## Hat

## MATERIALS

2 skeins of Friends Cotton 8/4 colour 05 Yarn A
2 skeins of Friends Cotton 8/4 colour 114 Yarn B
$5 \times$ DPN 3.75 mm (US 5)
Circular needles 3.75 mm (US 5) 40 cm 15.75"

Circular needles 4 mm (US 6) 60 cm - 23.62" Stitch marker

## YARN QUALITY

(10) Friends Cotton 8/4, Hobbii

100\% Cotton
$50 \mathrm{~g}(1.75 \mathrm{oz})=160 \mathrm{~m}(175 \mathrm{yds})$
GAUGE
$10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}\left(4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}\right)=22$ sts $\times 36$ rows

## ABBREVIATIONS

$K=K n i t$
St(s) $=$ Stitch(es)
C/on = Cast on
C/off = Cast off
Dec c/off $=($ Decrease cast off) K2tog from the back of the loop then slip the stitch back to the left needle, repeat to the end of the row
PM = Place marker
Kf\&b = knit in the front and then the back of the same stitch with the yarn at the back of the work

## INFO AND TIPS

The hat is knitted all the way with two strands of yarn at the same time and in the round from start to finish.

## HAT CROWN

C/on 8 sts with two strands of yarn A and DPN 3.75 mm (US 5)
Spread your 8 sts over 4 needles and PM to mark the start/end of the round

Round 1 - K round
Round 2 - Kf\&b in every sts (16 sts)
Round 3 - K round
Round 4 - (K1, Kf\&b) repeat to the end of the round (24 sts)

Change to two strands of yarn $B$
Round 5 - K round
Round 6 - (K2, Kf\&b) repeat to the end of the round ( 32 sts )
Round 7 - K round
Round 8 - (K3, Kf\&b) repeat to the end of the round (40 sts)

Change to two strands of yarn A

Continue increasing following the patt above from round 1 to 8 and changing yarn colour every 4 rounds until you have 128/136/144 sts.
Note: In every increase round you have to K1 more in each section between the increase than on the previous increase round.

You should be able to transfer your work about now to circular needles 3.75 mm (US 5) 40 cm - 15.75".

Continue straight without increasing by Knitting every round until your piece measure $16 / 16 / 17 \mathrm{~cm}-6.30^{\prime \prime} / 6.30^{\prime \prime} / 6.69^{\prime \prime}$ from c/on. Still changing yarn colour every 4 rounds and finishing on a set of 4 rounds of the same colour.

## HAT BRIM

Next round - (K7/7/5, Kf\&b) x 16/17/24 (144/153/168 sts)
Next round - K round
Next round - (K8/8/6, Kf\&b) x 16/17/24 (160/170/192 sts)
Next round - K round
Next round - (K9/9/7, Kf\&b) x 16/17/24 (176/187/216 sts)
Next rounds - K 3 rounds
Next round - (K10/10/8, Kf\&b) x 16/17/24 (192/204/240 sts)
Next rounds - K 3 rounds
Next round - (K11/11/9, Kf\&b) x 16/17/24 (208/221/264 sts)
Next rounds - K 3 rounds
Next round - (K12/12/10, Kf\&b) x 16/17/24 (224/238/288 sts)
Next rounds - K 2 rounds

Dec c/off all remaining sts, cut the yarn and make secure.

## FINISHING UP

Weave in all ends
