2, 3 tr in the same ch-space (this is now a corner). 3 dc, 3 hdc, 3 dc, 3 tr, ch 2, 3 tr in the same ch-space, 3 dc, 3 hdc, 3 dc, 3 tr, ch 2, 3 tr in the same ch-space, 3 dc, 3 hdc, 3 dc, 3 tr, ch 2, join with 1 slst in the space with the ch-4.

# **CONNECT THE 4 GRANNY-SQUARES**

# With col. D

Place two squares with the right sides facing. Insert the hook in the corner of the square closest to you and work a slst. Insert the hook in the square farthest from you and work a slst in that one. Continue in this way in all of the sts until you reach the end of this edge (make sure you alternate working in the sts on each square). Finally work a slst in both corners, one at a time. Do the same with the next square along with one of those you have already joined. Continue this until all four of your granny squares have been joined.



# **THE STRAPS**

# With col. D

The four granny squares have now been joined in a row. In the outermost granny square, work a slst in the middle st. Ch 50-70 (until the strap has reached the desired length.) Then ch 1, which will work as a turning chain. Work 1 sc in each ch along the strap. Join with a slst in the middle st where you started.

Repeat this on the other side of the headband.
