MATERIALS

Friends Cotton 8/4 1 skein of color 15 - YARN A 1 skein of color 123 - YARN B

Knitting needle 3.25 mm (US 3) Stuffing Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

Friends Cotton 8/4, Hobbii
100 % Cotton
50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (174 yds)

GAUGE 10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 30 sts x 50 rows SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS Height: 14 cm / 5.5" (without the strap) Width: 18 cm / 7" (with the ears)

PATTERN INFORMATION

The Bear shoulder bag is a quick and easy gift to knit for a little one.

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit P = Purl St(s) = Stitch(es) C/on = Cast on C/off = Cast off Kf&b = knit in the front and then the back of the same stitch with the yarn at the back of the work K2tog = Knit the next two stitches together K3tog = Knit the next three stitches together SKP = (slip, knit, pass) Slip the first stitch, knit the second stitch then pass the first stitch over the second one – you have decrease 1 stitch

INFO AND TIPS

The Bag is knitted in two different parts then sewn together, the same principle is used for the ears. The face and the strap are added at the end.

BAG (Make 2)

C/on 36 sts with yarn A

Row 1 – Kf&b, K to last st, Kf&b (38 sts) Row 2 – P row Repeat the first 2 rows 4 more times (46 sts)

Row 11 – K row Row 12 – P row Repeat the last 2 rows 9 times

Row 31 – SKP, K to the last 2 sts, K2tog (44 sts) Row 32 – P row Row 33 – K row Row 34 – P row



Repeat the last 4 rows 3 times (38 sts)

Row 47 – SKP, K to the last 2 sts, K2tog (36 sts) Row 48 – P row Repeat the last 2 rows 5 times (26 sts)

C/off all the sts loosely, cut the yarn and make secure

EARS (Make 4)

C/on 20 sts with yarn A

Rows 1 to 3 – K 3 rows Row 4 – K2, SKP, K until the last 4 sts, K2tog, K2 (18 sts) Rows 5 to 7 – K 3 rows Repeat the last 4 rows 3 more times (12 sts)

Row 20 – K2, SKP, K until the last 4 sts, K2tog, K2 (10 sts) Row 21 – K3tog, (K2tog) x 2, K3tog (4 sts)

C/off all 4 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

NOSE

C/on 10 sts with yarn B

Row 1 – K row Row 2 – P row Row 3 – Kf&b, K until the last st, Kf&b (12 sts) Row 4 – P row Repeat the last 2 rows once (14 sts)

Row 7 – K row Row 8 – P row Row 9 – SKP, K until the last 2 sts, K2tog (12 sts) Row 10 – P row Row 11 – SKP, K until the last 2 sts, K2tog (10 sts)

C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

EYE (make 2)

C/on 3 sts with yarn B

Row 1 – (Kf&b) x 3 (6 sts) Row 2 – K row



Row 3 – (K2tog) x 3 (3 sts)

Thread through all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

STRAP

C/on 5 sts with yarn A

<u>Knit an Icord as follow:</u> Row 1 – K row, move all 5 sts back on the left needle Repeat this row until your strap measure 85 cm / 33.46"

C/off all the 5 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

FINISHING UP

Sew the two sides of the ear together and stuff lightly.

Then do the same with the two sides of the bag up to the point where the reduction starts.

Stitch the ears shut and then attach them to the bag along the side reduction.

Add the eyes and the nose to the front of the bag and finish by adding the strap on each side.

Weave in all ends
