



KNITTING PATTERN

Cyprian

Children's sweater

Design: Knit Gang | Hobbii Design



MATERIALS

3 (3) 3 (4) skeins of Acacia Print color 05

Knitting needles 4 mm (US 6) Circular needles 3 mm (US 2.5) Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

Acacia Print, Hobbii 51% acrylic, 49% cotton 100 g (3.5 oz) = 250 m (273 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4'' x 4'') = 23 sts x 30 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit

p = Purl

CO = cast on

BO = bind off

inc = increase

SIZE

6 yrs (8 yrs) 10 yrs (12 yrs)

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 42 (44) 46 (48) cm / 17.3" (18.1") 18.8" Length: 41 (44) 47 (50) cm / 17.3" (18.5") 19.6"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Cyprian is a simple children's sweater, which, thanks to its loose, comfortable cut, will be perfect for everyday craziness! Thanks to the yarn used with cheerful color changes, there will be no boredom!

The sweater is worked straight and sewn together at the end.

INFO AND TIPS

The sweater consists of front, back and sleeves sewn together at the end.

SWEATER

Front piece

CO 97 (102) 107 (112) sts on 4 mm needles. Work 8 rows in rib stitch (k 2, p 2) then, 98 (106) 114 (122) rows in stockinette stitch.

In the next row BO 19 (20) 21 (24) middle sts for the neckline = 39 (41) 43 (44) sts on each shoulders

Now work the left and right shoulders separately.

From the neckline side, in every second row BO 3 sts, 2 sts, 1 st, 1 st (all sizes). = 32 (34) 36 (37) sts on each shoulder

Now start forming the shoulders. On each shoulder bind off in every second row from the shoulder side:

6 yrs size - 8 sts, 8 sts, 8 sts, 8 sts 8 yrs size - 10 sts, 8 sts, 8 sts, 8 sts 10 yrs size - 9 sts, 9 sts, 9 sts, 9 sts 12 yrs size - 9 sts, 7 sts, 7 sts, 7 sts, 7 sts

Back piece

CO 97 (102) 107 (112) sts on 4 mm needles. Work 8 rows in rib stitch (k 2, p 2) then, 102 (110) 118 (126) rows in stockinette stitch



In the next row BO 23 (24) 25 (28) middle sts for the neckline. Then, from the neckline side, in every second row BO on both sides 3 sts, 2 sts (all sizes).

Continue working the forming of the shoulders as in the front piece.

SLEEVES

CO 48 (50) 52 (54) sts on 4 mm needles. Work 8 rows in rib stitch (k 2, p 2) then start to work in stockinette stitch. In each 6th row of stockinette stitch inc 1 st on both sides of the sleeve. Repeat 14 times (all sizes) i.e. for 84 rows of stockinette stitch. Continue knitting in stockinette stitch until the sleeve measures the desired length. BO all sts.

Finishing

Sew the front and back piece together at the shoulders, on a circular needle 3 mm pick up an even number of sts around the neckline. Work 8 rows in rib stitch (k 2, p 2), BO. Sew the sleeves and sides of the sweater.
